ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians were overcome by a three-run home run and an eighth-inning grand slam as the Columbus Clippers came out on top in Game 2 of their six-game set at Huntington Park, 9-2. With the game knotted at 2 in the bottom of the sixth inning, Kahlil Watson sparked Columbus' rally with a two-out double. Cooper Ingle followed with a walk and Dom Nunez cleared the bases with a three-run shot to right field off Sean Sullivan to put Columbus on top. After four scoreless frames, the two teams traded blows before the Clippers' knockout punch in the seventh. Mike Jarvis opened the scoring with a solo home run to give Indy a brief 1-0 lead in the fifth inning. Columbus responded in their half of the fifth by loading the bases on a pair of walks and a single. Petey Halpin then came through with a two-out, two-RBI single to grant the Clippers a 2-1 advantage. Indy quickly worked to tie the game in the top of the sixth before Columbus' critical frame. Nelson Velazquez reached on a one-out single and was brought home on a Rafael Flores double one batter later. Columbus broke the game wide open in the eighth, loading the bases on two walks and a double and cashing in with a 108.5-mpg grand slam from Milan Tolentino.

JARVIS JAMS: Mike Jarvis opened the scoring in last night's contest with his first home run of the campaign. To conclude a nine-pitch battle with Ryan Webb, Jarvis launched a 3-2 cutter 106.8 mph and 418 feet to left center field. It was his first Triple-A homer since a 411-foot blast on May 29, 2024, with Indianapolis vs. Omaha, surpassing that one as the farthest hit ball of his professional career.

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores went 3-for-4 with one double and one RBI in last night's contest, marking his second straight game with multiple hits and ninth on the campaign (7 with Indy). He has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 contests since Aug. 20 at Syracuse. Across this span, he is hitting .408 (20-for-49) with two doubles, a triple, five homers, 15 RBI and a 1.240 OPS. In 26 games with the Indians since being traded from New York (AL), Flores is hitting .306 (30-for-98) with 12 runs, four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 20 RBI, 11 walks and a .901 OPS.

FULL NELSON: Outfielder Nelson Velazquez signed with Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on Tuesday and has made a splash in his first two games with Indianapolis. He went 2-for-4 with a run in last night's contest. In Tuesday's series opener, he hit a game-winning home run in his first contest with Indianapolis. With the game tied, 3-3, in the eighth inning, Velazquez worked to a 3-1 count against Bradley Hanner. Hanner threw a fastball down Broadway that Velazquez cranked 106.2 mph and 413 feet into deep right center field to give the Indians their winning runs. It was his sixth homer on the campaign and first since May 17 with Omaha. After being released by Omaha on May 28, Velazquez spent the last several months with the Guerreros de Oaxaca in the Mexican League.

ALIKA-LINE BATTERY: Alike Williams continued his hot stretch last night tallying a single in the contest. In 26 games since Aug. 1, Williams is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with 20 runs, three doubles, one triple, seven homers, 20 RBI, eight walks, two stolen bases and a .913 OPS. This year propelled Williams to being named the Indianapolis Indians August Player of the Month. He blasted his ninth home run of the season in on Tuesday's series opener. Williams expanded his Triple-A career best total and is one shy of his single-team, single-season high of 10 home runs in 2022 with High-A Bowling Green.

BRETT BASH: Brett Sullivan extended his on-base streak to nine games last night dating back to Aug. 13. In this span, he is hitting .250 (7-for-28) with seven runs, one double, one triple, two home runs, four RBI, eight walks, one stolen base and a .988 OPS. He went 0-for-3 with a walk and has taken a free pass in eight of those nine games, and hit safely in six of them. Additionally, he has walked in four straight games, marking the second four-game walking streak in his current on-base run. Prior to this, Sullivan had not walked in four consecutive contests since a five-game streak from Sept. 12-18, 2024, with Triple-A El Paso.

BRANDAN BLANKS: Brandon Bidois is yet to allow a run in his Triple-A career and has opened the 2025 season with four scoreless appearances. In this span, he has not allowed a hit across 5.2 innings with four walks and five strikeouts. Among all minor league pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched, he has the lowest batting average against (.118, 21-for-178), lowest OPS against (.365), second-lowest ERA (0.84) and second-lowest hits per nine (3.52) among minor league pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched. In addition to these stats, he has an 8-0 record across 35 appearances.

BUCCO ABOARD: Right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence had his rehab assignment transferred from Single-A Bradenton prior to last Tuesday's series opener vs. Buffalo. Lawrence, 30, did not allow a run in 10 of 11 appearances with Pittsburgh before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 24 and being transferred to the 60-day IL on May 3 with right elbow inflammation. Lawrence made two appearances with Bradenton prior to his transfer to Indy. In three games with the Indians on the rehab assignment, he has allowed three earned runs across 3.0 innings with four strikeouts.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series at Huntington Park with the Columbus Clippers at 6:35 PM. RHP Drake Fellows is set to make his 30th appearance and 16th start of the season. He tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball in his last outing on Aug. 29 vs. Buffalo. It was his longest outing since a career-high 7.0 innings on July 1, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Harrisburg. It is set to be Fellows third appearance against the Clippers this season. In four career games (3 starts) against the club, he is 1-0 with a 5.93 ERA (9er/13.2ip) with 12 hits, six walks and 11 strikeouts. Opposite Fellows is Columbus RHP Aaron Davenport. Davenport earned the win at Columbus vs. Indy on June 21, tossing 5.2 innings of one-run ball. It was his lone career appearance against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 1993: On Razor Shines Appreciation Night at Bush Stadium, the fan favorite concluded his nine-year career with the Indians with an eighth-inning single that propelled Indianapolis to a nine-run rally and 13-4 comeback victory. Shines ended his career in Indianapolis ranked among Indians franchise leaders with 68 home runs (T-3rd), 404 RBI (4th) and 138 doubles (5th).

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 16th start of the season and his 36th career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball in his last outing on Aug. 29 vs. Buffalo. It was his longest outing since a career-high 7.0 innings on July 1, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Harrisburg.

Against the Clippers: In four career games (3 starts) against the club, he is 1-0 with a 5.93 ERA (9er/13.2ip) with 12 hits, six walks and 11 strikeouts.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliever to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University... Acquired by Pittsburgh from San Diego on Jan. 19, 2021 with RHP David Bednar, OF Hudson Head and LHP Omar Cruz in exchange for RHP Joe Musgrove; New York (NL) recieved LHP Joey Lucchesi from San Diego and sent C Endy Rodríguez to Pittsburgh.
