ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 2-0 at Neuroscieno Group Field. Bryan Gonzalez hit a solo home run in the third inning and Chris Brito had a sacrifice fly in the top of the sixth for the only runs of the game. Quad Cities starting pitcher Logan Martin allowed two hits over five scoreless innings for his seventh win of the season. Wisconsin starter Sam Garcia had six strikeouts and allowed one run on two hits over five innings. Last night was only the third time Wisconsin has been shutout this season. The Bandits have shutout the Rattlers out twice in 2025.

FOURTEEN: Jadher Areinamo extended his hitting streak to fourteen games with a lead-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. He is 23-for-56 (.423) during the streak. Areinamo has six doubles, two homers, sixteen RBI, and nine runs scored with a 1.033 OPS during the streak. Areinamo has the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season. Only Tommy White of Lansing (17 games) has a longer streak in the Midwest League in 2025.

CHANCES WERE: Wisconsin had two runners on base with one out in the fifth, but Martin got a double play to end the threat. The first two Rattlers reached in the sixth inning before reliever Tommy Molsky retired the next three hitters. In the ninth, Areinamo and Marco Dinges singled against Zachary Cawyer, who got out of the inning with a grounder and two strikeouts to close

NOPE: Dinges threw out Callan Moss trying to steal second base in the top of the sixth. In eighteen games as a catcher for the Rattlers, Dinges is 10-for-44 (.227) in throwing out runners trying to steal against him.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard lost at West Michigan on <u>June 21</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Birchard made a start at Modern Woodmen Park on April 9, 2025. He allowed one hit, walked four, and struck out four over 3-2/3 scoreless innings in that game for a no decision. Birchard also made a start against the River Bandits on August 30, 2024 at home. He allowed four runs on three hits and three walks, with a strikeout over 1/3 of an inning.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP FELIX ARRONDE: The Kansas City Royals signed Arronde, a native of Cuba, to a minor league contract on June 28, 2021 just after he turned eighteen.

RATING: MLB Pipeline ranks Arronde as the #18 prospect in the Royals system. *Baseball America* slots him at #17 in the Royals organization.

COLUMBIAN EXHIBITION: Arronde spent 2021 and 2022 in the Dominican Summer League. He split time between the ACL and the Columbia Fireflies in 2023. Arronde repeated the Carolina League in 2024 and was 4-8 with a 2.94 ERA and 103 strikeouts with only 32 walks over 110-1/3 innings pitched. His WHIP last year was 1.02 and opponents hit just .205 against him.

LAST START: Arronde had a no decision against Lansing at home on June 21. He allowed a run on five hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Arronde started against the Timber Rattlers at Modern Woodmen Park on <u>April 9</u>. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out five over 4-1/3 scoreless innings for a no decision.
