### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 9-4 at Dozer Park.](#)

Eduarqui Fernández, Gregory Barrios, and Matt Wood hit solo homers for the Timber Rattlers. Terence Doston had a pair of doubles, drove in two runs, and scored a run. Luis Lara stole three bases. There was a 67-minute rain delay after the bottom of the sixth inning with the Rattlers leading 7-2. Both teams scored two runs after the game was restarted. Wisconsin has won three in a row.

**GOING DEEP:** Wisconsin had not homered in their first six games against the Chiefs. Fernández blasted his homer in the third inning to put the Rattlers up 4-2. Barrios hit his shot with one out in the fifth. Wood cracked his dinger with two outs in the fifth. Peoria scored all their runs last night on two-run homers. Leonardo Bernal hit one with two outs in the fifth. Dakota Harris hit his with one out in the eighth. The Chiefs have scored seven runs in the last two games on three two-run homers and a solo home run.

**THE PEN IS MIGHTY:** Wisconsin's bullpen has allowed three runs – two earned – over 19-1/3 innings over the first four games of the series in Peoria. The bullpen has walked four in the series.

**YERLIN OF LIVING DANGEROUSLY:** Reliever Yerlin Rodriguez pitched a scoreless ninth inning with a walk and a strikeout last night for the Rattlers. He has made seven appearances with Wisconsin in 2024. Rodriguez has allowed two hits, walked seven, and struck out ten without allowing a run over seven innings.

**SETTING A MARK:** Brett Wichrowski set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven in 3-2/3 innings last night as the Wisconsin starter.

**NUMBER NINE:** Terence Doston was 2-for-4 in the ninth spot of Wisconsin's order last night. In his last four games, Doston has been on base eight times with three hits, four walks, and a fielder's choice. Doston has scored seven runs in his last four games.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jadhler Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has nine active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#7), Won-Bin Cho (#9), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#22), Pete Hansen (#26), Joshua Baez (#29), and William Sullivan (#30).

**THE CHIEFS SO FAR:** Peoria is 7-12 to start the season. The Chiefs avoided a six-game sweep at Quad Cities with a win on Sunday afternoon over the River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. Peoria's only home series prior to this one with Wisconsin was against Beloit from April 9 through April 14. The Chiefs were 4-2 in that series with the Sky Carp.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARDS:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

**BACK IN 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST SEASON:** Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision at home against Cedar Rapids on [April 20](#). He allowed four runs on three hits and two walks with two strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.

**VS. PEORIA (2024):** Cornielle won at home on [April 6](#) against the Chiefs. He allowed two runs on four hits over five innings with two walks and three strikeouts.

## PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP PETE HANSEN:** The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hansen in the third round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Texas.

**THE EYES OF TEXAS:** Hansen went 22-4 with a 2.67 ERA and 218 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings in his career with the Longhorns. He was 11-3 with 120 strikeouts over 107-2/3 innings in his final season at Texas.

**SHUTDOWN MODE:** Hansen signed with St. Louis on July 23, 2022 and did not pitch professionally until the 2023 season.

**GET IT STARTED:** Hansen began his career with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League in 2023. He went 11-3 with a 3.09 ERA and 126 strikeouts over 112-2/3 innings pitched over 23 starts last season.

**MEMPHIS IN THE MEANTIME:** Hansen made a relief appearance for the Memphis Redbirds, the Triple-A Affiliate of the Cardinals on [September 24, 2023](#). He pitched a scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and no strikeouts for a no decision.

**STACKING AWARDS:** Hansen was the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on August 13, 2023, a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star, and an MiLB.com St. Louis Cardinals Organizational All Star last year.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** Hansen is rated as the #26 prospect in the St. Louis system by MLB Pipeline and the #28 Cardinals prospect by *Baseball America*.

**LAST START:** Hansen lost at Quad Cities on [April 20](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Hansen made the start at Wisconsin on [April 7](#). He allowed three runs on seven hits, walked two, struck out four, and hit a batter over 4-2/3 innings for a no decision.
