**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 13-10 at Dozer Park. The Rattlers had leads of 6-1 and 9-5 but couldn't hold the lead. The Chiefs took the lead with six runs in the bottom of the seventh inning and added two runs in the eighth.

**HOME RUN DERBY:** The teams combined to hit six home runs last night. Ethan Murray, Carlos Rodríguez, and Tristan Peters all hit home runs for Wisconsin. Carlos Soto, Jacob Buchberger, and Mack Chambers hit the homers for the Chiefs.

**FIRST:** The homers by Rodríguez, Peters, and Murray were their first of the season. The last time Rodríguez homered as a Rattler was May 14, 2021 at Peoria.

**FIVE BY FIVE:** Rodríguez and Darrien Miller both reached base five times in Friday's game for Wisconsin. Rodríguez went 3-for-3 with two singles, a homer, and two walks. Miller was 3-for-3 with two singles, a double, and two walks. Rodríguez scored two runs and drove in two. Miller scored three runs.

**RUNNING WILD:** Peoria stole eight bases in last night's game, including five stolen bases in the third inning. Mike Antico had three steals last night and is 10-for-10 in stolen base attempts this season.

**THE RALLY:** Wisconsin reliever Miguel Guerrero had two outs and a 1-2 count on Matt Chamberlain with nobody on base in the bottom of the seventh protecting a 9-5 lead. Chamberlain reached on a single and the next seven Peoria batters reached base with six scoring. LJ Jones had an RBI double, Chambers tied the game with a three-run homer, and Masyn Winn put the Chiefs in front with a two-run triple.

**LAST-DITCH RALLY:** Wisconsin trailed 13-9 heading to the top of the ninth. The first three batters of the inning walked to load the bases. Carlos Rodríguez drew a walk with one out, but the game ended when the next batter grounded into a 6-4-3 double play.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](http://MLB Pipeline) puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). [MLB Pipeline](http://MLB Pipeline) has six current Chiefs2 on their list of Cardinals prospects – four active and two on the injured list: Maysin Winn (#5), Michael McGreevy (#8), Austin Love (#21), and Gordon Graceffo (#23) are on the active list. Ian Bedell (#22) and Jhon Torres (#24) are on the Peoria Injured List.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JUSTIN JARVIS:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

**THE SENIOR SEASON:** In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

**A PERFECT DAY:** Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

**NOT ON CAMPUS:** Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

**YEAR ONE:** Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

**2019:** Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

**2021:** Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Jarvis lost to [Quad Cities at home on April 24](#). He allowed five runs on four hits, including two homers, three walks and two strikeouts over two innings.

**VS. PEORIA (2021):** Jarvis made three starts and had no decisions against the Chiefs in 2021. He allowed six runs on eleven hits with eleven walks and nine strikeouts over ten innings in those three starts against Peoria last season.

**VS. PEORIA (2022):** Jarvis had a no decision [against the Chiefs as the starting pitcher on April 9](#). He allowed three runs on four hits, including two homers, with four walks and a strikeout over four innings.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP LOGAN GRAGG:** The Cardinals selected Gragg in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of Oklahoma State University.

**I WANT TO BE A COWBOY:** Gragg went 3-3 with two saves and a 5.10 ERA in 24 games – two starts – in his final season at Oklahoma State. He walked 19 and struck out 36 in 42-1/3 innings pitched.

**A DIFFERENT COLLEGE:** Gragg made his pro debut with the State College Spikes in the New York-Penn League after signing with the Cardinals. He had two saves and a 2.45 ERA in eight relief appearances before a promotion to the Chiefs in 2019.

**PLAYS IN PEORIA:** Gragg made nine appearances – eight starts – with the Chiefs in 2019. He was 0-3 with a save and a 3.38 ERA with twelve walks and 35 strikeouts over 34-2/3 innings pitched. He also pitched for the Chiefs in 2021 and went 2-7 with a 4.45 ERA in 25 appearances – twenty starts – with 80 strikeouts and 27 walks.

**LAST START:** Gragg lost [at Cedar Rapids on April 24](#). He allowed six runs on ten hits with no walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2021):** Gragg was 1-1 in seven appearances – five starts – against Wisconsin in 2021: [May 11](#), [May 15](#), [June 1](#), [June 6](#), [June 24](#), [June 27](#), and [July 15](#). He allowed ten runs – seven earned – on nineteen hits with six walks and fourteen strikeouts over twenty innings against the Rattlers last season.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2022):** Gragg allowed an unearned run with two walks and no hits over an inning of relief [at Wisconsin on April 9](#).
