**ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-3 at Perfect Game Field.](#)**

Wisconsin hit three solo home runs in the game. The Kernels broke a 3-3 tie when Aaron Sabato hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the fifth inning.

**FAST START:** Tyler Black hit a home run to start the game. Black is 9-for-25 with five walks in the first innings this season. He has an OPS of .987 in the first innings during 2022.

**BACK TO EVEN:** Wisconsin trailed 3-1 after Will Holland drove in two runs with a triple and scored on a throwing error on the play with two outs in the bottom of the third. The Rattlers tied the game on solo home run by Wes Clarke in the fourth and Tristan Peters in the fifth.

**FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** Sabato's three run home run in the fifth inning came against Wisconsin starting pitcher Antoine Kelly. The homer was the first allowed by Kelly this season. He had not given up a home run in his first 43-2/3 innings in 2022.

**ADDING UP:** Kelly had seven strikeouts last night. He is tied with teammate Brandon Knarr for second in the Midwest League in strikeouts (60). Connor Phillips of Dayton is the league leader with 66 strikeouts.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodriguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Alerick Soularie (#24), Cade Povich (#26), and Christian Encarnacion-Strand (#28).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP RYNE MOORE:** The Brewers selected Moore in the 18<sup>th</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of Old Dominion University.

**THE MONARCH:** Moore went 9-1 with a 3.16 ERA in seventeen games – fourteen starts – in his final season at ODU. He was also named a Second Team All-Conference USA selection in 2021.

**AM I BLUE?** Moore began his professional career with Milwaukee's Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League after signing his professional contract. He made six appearances – two starts – and allowed a run on four hits over 12-2/3 innings for Brewers Blue.

**IN MY MIND I'M GOING TO CAROLINA:** Moore started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in six starts in the Carolina League. Moore walked eleven and struck out 38 over 35 innings for the Mudcats.

**WELCOME TO WISCONSIN:** Moore joined the Timber Rattlers on May 12, 2022.

**LAST START:** Moore [lost to the Kernels on May 24 in game one of this series](#). He allowed eight runs – seven earned – on eight hits with two walks and two strikeouts over three innings pitched.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** The game on May 24 is the only time Moore has faced the Kernels in his career. That was also the first time he pitched against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP SEAN MOONEY:** The Minnesota Twins selected Mooney in the 12<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft out of St. John's University.

**JOHNNIES:** Mooney pitched three years at St. John's. He was 21-6 and a 2.13 ERA in 41 games – 38 starts – and had 249 strikeouts over 244-2/3 innings during his career at St. John's.

**AS A FRESHMAN:** Mooney was the Big East Pitcher of the Year and the Big East Freshman of the Year in his first season at St. John's. He was 8-2 with a 1.71 ERA in sixteen games – thirteen starts as a freshman.

**TOMMY JOHNNIE:** Mooney was 2-1 in nine starts with a 2.17 ERA in his final season for the Red Storm, but he missed the final six weeks of the 2019 season at St. John's due to Tommy John Surgery.

**STARTING OUT:** Mooney started his professional career with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Low-A Southeast in 2021. He was 0-1 with a 1.24 ERA in ten games – nine starts – with 52 strikeouts in 29 innings pitched before his promotion to Cedar Rapids. Mooney went 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA in six regular season starts for the Kernels in 2021. Mooney lost his one postseason start for Cedar Rapids during the 2021 playoffs.

**LAST START:** Mooney [had a no decision at home against Lake County on May 17](#). He allowed one hit with three walks and six strikeouts over five scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Mooney had [a no decision at Wisconsin on September 10, 2021](#). He allowed three runs on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings. Joey Wiemer hit a three-run home run off Mooney in the first inning of that game.
