### INDY BITS

**ABOUT SUNDAY:** The Indianapolis Indians concluded their rain-shortened five-game series against the Iowa Cubs on Sunday, dropping the series three games to two. Friday's game four was suspended, 3-3, in the top of the 10th inning due to inclement weather and was resumed on Sunday. Right-hander Carson Fulmer shined in his Indians debut on Friday, tossing 5.0 shutout innings on five hits, no walks and six strikeouts. Indianapolis took a 3-0 lead in the third inning until the I-Cubs stormed back to knot the game in the seventh inning. After the game was resumed in the top of the 10th inning, the I-Cubs posted a run in the top of the frame to take the advantage. The Indians rallied for two runs in the bottom half of the frame to walk off winners. Malcom Nuñez tied the game, 4-4, with an RBI single and Nick Solak ended the game with a ground ball single between third base and shortstop.

**MORE ABOUT SUNDAY:** After the walk-off in the resumed game, the Indians took a 4-1 loss in the series finale on Sunday afternoon. Starting pitcher Mike Burrows made his second start of the season, tossing 2.1 innings of one-run ball with two strikeouts. Right-hander David Bednar made his season debut, tossing a scoreless fifth inning with one strikeout. The I-Cubs posted a first-inning run before Bryce Johnson knotted the game in the second inning with an RBI groundout. Iowa then scored three unanswered runs to seal the game.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indians kick off a six-game road set against the Louisville Bats tonight at 6:35 PM in MiLB TV's Free Game of the Day. Taking the mound for the Indians is right-hander Bubba Chandler. The Pirates top farmhand is set to make his second start of the season after tossing 2.2 shutout innings on April 3 vs. Iowa. It marks his second career start opposite Louisville, last tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball (0er) with five strikeouts on Aug. 28 (1), 2024. Facing off with Chandler is Bats right-hander Chase Petty. Petty took the loss in his season debut, allowing a career-high tying six runs (MR: 7/31/22 with Dayton at West Michigan) across 3.1 innings on April 2 at Omaha. The Indians went 12-9 against the Bats last season including an 8-2 record at Victory Field. Indianapolis seeks their fourth consecutive win as the away team against the Bats, with one of the three straight being a Victory Field contest on Aug. 28 of last season.

**THE THRILL OF IT:** The Indians walked off winners in game two and game four of last week's series vs. Iowa. In game two on Thursday, the Indians walked off in the first contest of a seven-inning doubleheader, with the game going to extras in the eighth inning. Malcom Nuñez stepped to the plate as a pinch hitter in the bottom of the eighth and delivered a game-winning fielders' choice. It was the Indians first pinch-hit walk-off plate appearance since Christian Bethancourt's decisive RBI single in the 10th inning on June 30, 2021 vs. Iowa. In Sunday's resumed contest, Nick Solak won the game with an RBI single through the left side.

**NO FLY ZONE:** The Indianapolis Indians have not allowed a home run through six games and 51.0 innings this season. It is the team's longest stretch of games without allowing a homer in the Victory Field era.

**GONDOLA GORSKI:** Matt Gorski has reached base safely in all six of the Indians games this season and is riding a team-high five-game hitting streak. In those six games he is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and a 1.085 OPS. He launched his first home run of the season in Game 1 on Thursday, following DJ Stewart's three-run bomb for a set of back-to-back blasts in the third inning. He has an extra-base hit in three consecutive games, recording one double in each contest.

**TWO YORKE CITY:** Nick Yorke posted three doubles across Thursday's doubleheader, going 3-for-7 with one walk, one run and one RBI on the day. Through four games this season, Yorke is hitting .333 (5-for-15) with a .412 OBP. He has a hit in four consecutive games and has reached base safely two-plus times in three straight contests. Yorke was placed on the 7-day injured list on April 4 with right shoulder soreness.

**YOUNG BUCS:** Six prospects ranked among the Pirates top 30 according to MLB Pipeline began the season in Triple-A, led by right-hander Bubba Chandler as the organization's No. 1 (MLB's No. 15) overall farmhand. It marks the second consecutive year that the Pirates top prospect will begin the season with the Indians, following right-hander and 2024 MLB Rookie of the Year Paul Skenes. Other prospects on the 2025 Opening Day roster include utilityman Nick Yorke (No. 5), Opening Day starter and right-hander Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), right-hander Mike Burrows (No. 15), infielder Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 17) and outfielder Billy Cook (No. 18). Last season, the Indians featured six of the Pirates top 30 prospects (according to *Baseball America*).

**ON THIS DATE IN 2002:** Trailing 8-0 after 4 1/2 innings, the Indians plated four runs in the fifth, two in the sixth and five in the eighth to rally past Toledo at Victory Field, 11-8. Shortstop Bill Hall had a game-high three hits, right fielder Izzy Alcantara homered and drove in four runs, and third baseman Rob Sasser and catcher Marcus Jensen each went yard for Indy.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Bubba Chandler:** Right-hander Bubba Chandler is set to make his second start of the season tonight at Louisville. He is currently rated the No. 15 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. He made seven starts for the Indians last year posting a 1.83 ERA (8er/39.1ip) with 54 strikeouts. He struck out eight-plus batters in four of those seven starts, reached the double digit mark in strikeouts twice and matched a career high with 11 strikeouts on Aug. 16, 2024, at St. Paul.

**Last Outing:** Chandler tossed 2.2 shutout innings on one hit, three walks and four strikeouts in his season debut on April 3 vs. Iowa.

**Against the Bats:** Tonight marks Chandler's second career start opposite Louisville, last tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball (0er) with five strikeouts on Aug. 28 (1), 2024.

**IL Pitcher of the Week:** Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

**EAS Pitcher of the Week:** Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on June 23, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and 10 strikeouts while he secured the win.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. . Selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.

2024 Highlights

- » Was named Indianapolis' May Player of the Month after hitting nine home runs in 23 games, good for a .720 slugging percentage and 1.050 OPS; His nine home runs in the month were the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007.
- » Launched 10 home runs in an 18-game stretch from 5/16-6/2 with a .328 batting average (21-for-64), three doubles, two triples, 27 RBI, .906 slugging percentage and 1.276 OPS; in that time, he led all International League batters in home runs, RBI, slugging percentage, OPS, extra-base hits (15), total bases (58) and triples (T-1st, 2).
