ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 13-3 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#) Wisconsin scored eight runs in the bottom of the first inning to erase an early 1-0 deficit. Gregory Barrios had a two-run double and Luis Lara had a two-run single as part of the big inning.

MOLTEN HOT: Mike Boeve went 2-for-2 with a walk, a stolen base, an RBI, and two runs scored for the Rattlers last night. Boeve has reached base in seven consecutive plate appearances in the last two games. He is 8-for-11 in the series and 21-for-38 (.553) for the season. Boeve has also walked thirteen times in thirteen games for an on base percentage of .642 on the season.

DON'T CRY BECAUSE IT'S OVER. SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED: Boeve was replaced by Jesús Chirinos defensively for the top of the fifth inning. It was announced this morning that Boeve has been promoted to Biloxi, the Double-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers in the Southern League.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Barrios was 3-for-3 with two runs, two walks, and two RBI last night. He is 9-for-13 with five doubles in the series. Barrios leads the Midwest League with seven doubles.

GET HIM ON; GET HIM IN: Dylan O'Rae was on base with two singles and two walks to score three runs. O'Rae has scored fifteen runs in thirteen games and leads the league in that category.

BETTER MAKE IT FIVE! Luis Lara and O'Rae extended their current hitting streaks to five games last night. Lara is 7-for-19, and O'Rae is 8-for-20. These are their longest hitting streaks of the season.

GOOD WOOD: Matt Wood hit his first home run of the season in last night's game. His three-run blast in the bottom of the second put the Rattlers up 11-1. Wood went 3-for-5 with four RBI in the game

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries) and Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Mike Boeve (#15), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadhve Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Gabriel Gonzalez (#4), CJ Culpepper (#8), Luke Keaschall (#9), Danny DeAndrade (#14), Andrew Morris (#18), Zebby Matthews (#20), Ricardo Olivar (#22), and Darren Bowen (#29). Connor Prelipp (#17) is currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARDS: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

BACK IN 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST SEASON: Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

LAST START: Cornielle lost at South Bend on [April 13](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2023): Cornielle went 0-1 in four games – two starts – against the Kernels last season. He allowed seven runs – six earned – on thirteen hits with five walks and 21 strikeouts over 22-1/3 innings against Cedar Rapids in 2023.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CJ CULPEPPER: The Minnesota Twins selected Culpepper in the thirteenth round of the 2022 draft out of California Baptist University. Culpepper is the #14 prospect in the Minnesota organization according to MLB Pipeline.

GOLDEN STATE: Culpepper pitched from 2020 through 2022 for CBU. He was 7-7 with fourteen saves in 44 games – sixteen starts – in his three seasons. Culpepper had 126 strikeouts in 108-1/3 innings pitched with a 3.74 ERA in his college career.

THAT'S WAC: Culpepper was the closer for the Lancers in 2021 and went 2-2 with thirteen saves over 22 appearances to be named Western Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year and First Team All-WAC. In 2022, Culpepper was 5-3 in sixteen games – fourteen starts at Cal Baptist and was Second Team All-WAC.

STARTING OVER: Culpepper made one appearance in the Florida Complex League in 2022 and began the 2023 season with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. He was 4-3 with a 2.33 ERA and 53 strikeouts over 46-1/3 innings pitched in eleven starts before his promotion to Cedar Rapids on June 26. Culpepper went 2-2 with a 4.99 ERA in ten regular season starts for the Kernels.

PLAYOFF HERO: Culpepper was the starting and winning pitcher against Peoria in Game Three of the Western Finals on [September 15, 2023](#). He allowed one run on four hits and struck out eight to help the Chiefs move on to the Championship Series.

LAST START: Culpepper had a no decision at home against Dayton on [April 14](#). He gave up a run on two hits with a walk and three strikeouts over four innings against the Dragons.

VS. WISCONSIN (2023): Culpepper went 0-1 in three starts against the Timber Rattlers – [July 26](#) at Wisconsin, [August 19](#) at Cedar Rapids, and [September 7](#) at Wisconsin – last season. He allowed thirteen runs – eleven earned – on fourteen hits with six walks and six strikeouts over nine innings in his starts against the Rattlers.
