# FAYETTEVILLE WOODPECKERS (30-32) vs. AUGUSTA GREENJACKETS (34-29)

TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) open up their second straight series at Segra Stadium against the Augusta GreenJackets (Low-A Braves). The two teams split their first series of the season back in April at SRP Park as the first three games of this series will wrap up the first half of their respective Carolina League schedules. RHP Carlos Calderon gets the ball for Fayetteville while Augusta starts their ace, RHP J.J.

THE OPPONENTS: The GreenJackets are in their second season as a member of the Low-A East/Carolina League as well as their second season as an Atlanta Braves affiliate. Prior to 2021, the GreenJackets in the then-Low-A South Atlantic League with the San Francisco Giants from 2004-2020, winning the league championship in 2008. Augusta also was affiliated with the Boston Red Sox (1999-2004) and the Pittsburgh Pirates (1984-1998), known as the Augusta Pirates from 1988 to 1993 after moving from Macon, GA after the 1987 season.

SATURDAY IS FOR THE PECKERS: This season, Saturday has been very kind to the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. With a doubleheader sweep over the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers on Saturday, the Woodpeckers have improved to 8-4 on Saturdays this season. Additionally, Fayetteville has only lost once on Saturday at Segra Stadium in 2022 over the course of five games played and have not lost a Saturday game at home since their first home series of the year against the Salem Red Sox. The Woodpeckers have also outscored opponents 69-58 on Saturday through a dozen contests.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 62 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 61 long-balls, nine more than the next closest team. 26 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 35 on the road, the most road homers of any team in the league. Additionally, the Woodpeckers have already hit 15 home runs in the month of June and are on pace for their most prolific month of the season in terms of power.

**DON'T FALL BEHIND:** Woodpeckers outfielder Joey Loperfido leads the team in batting average (.303), hits (60), and doubles (12), but he also is among the league's best in another unique category. When ahead in the count, Loperfido is hitting .421 this season, the highest batting average in that situation by a qualifying player still active in the Carolina League. He also is tied with Salem's Niko Kavadas for the most doubles (8) when in a favorable count to go along with 37 total bases, tied for tenth in the league.

**ULLOLA? OOH LA LA!:** RHP Miguel Ullola has quickly become one of the more reliable arms of the Woodpeckers' pitching staff. In 24.2 innings pitched this season, Ullola has a 1.82 earned run average, the lowest of any Fayetteville pitcher to work at least ten innings in 2022. Additionally, he has not given up an earned run since May 22 in Kannapolis, a 15-inning span.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: As the first half of 2022 wraps up, the Fayetteville Woodpeckers pitching staff finds themselves atop a number of categories in the Carolina League. The Woodpeckers have allowed the fewest hits (411) in the league this year and are tied with the Lynchburg Hillcats for the most strikeouts (687) as a team. Fayetteville also has the lowest opponent batting average (.206) across the Caorlina League this season

MOST LEADS ARE SAFE: Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 23-2 when leading after seven innings and 25-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-24 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-5 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a 5-3 road win against the Down East Wood Ducks.

**Recap**: The Woodpeckers rode a sublime start from Edinson Batista to a win in the series finale against Kannapolis that secured a split for Fayetteville. The Cannon Ballers made a late push with one in the seventh and two in the eighth, but reliever Freylin Garcia shut the door on them for his second save.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach. Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Grevs and the Gary-Southshore Railcats.
