LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 14-1 at Modern Woodmen Park.](#)

The Timber Rattlers offense had sixteen hits and scored in every inning from the fourth through the ninth inning to reach double digits in runs for the second game in a row. Three Wisconsin pitchers – Jayden Dubanewicz, Quito Low, and Michael Fowler – combined for twelve strikeouts and held the Bandits to one run. Marco Dinges, Daniel Dickinson, and Josiah Ragsdale each homered for the Rattlers. Sunday's game was rained out.

HE GETS ON BASE: Ragsdale went 2-for-5 with a walk, a homer, two RBI, and three runs scored on Saturday to extend his on-base streak to 26 games. Ragsdale is 36-for-97 (.370) with nineteen walks, 28 runs scored, and an OBP of .483 during the streak. Ragsdale also had his nineteenth multi-hit game of the season with his performance, the most by a Rattler this season.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Dinges returned to the lineup Saturday for the first time since his ejection in the ninth inning against Great Lakes at home on June 13. He went 3-for-4, walked, and was hit by a pitch. Dinges hit his homer in the seventh inning, his first home run since May 26 against Peoria. Dinges had homered on June 7 but that one was wiped out when the game was rained out.

FIRST! Dickinson's home run was his first as a professional. He hit a lead-off homer in the top of the eighth inning. Dickinson also went 3-for-4 with a walk and a hit batsman last night.

ANOTHER ONE: Dubanewicz is 2-0 in two starts with the Rattlers after winning both of his starts last week. He beat Great Lakes at home on June 14 and picked up the win last night. Dubanewicz allowed one run on six hits, walked none, and struck out six over five innings against the River Bandits.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended in 2024 when the Kernels missed the playoffs but started again in 2025 when they advanced to the Midwest League Championship Series. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRAYLON OWENS: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Owens in the tenth round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Texas-San Antonio.

FOUR SEASONS AS A ROADRUNNER: Owens spent all four seasons of his college career at UTSA. He was 14-7 with four saves and a 4.76 ERA in 63 games – 22 starts – in college. Owens had 196 strikeouts in 181-2/3 innings at Texas-San Antonio.

VICTORIAN AGE: Owens pitched three summers for the Victoria Generals of the Texas Collegiate League and went 10-1 with a 2.76 ERA in eighteen games – fourteen starts with the Generals.

NO PRO: Owens did not pitch professionally after signing with the Brewers. He was 7-2 with three saves in 21 games – fourteen starts – as he helped the Roadrunners make the NCAA tournament and advance to a Super Regional against the UCLA Bruins in his final season.

NAILED IT DOWN: Owens earned the save against Texas in the Austin Regional on [May 31, 2025](#). He allowed a run on a hit with seven strikeouts over the final four innings to lock down a 9-7 win over the Longhorns. Owens was named to the All-Regional Team for his performance.

A MAJOR AWARD: The Brewers named Owens as their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May.

LAST APPEARANCE: Owens pitched three innings of relief against Quad Cities in game one of this series on [June 16](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and three strikeouts for the save.

LAST START: Owens had a no decision against Great Lakes at home on [June 9](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Owens is 1-0 in his lone start against theernels this season. He earned the win at Cedar Rapids on [June 3](#) by allowing one run on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

LHP DASAN HILL: The Minnesota Twins selected Hill in Competitive Balance Round-B with the 69th pick of the 2024 draft out of Grapevine (TX) High School.

GOING PRO: Hill signed with the Twins over a commitment to Dallas Baptist University. He made his professional debut in 2025 with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. He was 0-2 with a 2.77 ERA in sixteen games and 68 strikeouts over 52 innings before a promotion to Cedar Rapids on August 11, 2025. Hill was 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA in three regular season starts for the Kernels.

RATINGS BOARDS: *Baseball America* places Hill as the #5 prospect in Minnesota's system. MLB Pipeline has him at #6 in their ranking of Twins prospects.

PLAYOFF HERO: Hill was the starting pitcher for Game Two of the Western Final for the Kernels against the Beloit Sky Carp at Cedar Rapids on [September 11, 2025](#). He allowed two runs on two hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over five innings to earn the win and force Game Three against Beloit.

LAST START: Hill lost at Lansing on [June 9](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on six hits with three walks and six strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hill lost to the Timber Rattlers in Cedar Rapids on [June 3](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.
