ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and South Bend Cubs were rained out at Four Winds Field. This was the third Timber Rattlers game to be rained out this season. However, Sunday is Wisconsin's first doubleheader. The previous two rainouts were on a Sunday afternoon in the final game between opponents during the first half and were not rescheduled.

LAST ACTION: [The Cubs beat the Rattlers 5-3 Friday night at Four Winds Field.](#) Felix Stevens broke a 2-2 tie with a solo homer in the bottom of the sixth inning. The Cubs added an insurance run in the seventh and eighth innings on two-out, RBI doubles in both innings and held off a last-ditch rally from the Rattlers in the ninth. The Cubs have won three of the first four games in the series. Stevens, who is on a 14-game hitting streak, is 5-for-14 with two homers, three doubles, and eight RBI in this series.

OPENING HIS ACCOUNT: Brock Wilken, the #1 pick of the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2023 Draft, collected his first Timber Rattlers RBI with his first Timber Rattlers hit when he singled in the top of the first to drove in Robert Moore from second base.

STUPID GOPHERS: The Cubs took a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the third inning on a two-run home run by Ezequiel Pagan. Along with Stevens's homer in the sixth, the Cubs have hit five homers in the first four games of the series. South Bend has hit eight of their 59 homers against Wisconsin this season.

JUST SHORT: Wisconsin tied the game 2-2 on an RBI single by Je'Von Ward in the fifth and scored a run on a two-out single Darrien Miller in the ninth to bring the go-ahead run to the plate, but the Rattlers couldn't rally.

TIEBREAKER RULES: The Cubs have taken a 6-4 lead in the season series from the Timber Rattlers with two games remaining between the teams in 2023. South Bend is +22 in the run differential, too. Wisconsin needs to win the last two games of the series by a total of 23 runs to claim the tiebreaker from the Cubs.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend went 30-35 in the first half and finished in fourth place in the West Division, 9-1/2 games behind the Cedar Rapids Royals. The Cubs went 2-8 in the last ten games of the first half. The Cubs were in Peoria before this series started and won the first four games of the series before dropping the final two games to the Chiefs at Dozer Park.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: South Bend won the second half West Division title in 2022 with a 39-26 record 5-1/2 games in front of the Timber Rattlers. The Cubs beat Cedar Rapids 2-1 in the best-of-three West Final and Lake County 2-1 in the best-of-three Championship Series.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Bradley Blalock (#15), Eduardo Garcia (#20), and Matthew Wood (#25). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#4), James Triantos (#11), Michael Arias (#13), Moises Ballesteros (#18), and Ed Howard (#22).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRADLEY BLALOCK: Milwaukee acquired Blalock in exchange for Luis Urias in a trade with the Boston Red Sox on August 1, 2023.

ORIGIN STORY: The Red Sox selected Blalock out of Grayson High School in Loganville, Georgia with their 32nd round pick in the 2019 draft. Blalock signed with Boston over a commitment to Kennesaw State University.

START STOP START STOP: Blalock went 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA in four games – three starts – in the Gulf Coast League in 2019, missed the 2020 season due to the shutdown, was 3-6 with a 4.27 ERA in 23 starts for the Salem Red Sox in 2021, and missed the 2022 season due to Tommy John Surgery in March of 2022.

QUICK MOVES: Blalock returned to action with Salem on [May 24, 2023](#). He was transferred to the Greenville Drive, the South Atlantic League affiliate of the Red Sox, on June 20 and made his High-A debut at Bowling Green on [June 22](#). Blalock was 6-1 with a 2.19 ERA and 58 strikeouts over 53-1/3 innings pitched in eleven starts before the trade to the Brewers.

ON A ROLL: Blalock was 4-0 with a 1.75 ERA and 26 strikeouts over 25-2/3 innings in five starts in July. MLB Pipeline added Blalock to the Milwaukee Top 30 Prospect List at #15 after the trade.

