### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-2 at Dow Diamond.](#)

The Rattlers offense had two hits in the game. Great Lakes scored a run in the second, two unearned runs in the third, and a run in the fifth to take a 4-0 lead.

**STREAK CONTINUES:** Eduardo Garcia moved his on-base streak to 23 games with two walks last night. Garcia has the longest active streak in the Midwest League. Blake Burke of the Rattlers has the longest streak of the season in the Midwest League at 25.

**SWAN DIVE:** Loons starting pitcher Eriq Swan allowed a run on two hits and two walks in eight strikeouts over six innings. He retired eleven in a row after a Jadher Areinamo single in the second inning and a lead-off walk to Yhoswar Garcia in the sixth.

**RUNNING WILD:** Yhoswar Garcia stole four bases last night to give him 28 steals on the season. He is second in the league in steals. The Rattlers stole a season-high seven bases last night with Areinamo, Eduardo Garcia, and Tayden Hall each had one.

**WALKING BACK INTO THE GAME:** Wisconsin drew six walks over the final three innings, including four in the top of the eighth inning. Blake Burke drew a two-out, bases-loaded walk to get the Rattlers to within 4-2. Wisconsin left the bases loaded in the eighth. They got the tying run to the plate in the top of the ninth but fell short in their comeback.

**DRIVE FOR FIVE DENIED:** Wisconsin had a four-game winning streak going into last night's game. The Rattlers missed on their third attempt at a five-game winning streak with last night's loss.

**ABOUT GREAT LAKES:** The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

**ABOUT THE DODGERS:** The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JARON DeBERRY:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected DeBerry in the third round of the 2024 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

**JC:** DeBerry pitched the 2021 season at Northern Oklahoma-Enid and was 5-1 with a 4.10 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts. In 2022, he was at Grayson College with a 4-0 record, a 3.27 ERA, and 60 strikeouts in 41.1IP.

**SUMMER JOBS:** DeBerry was with Duluth in the Northwoods League in 2022 and Cowlitz in the West Coast League in 2023. He combined to go 4-0 with a 1.85 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 39 innings playing in the Summer Leagues.

**DBU:** DeBerry was 10-2 with a 4.11 ERA in two seasons with Dallas Baptist. He had 124 strikeouts in 124-1/3 innings. He was a First Team All-Conference USA selection in his final season. In his last start with the Patriots, DeBerry shutout Arizona over six innings as Dallas Baptist beat the Wildcats in the Tucson Regional of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

**BEFORE WISCONSIN:** DeBerry made his pro debut with three starts for the Carolina Mudcats before joining Wisconsin on May 20. He had no record, allowed one run, walked one, and struck out thirteen in 8-2/3 innings with the Mudcats.

**LAST START:** DeBerry had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on [June 6](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and four strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**VS. GREAT LAKES:** DeBerry has never pitched against Great Lakes prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

## GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP LUKE FOX:** The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Fox in the seventeenth round of the 2023 draft out of Duke.

**BADGER STATE:** Fox is a native of Waukesha, Wisconsin and a graduate of Catholic Memorial High School. He led the Crusaders to back-to-back D4 State Football titles as the quarterback. Fox also ran track and played basketball.

**BLUE DEVIL:** Fox was 6-7 with two saves and a 4.74 ERA in 35 games – seventeen starts – in two seasons at Duke. He had 142 strikeouts in 108-1/3 innings during the 2021 and 2022 seasons. Fox did not pitch for Duke in 2023 due to an injury.

**DESERT RANCH:** Fox had no record in sixteen games – fourteen starts – in 2024 between the ACL Dodgers and Rancho Cucamonga. He made four appearances – two starts – with the ACL Dodgers. He made twelve starts with Rancho Cucamonga with a 3.52 ERA, 21 walks, and 38 strikeouts over 30-2/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Fox had a no decision at South Bend on [June 6](#). He allowed a run on two hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Fox has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
