### INDY BITS

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** The Indianapolis Indians were swept by the Toledo Mud Hens in a 7.0-inning doubleheader at Fifth Third Field on Thursday night. Toledo took Game 1, 2-1, and shut out Indy, 5-0, in Game 2. In Game 1, the Indians took a 1-0 lead in the second inning when Matt Gorski poked a solo home run to right field for his fourth homer of the campaign. The Mud Hens struck back for a pair of runs in the fifth inning off Thomas Harrington, first with a game-tying solo home run by Bligh Madris. After Ryan Kreidler was hit by a pitch and Stephen Scott walked, Riley Unroe delivered the game-winning hit with an RBI double. Mud Hens starting pitcher Austin Bergner allowed just the solo shot across 3.0 innings, with Jordan Balazovic earning the win with two scoreless innings in relief. Matt Gage tossed a scoreless ninth inning for his first save of the season to cap a 2-1 Toledo win. In Game 2, Indianapolis was held to just two hits in a 5-0 loss. Nick Dombkowski allowed three runs in 2.0 innings as the opener and Carson Fulmer followed him in relief with 2.1 innings of two-run ball. Enns blanked the Indians for 4.0 innings, striking out eight, while Ricky Vanasco earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings and five strikeouts.

**PEN IS MIGHTY:** In May, the Indians bullpen is 7-0 and are pacing Triple-A clubs in ERA (2.00, 16er/72.0ip), WHIP (0.97), opponent's batting average (.195, 50-for-256) and strikeout-to-walk-ratio (3.95, 79 K/20 BB). Eight of the Indians 13 relievers used in the month have a sub-.200 ERA, including five who have not allowed a run. Indy's bullpen is one of two in Triple-A and one of three in all of full-season Minor League Baseball to have not sustained a loss in May. On the season, Indy's bullpen is 16-5, good for a .762 winning percentage which ranks third among Triple-A bullpens.

**QUÉ LO QUE:** Rehabber Endy Rodríguez tagged a game-tying two-run homer off RHP Aaron Wilkerson in the sixth inning of Sunday's victory vs. Louisville. It was his second two-run homer in as many days, as he clubbed his first off RHP Alan Busenitz in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. He began his rehab assignment on May 14 after being placed on the 10-day injured list on April 15 with a right-hand laceration, sustained when struck by a pitch in the dirt on April 14 vs. Washington.

**HOOSIER HAMMERS HENS:** Matt Gorski smacked his fourth homer of the season in Game 1 of yesterday's doubleheader, adding to an impressive résumé against the Mud Hens. Since the beginning of the 2024 season, Gorski leads all hitters against the Mud Hens in home runs (7), RBI (25), extra-base hits (18) and total bases (61). The Indiana University alum also ranks among hitters vs. the Mud Hens (min. 50 PA) in OPS (2nd, 1.075), slugging percentage (2nd, .693) and batting average (5th, .318, 28-for-88). Since 2022, the Indians rank second among all Mud Hens opponents in OPS (.816) and fourth in batting average (.276).

**HE GETS ON (BAE)SE:** Ji Hwan Bae is currently riding a 20-game on-base streak dating back to April 13 at Louisville. It's the longest on-base streak by an Indians hitter this season and is tied for the eighth-longest active on-base streak in all of Triple-A. Bae's streak includes a stretch from April 15 to May 6 in which he hit safely in 15 of 17 games. In that stretch, he hit .300 (21-for-70) and tied for the team lead in extra-base hits (6) while scoring 18 runs, which ranked third in all of Triple-A in that span.

**TWO MORE BUCCOS ABOARD:** In addition to Endy Rodríguez, the Indians roster also boasts two additional major league rehabbers in Dauri Moreta and Nick Gonzales. Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. He excelled in 94 games with Pittsburgh last season, hitting .270 (97-for-359) with 19 doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 49 RBI. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since allowed two runs while striking out nine in 6.0 innings (seven appearances) with Indy.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians look to avoid a series loss as they take on the Toledo Mud Hens in game four of a six-game set on Friday night at 7:05 PM from Fifth Third Field. A series loss would be Indy's first in a six-game series since their first full series of the season against Iowa from April 1-6 at Victory Field. Since then, the Indians have won three series, split two and won three games in a seven-game set at St. Paul. Righty Carmen Mlodzinski will take the mound for the Indians for the first time this season after being optioned from Pittsburgh on May 21. This will mark Mlodzinski's first-career Triple-A start after making 36 relief appearances with the Indians from 2021-2024. He's made nine starts with the Pirates this season and 50 total starts between all levels in his career. Mlodzinski has made seven appearances against Toledo and has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (2er/8.0ip) with nine strikeouts. He will duel against Toledo righty Wilkel Hernandez, who faced the Indians for the first time in his career earlier this season. In that start, he allowed one run and two hits across 5.0 innings while striking out eight.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1998:** For the second time in five days, Indians center fielder Pat Watkins recorded a four-hit game en route to an Indianapolis win. Tied at 4-4 through seven innings, the Indians plated eight runs in the eighth and two in the ninth to run away with a 14-4 victory at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Indy had 20 hits as a team, with Watkins and shortstop Damian Jackson accounting for eight of the knocks. Watkins had three doubles, and the Indians tallied nine extra-base hits in total (seven doubles, one triple, one home run).

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Carmen Mlodzinski:** Mlodzinski is set to make his season debut and first career start with Indianapolis after being optioned on May 21.

**Bucco Aboard:** In nine starts with the Pittsburgh this season, Mlodzinski posted a 1-4 record, 5.67 ERA (25er/39.2ip), 52 hits, 12 walks and 28 strikeouts. He has appeared in 84 games (14 starts) with the Pirates since 2023, posting a 9-12 record, 3.78 ERA (53er/126.1ip), 121 hits, 29 walks, four hit batters and 108 strikeouts.

**Indianapolis:** Mlodzinski made 15 appearances for the Indians last season, posting an 0-1 record and 6.75 ERA (13er/17.1ip) pitching exclusively from the bullpen. In 36 career games with Indy, he is 2-4 with a 4.50 ERA (23er/46.0ip) with 51 hits, 22 walks, two hit batters and 51 strikeouts.

**Last Outing:** Mlodzinski took his fourth loss of the season on May 17 at Philadelphia, extending his losing streak to a major league career-high three decisions. He tossed 3.1 innings with a season-high tying seven hits, four runs, one walk and two strikeouts.

**Against the Mud Hens:** Mlodzinski has made seven career appearances against Toledo, logging a 1-0 record, 2.25 ERA (2er/8.0ip), six hits, three walks and nine strikeouts.

**Major League Debut:** Mlodzinski made his major league debut with Pittsburgh on June 16, 2023, at Milwaukee, tossing 1.1 innings. He allowed a solo home run to Joey Wiemer and struck out Blake Perkins looking for his first career punchout.

**Miscellaneous:** Mlodzinski was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (31st overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of South Carolina University (Columbia).