LAST START: Blalock won at Bowling Green on [July 30](#) in his final start for Greenville. He allowed two unearned runs on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Blalock has never pitched against South Bend prior to this afternoon. He made the start at Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on [June 1, 2023](#). Blalock allowed a run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts over four innings for a no decision. Current South Bend Cubs Moises Ballesteros (0-for-1, BB, K) and Felix Stevens (0-for-2, 2K) faced Blalock in that game.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK! Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31. He earned the award by striking out ten Cedar Rapids batters over 7-1/3 scoreless innings on [July 30](#). He walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

LAST START: Jimenez beat Cedar Rapids at home on July 30 with his Award-Winning performance. He set a new pro single-game high for innings pitched and matched his pro single-game high for strikeouts. Wisconsin shut out theernels in a 4-0 win in the game.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Jimenez pitched three innings of scoreless, hitless relief against the Cubs at home on [May 13](#). He struck out two, walked none, and was not involved in the decision.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LUIS DEVERS: The Chicago Cubs signed Devers as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 19, 2017.

TWO SUMMERS: Devers pitched for Chicago's #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and 2019. He was 5-10 with a 2.63 ERA in 28 games – 27 starts. He had 109 strikeouts and 33 walks in 119-2/3 innings in the DSL.

BEFORE SOUTH BEND: Devers started his 2021 season with the ACL Cubs and was 2-4 with a 3.33 ERA and 54 strikeouts over 51-1/3 innings in twelve games – eleven starts – before a promotion to Myrtle Beach at the end of the season. Devers pitched two times in relief for the Pelicans in 2021. Devers started this season with the Pelicans. He was 9-3 with a 2.58 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts. Devers had 75 strikeouts and fourteen walks in 66-1/3 innings before earning a promotion to South Bend on July 4, 2022.

HEADING UP AROUND THE BEND: Devers was 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 51-1/3 innings in eleven games – eight starts for the Cubs last season. He also made two starts with no record during the Cubs playoff run in 2022. Devers started the 2023 season on the 60-day IL of the Tennessee Smokies. He was sent to South Bend and activated on June 6, 2023.

LAST START: Devers beat the Timber Rattlers on [August 1](#) in game one of this series. He allowed one hit, walked none, and struck out six over five scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: The game last Tuesday was Devers first appearance against the Timber Rattlers in 2023. Devers made his Midwest League debut against Wisconsin on [July 6, 2022](#) with three innings of scoreless relief at South Bend. He walked none and struck out three for a no decision. Devers also started at Wisconsin on [August 11, 2022](#). In that game, Devers allowed a run on two hits with two hit batsmen, two walks, and three strikeouts over five innings for a no decision.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CONNOR NOLAND: The Chicago Cubs selected Noland in the ninth round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Arkansas. Noland was a teammate of Timber Rattler Robert Moore at Arkansas.

THE ARK: Noland pitched four seasons with the Razorbacks and was 14-11 with a 3.85 ERA and 202 strikeouts over 225-2/3 innings in 52 games – 41 starts. In his final season at Arkansas, Noland was 8-6 with a 3.65 ERA in 20 games – 19 start – and 113 strikeouts over 116 innings.

TWO-SPORT PLAYER: Noland was recruited to play football at Arkansas and appeared in four games at quarterback in 2018. He made a start against Tulsa on October 20, 2018. Noland was 21-for-42 on passing attempts for 255 yards and one touchdown.

OMAHA! Noland was 1-1 in two starts during the Razorbacks run in the 2022 College World Series. He beat Stanford on June 18 with six strikeouts over 6-2/3 scoreless innings and lost to Mississippi on June 23 despite allowing two runs and striking out seven over eight innings.

GETTING STARTED: Noland did not pitch professionally in 2022. He made his professional debut with South Bend in a [start at home on April 11, 2023 against the Beloit Sky Carp](#). Noland allowed a run on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over four innings for a no decision.

LAST START: Noland had a no decision at Peoria on [July 30](#). He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and six strikeouts over six innings. Francisco Hernandez homered off Noland in the game. The Chiefs would win 5-4 in ten innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Noland has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
