JULY, 2025:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Lake County Captains 5-4 in ten innings at Neuroscience Group Field. The game was tied 3-3 after nine innings. The Captains scored a run on an error in the top of the tenth. In the bottom of the tenth, Eduardo Garcia drove in the tying run with a two-out, bloop single. Blake Burke drove in the game winner with a single on a 3-2 pitch moments later.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: Wisconsin recorded their seventh walkoff win of the season last night. Burke has two walkoff hits in 2025 with the Rattlers. He also had a walkoff single against the Peoria Chiefs on May 27. CALIENTE: Garcia went 3-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored last night. He is 8-for-14 (.571) with a 1.243

OPS in the first three games of this series. GREAT START: Manuel Rodriguez was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers last night. He gave up a home run to Alfonsin Rosario with one out in the first inning. Rodriguez retired seventeen of the last eighteen batters he faced in the game with a lead-off single by Maick Collado in the third inning the only other base runner he allowed. Rodriguez struck out four and earned a quality start but picked up a no decision after leaving the game with a 3-1 lead.

BACK TO EVEN: Lake County rallied to tie the game with two runs in the top of the seventh inning against Jesús Broca. The first four batters of the inning reached on two singles, an RBI double, and a walk. Juan Benjamin drove in the tying run with a sacrifice fly. Broca kept the game tied by retiring the next two batters in the seventh. Aaron Rund stranded a runner in the eighth by getting the final two outs of that frame and pitching a 1-2-3 ninth to get the game to extra innings.

GOOD-BYE TO JULY: Wisconsin closed out a rough month with their win last night. The Rattlers went 9-15 and were outscored 126-84 during July. Last month, Wisconsin hit .220 with an OPS of .621. Pitchers had an ERA of 4.71 with 197 strikeouts and 107 walks in 210-1/3 innings.

ABOUT THE LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS: Lake County joined the Midwest League in 2010 from the South Atlantic League. They started out as the Columbus RedStixx in Georgia before moving to Eastlake, Ohio after the 2002 season. The Captains are the Midwest League affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The franchise has been affiliated with Cleveland since it was known as the Columbus Indians in 1991. Lake County won the Midwest League title in 2010 and lost to Kane County in the 2014 Midwest League Championship Series. They were the East Division Champions in 2022 and lost to the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League Championship Series. Lake County defeated the Timber Rattlers in the 2024 Midwest League Championship Series.

ABOUT THE GUARDIANS: Cleveland was the parent club of the old Appleton Papermakers in 1941, 1942, and 1946. Mike Garcia was the most notable Papermaker to play of the Indians. Cleveland's affiliation history in the Midwest League dates includes the Dubuque Packers from 1962-64 and Waterloo from 1977-1988 before the Captains.

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TANNER GILLIS: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

ON THE HORIZON: Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY? Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

LAST START: Gillis had a no decision at Quad Cities on <u>July 26</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. LAKE COUNTY: Gillis has never faced the Captains prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians.

LAKE COUNTY STARTING PITCHER:

LHP JACKSON HUMPHRIES: The Cleveland Guardians selected Humphries in the eighth round of the 2022 draft out of Fuquay-Varina (NC) High School.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline has Humphries ranked as the #19 prospect in the Cleveland system after the trade deadline update.

MMM. MMM. NOPE: Humphries had committed to pitch at Campbell University before signing with the Guardians.

PRO CAREER PRE-2025: Humphries did not pitch professionally in 2022. He split time between the ACL Complex and Lynchburg in the Carolina League in 2023 and was 0-7 with a 5.49 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts. Humphries spent the entire 2024 season in Lynchburg and was 3-6 with a 4.56 ERA in 23 starts. He walked 41 and struck out 97 I 79 innings pitched for the Hillcats last season.

LAST START: Humphries had a no decision against Lansing at home on <u>July 26</u>. He allowed a run on a hit with two walks and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Humphries has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made two starts – <u>June 27</u> and <u>August 27</u> – against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers in 2024. Humphries was 0-1 and allowed four runs on seven hits with six walks and ten strikeouts over seven innings in those two starts.
