TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) will try to make it three straight victories over the Augusta GreenJackets (Low-A Braves) and move to 2-0 in the second half of the Carolina League season. The Woodpeckers evened the six-game series Friday night with a thrilling 6-5 win over the GreenJackets. RHP Zack Matthews takes the mound for Fayetteville while Augusta seeks revenge with RHP Luis Vargas getting the start.

THE OPPONENTS: The GreenJackets are in their second season as a member of the Low-A East/Carolina League as well as their second season as an Atlanta Braves affiliate. Prior to 2021, the GreenJackets in the then-Low-A South Atlantic League with the San Francisco Giants from 2004-2020, winning the league championship in 2008. Augusta also was affiliated with the Boston Red Sox (1999-2004) and the Pittsburgh Pirates (1984-1998), known as the Augusta Pirates from 1988 to 1993 after moving from Macon, GA after the 1987 season.

SATURDAY IS FOR THE PECKERS: This season, Saturday has been very kind to the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. With a doubleheader sweep over the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers on Saturday, the Woodpeckers have improved to 8-4 on Saturdays this season. Also, Fayetteville has only lost once on Saturday at Segra Stadium in 2022 over the course of five games played and have not lost a Saturday game at home since their first home series of the year against the Salem Red Sox.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Additionally, RHP Forrest Whitley who is on rehab assignment with Fayetteville is the #4 prospect in the system.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 66 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 65 long-balls, six more than the next closest team. 30 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 35 on the road, the second-most road homers of any team in the league behind Myrtle Beach. Additionally, the Woodpeckers are on pace to blow by their home run total in the 2021 season, where they finished fourth in the league with 111 homers.

EXTRA EXTRA, READ ALL ABOUT IT: On Thursday night against Augusta, the Woodpeckers recorded seven extra base hits in their 9-8 win over the GreenJackets, the second most by Fayetteville in a single game this season. Additionally, the seven extra base hits came from seven different batters. Tyler Whitaker, Justin Williams, and Freddy Guilamo all had home runs while Victor Mascai, Leosdany Molina, and Logan Cerny tallied doubles. Jaxon Hallmark also pitched in with a two-out triple in the bottom of the eighth inning.

PALMA'S BACK, TELL A FRIEND: Catcher Miguel Palma returned to the Fayetteville lineup on Friday night after spending a week on the shelf and he did not miss a beat in his first game back. Palma ripped a two-run double in his first at bat of the ballgame to give the Woodpeckers the lead in the first inning before launching a go-ahead solo home run in the bottom of the eighth for the winning run. Despite missing time, Palma statistically has been one of the top hitters in the lineup in June, batting .394 with three homers and eight RBIs over just nine

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers pitching staff was among the best in the Carolina League throughout the first half of the 2022 season. The Woodpeckers allowed the fewest hits (434) in the league in the first half and accrued the most strikeouts (720) as a team. Fayetteville also had the lowest opponent batting average (.206) across the Caorlina League.

**MOST LEADS ARE SAFE:** Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 24-3 when leading after seven innings and 27-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-25 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-5 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach. Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School.
