SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers swept a doubleheader from the Lansing Lugnuts at Neuroscience Group Field on Thursday. Luis Castillo had three RBI in each game.

GAME ONE RECAP: Wisconsin won game one 9-0 for their second consecutive shutout. Braylon Payne hit a solo homer in the first inning for a 1-0 lead. Wisconsin scored five runs after a two-out error in the bottom of the fifth inning and added three more runs in the sixth. Josh Knoth set a pro single-game high for innings with six scoreless frames. He allowed three hits and walked one for a quality start. Payne went 2-for-3 and scored three runs for Wisconsin.

GAME TWO RECAP: The Rattlers earned the sweep with a 6-4 win in the nightcap. Castillo hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the first to give the Rattlers a 4-0 lead. Lansing tied the game with a two-run single by Gunner Gouldsmith in the second and a two-run double by Gouldsmith in the fourth. Luis Lameda broke the tie with a two-out, two-run double in the sixth inning.

FIRST: Lameda had been 0-for-13 as a Timber Rattler before his big hit last night.

DEBUT: Jacob Morrison made his Timber Rattlers debut with three scoreless innings of relief in game two last night. He allowed one hit, walked one, struck out three, and earned the win.

STAY HOT: Castillo is 7-for-19 with nine RBI in this series with Lansing. He had a hit in each game last night to run his season-high hitting streak to seven games. He is 11-for-28 (.392) during the streak. Castillo has 64 RBI in 64 games this season. His career high for RBI in a season is 75 in 115 games with Carolina in 2024.

A RUN AT HISTORY: Payne's home run was his 21st of the season. The franchise record for homers in a season is 22, and is held by Khrist Davis (2010), Victor Roache (2013), and Clint Coulter (2014).

ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been in and out of in the Midwest League since the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974 before leaving the league. The A's returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Their affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. The Athletics left the league again after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, they went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and Lansing (since 2021).

STARTING PITCHERS

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ETHAN DORCHIES: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Dorchies in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

GOING PRO: Dorchies signed with the Brewers over a commitment to the University of Illinois-Chicago.

PROSPECT WATCH: MLB Pipeline has Dorchies at #20 in their latest rankings of Brewers prospects. He is rated as the #20 prospect in the Brewers system by *Baseball America*.

LAST SEASON: Dorchies split time between the Arizona Complex League (Six games – three starts) and the Carolina Mudcats (Thirteen games – eight starts). Dorchies went 0-3 with four saves, a 2.74ERA, and 89 strikeouts in 82 innings pitched.

LAST START: Dorchies was not involved in the decision at South Bend on [July 26](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. LANSING: Dorchies had never faced Lansing prior to this afternoon. The last time he pitched against an affiliate of the Athletics was a start on [June 28, 2025](#) in an Arizona Complex League game. He allowed three hits, walked two and struck out five over five scoreless innings.

LANSING STARTING PITCHER:

RHP SAMUEL DUTTON: The Athletics selected Dutton in the tenth round of the 2025 draft out of Auburn University.

WAR EAGLE: Dutton started his collegiate career with LSU and pitched there for three seasons before moving to Auburn in 2025. In his final season of collegiate baseball, Dutton was 7-3 with a 4.31 ERA and 95 strikeouts n 85-2/3 innings over sixteen starts.

THE RANCH: Dutton made his pro debut with the Stockton Ports of the California League after signing with the Athletics. He had no record with a 3.52 ERA in five games – three starts. Dutton walked two and struck out thirteen over 7-2/3 innings. He has been with Lansing all of 2026.

LAST START: Dutton lost to the Timber Rattlers in game one of this series on [July 28](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Dutton had never faced Wisconsin prior to last Tuesday. That was also the first time he pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
