ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-4 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) The Timber Rattlers had a 4-3 lead going into the top of the ninth inning. The Whitecaps scored four runs on no hits to take the lead.

STARTING TO HEAT UP: Blake Burke went 2-for-4 last night. He hit a solo home run in the third inning to put the Rattlers up 3-1. Burke added an RBI single in the seventh to give the Rattlers a 4-3 lead. In his last five games, Burke is 9-for-20 with two doubles and two walks to raise his average from .226 to .288.

TATER TIME: Burke's line drive homer in the third had an exit velocity of nearly 114 mph and landed in the Whitecaps bullpen. It was his second home run of the season.

TOUGH NIGHTS IN THE FIELD: Wisconsin committed three errors last night. The Rattlers have been charged with nine errors in their last six games.

TOUGH NINTH: Yerlin Rodriguez entered the game in the top of the ninth to protect a 4-3 lead. He issued walks to the first two batters before getting a strikeout, a wild pitch moved the runners into scoring position and an intentional walk loaded the bases. A fourth walk forced in the tying run. Rodriguez got a grounder to second, but the throw home for the force play was wild and two runs scored on the play. After a strikeout, another wild pitch let the final run of the inning score. Only one ball was put in play by the Whitecaps in the ninth.

LATE GAME SITUATIONS: Last night was the fifth time Wisconsin's opponent has won a game in their final at bat. It was also the third time this year in which the Rattlers lost a game they had led going into the ninth inning. Wisconsin is 4-for-11 in save opportunities in 2025.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Brandon Woodruff is set to make a rehab start for the Rattlers today, his fourth start of his current rehab assignment for the Brewers.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#16), Jadhav Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has two active West Michigan players on their list of Top 30 Tigers prospects: Max Clark (#2) and Josue Briceño (#6). Kevin McGonigle (#3) is currently on the West Michigan Injured List. That trio is also on the MLB Pipeline Top 100 Prospects in baseball: Clark (#5), McGonigle (#26), and Briceño (#91).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON WOODRUFF: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2014 draft out of Mississippi State.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Woodruff is making his third rehab start for the Timber Rattlers. He made two starts for Wisconsin in July, 2023. He is currently on a 30-day rehabilitation assignment from the Brewers as he works his way back from shoulder surgery in October, 2023.

THREE YEARS AT STATE: Woodruff pitched three seasons with Mississippi State and was 3-6 with a 4.70 ERA and 81 strikeouts over 90 innings pitched in 34 games – eighteen starts – in college.

SKIPPED US: Woodruff started his professional career in the Pioneer League with the Helena Brewers in 2014 and moved to Brevard County in the Florida State League in 2015 without playing for the Timber Rattlers.

MAKING MOVES: Woodruff went 4-1 with a 1.83 ERA in Brevard County before a promotion to Biloxi in the Southern League where he went 10-8 with 124 strikeouts and a 3.01 ERA in 113-2/3 innings during the 2016 season.

MLB DEBUT: Woodruff started the 2017 season with Colorado Springs in Triple-A before making his Major League debut with the [Brewers on August 4, against the Tampa Bay Rays](#). Woodruff was the winning pitcher in that debut with six strikeouts over 6-1/3 scoreless innings.

LAST BREWERS START: Woodruff had a no decision at Miami on [September 23, 2023](#). He allowed four runs on six hit with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

LAST START: Woodruff was the starter for the Nashville Sounds on [April 24](#) in a the first game of a doubleheader against the Durham Bulls. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out five over five scoreless innings for the win.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BEAU BRIESKE: The Tigers selected Brieske in the 27th round of the 2019 draft out of Colorado State University-Pueblo.

ON THE LIST: Brieske has been on the Detroit IL with right ankle inflammation since April 18.

BACK IN THE MIDWEST LEAGUE: Brieske was 6-3 with a 3.45 ERA in thirteen starts with the Whitecaps during the 2021 season. He was promoted to Erie, the Double-A Eastern League affiliate of the Tigers in July 2021.

IN THE SHOW: Brieske made his MLB debut on [April 23, 2022](#) in a start against the Colorado Rockies.

THIS YEAR: Brieske was 0-1 in seven relief appearances for the Tigers before going on the IL. He had walked three, struck out four, and allowed nine runs – seven earned – over 7-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST APPEARANCE: Brieske allowed a run on two hits with a walk and a strikeout over an inning in relief against Kansas City on [April 17](#).

VS. WISCONSIN: Brieske beat Wisconsin on [May 20, 2021](#) at Neuroscience Group Field. He allowed an unearned run on one hit with no walks and nine strikeouts over six innings.
