I'M THINKING HE'S BACK: Max Lazar pitched three scoreless innings, allowed two hits, and struck out four in relief yesterday. Lazar has six strikeouts over seven scoreless innings in his last two appearances.

**WELCOME BACK:** Eric Brown Jr returned to the lineup on Wednesday for the first time since he was hit in the face by a pitch at Beloit on April 26. He was 1-for-4 yesterday.

**DON'T RUN ON THEM!** Nathan Church tried to steal third base in the first inning yesterday and was caught by Alex Hall. Thomas Francisco tried to score from second on a single to right and was caught on a throw home by Micah Bello. Hall has thrown out 37.5% of runners trying to steal on him this season. Bello has two of Wisconsin's six outfield assists in 2023.

**GO INTO THE LIGHT:** Wisconsin is 3-6 in day games this season. They are 0-4 and have been outscored 24-10 in road games played during the day in 2023.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#15), Eduardo García (#21), and Joseph Hernandez (#28). MLB Pipeline has five active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), Victor Scott II (#27), and Zane Mills (#30). Tink Hence (#3), Austin Love (#19), and Inohan Paniagua (#17) are on Peoria's IL.

# WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

**DELAYED START:** Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

**MUDDY WATERS:** Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

**ON TO WISCONSIN:** Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

**LAST START:** Cruz had a <u>no decision against Beloit at home on April 27</u>. He allowed a run on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**VS. PEORIA (2023):** Cruz earned the <u>win against the Chiefs at home on April 15</u>. He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out four over five scoreless innings.

#### PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRENT BAKER: Drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of Angelo State University.

**ANGELO:** Baker pitched four seasons at Angelo State, an NCAA Division II school in San Angelo, Texas. He was 31-7 with a 2.69 ERA and 148 strikeouts over 131 innings pitched in 52 games – 47 starts.

**SENOIR SEASON:** Baker went 13-1 with a 2.11ERA in seventeen starts during his final season at Angelo State. He had 120 strikeouts over 106-2/3 innings pitched, was named the Lone Star Conference Pitcher of the Year, and helped the Rams advance to the 2021 NCAA Division II College World Series. He pitched twice during that College World Series but had a no decision in both starts.

**SUMMER WORK:** Baker pitched for three different summer wood bat leagues during his college career: Newark of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League (2018), Mankato of the Northwoods League (2019), and Round Rock of the Texas Collegiate League (2020).

GOING PRO: Baker made eight relief appearances without a decision in the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2021 after signing with St. Louis. In 2022, Baker made 25 starts for Palm Beach in the Florida State League and was 9-7 with a 3.14ERA and 138 strikeouts over 123-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Baker <u>won at South Bend on April 28</u>. He allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Baker has faced the Timber Rattlers twice this season. He took the loss at Wisconsin on April 11 and had a no decision on April 16. Baker has allowed six runs on eight hits with four walks and nine strikeouts over eight innings against the Rattlers this season. Wisconsin has two homers off Baker this season: Ernesto Martínez on April 11 and Jesús Chirinos on April 16.
