ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-4 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Beloit rallied from a 2-1 deficit with three runs in the top of the sixth inning and added two runs in the top of the eighth. Wisconsin scored twice in the ninth and had the tying runs in scoring position with one out but could not make up the difference. Ernesto Martínez Jr homered, walked, stole a base, and drove in two runs for Wisconsin. and Brady Allen both had two RBI for Beloit.

IT HAPPENED AGAIN: Beloit has scored in the first inning in five of the six meetings between the Rattlers and Sky Carp this season. Beloit has scored seven runs in the first inning against the Rattlers in 2023.

CRUZ CONTROL: Wisconsin starting pitcher Stiven Cruz pitched five innings last night. He allowed one run on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts. Cruz was in line for the win, but the Sky Carp rallied after he had left the game.

STEPPING IN AND STEPPING UP: Jose Acosta was 2-for-3 with an RBI last night. Since replacing Eric Brown Jr as a pinch runner in the first inning on Wednesday, Acosta is 5-for-6 and has been on base six times in seven plate appearances.

FIRST OF MANY? Darrien Miller was hit by a pitch for the first time this season when Edgar Sanchez plunked him in the fourth inning. Miller set the Timber Rattlers single season record for being hit by pitches when he was hit 24 times last year. Miller also had two hits last night for his first multi-hit game of 2023.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Milwaukee Brewers reliever Gus Varland is with the Timber Rattlers for a rehabilitation assignment. Varland, a Rule 5 draft selection of the Brewers out of the Los Angeles Dodgers organization last December, went on Milwaukee's injured list on April 16 after he was hit on his right hand and face by a liner at San Diego on April 15. Varland allowed three runs on three hits and a walk last night and took the loss. He also took another line drive last night when the Jacob Berry got Varland on the left wrist and heel of the glove.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games - eighteen starts - during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games - one start - for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances - two starts - with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner earned the win at Quad Cities on April 22. He allowed a run on a hit with two walks and five strikeouts over six innings.

VS. BELOIT: Woessner has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

#### BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ZACH KING: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the thirteenth round of the 2019 draft out of Vanderbilt.

THE COMMODORE: King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games - six starts - over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

AS A PRO (2019): King was 2-0 in six games – three starts – with the Gulf Coast League Marlins after he signed his professional contract. King walked seven and struck out 17 over 16-1/3 innings in the GCL in

BEAUTIFUL BELOIT: King made sixteen starts for the Beloit Snappers in 2021. He was 2-9 with a 5.88 ERA and 104 strikeouts in 99-1/3 innings pitched.

FROM 2022 UNTIL NOW: King was 4-3 with a 2.77 ERA in twelve starts for the Sky Carp before a promotion to the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, Miami's Southern League affiliate, last season. He was 2-6 with an 8.22 ERA in eleven starts for Pensacola last year and 0-2 with an 11.37 ERA in three starts this year before returning to the Sky Carp this week.

LAST START: King lost to Birmingham at home as the starter for Pensacola on April 23. He allowed seven runs - five earned - on two hits and four walks without retiring a batter.

VS. WISCONSIN: King has made five starts against the Rattlers over his 2021 and 2022 seasons with Beloit. In 2021, King was 1-1 and allowed ten runs on fourteen hits with seventeen strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings in three starts versus Wisconsin. In 2022, King was 0-1 in two starts and gave up seven runs - five earned - with eleven strikeouts in nine innings.
