**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 3-2. Darrien Miller had three hits, including two doubles, scored a run, and drove in a run for Wisconsin. Justin Jarvis allowed an unearned run over five innings for the win. Cam Robinson allowed a run in the top of the ninth but closed out the game for his third save of the season.

**EARLY LEAD:** The Rattlers took the lead in the bottom of the first on an RBI double by Tyler Black. Miller added an RBI single for a 2-0 lead. Wisconsin has scored first in seven straight games.

**JUSTIN TIME:** Jarvis gave up two hits, walked two, and struck out two in his five innings of work to get the win. Last night was Jarvis's first win at home since July 17, 2019. He had two no decisions in his final two home appearances in 2019 and was 0-5 in eight starts at home in 2021.

**BACK IN BLACK:** Tyler Black did not play in the series at Beloit. Black's RBI double in the first inning was his first appearance in a game since his walkoff, RBI single to end game two of the doubleheader with Peoria on April 10.

**BULLISH:** Joey Matulovich pitched two scoreless innings in relief of Jarvis. Matulovich struck out the final five batters he faced. Kent Hasler pitched a scoreless eighth with one strikeout.

**CLOSER:** Quad Cities scored a run in the ninth inning against Cam Robinson before Robinson struck out the final two batters of the game to strand the tying run at third and pick up his third save of the season. Last night was the seventh Wisconsin games this season to be decided by one run. Wisconsin is 4-3 in those one-run games.

**THE OPPONENTS:** The River Bandits won the High-A Central League title last season with a win in Game Five of the best-of-five championship series over Cedar Rapids. Quad Cities was 77-41 during the 2021 regular season.

**ABOUT QUAD CITIES:** The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams over the years: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

**ABOUT THE ROYALS:** The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP RUSSELL SMITH:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round (51<sup>st</sup> overall selection) of the 2021 draft out of Texas Christian University. He is rated as he #16 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

**AREA CODE:** Smith was picked as the Most Outstanding Player at the Area Code Games in 2016. He was also a four-year letter winner at Midlothian (TX) High School.

**THANK YOU, NO:** The Chicago Cubs picked Smith in the 38<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft. He elected to honor a commitment to TCU.

**HORNED FROGS:** Smith was 7-3 with a 3.83 ERA in fifteen starts during his final season at TCU. He had 101 strikeouts in 82-1/3 innings pitched that season.

**MISSING TIME:** Smith missed the 2019 season due to Tommy John Surgery and most of the 2020 season due to the pandemic shutdown.

**LAST START:** Smith [made his professional debut on April 14, 2022](#). He was the starting pitcher in game one of a doubleheader at Beloit. Smith pitched four innings, allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four without allowing a run for a no decision.

**VS. QUAD CITIES:** Smith has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals.

## QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP CHRISTIAN CHAMBERLAIN:** The Royals selected Chamberlain in the fourth round of the 2020 draft out of Oregon State University.

**BUSY BEAVER:** Chamberlain was 8-5 in 47 games – ten starts – with a 3.09 ERA during his career at Oregon State. He had 140 strikeouts over 105 innings pitched as a Beaver. He had eleven strikeouts in a College World Series game as a freshman in 2018.

**ALL-AMERICAN:** Chamberlain was named a Collegiate Baseball All-American in the shortened 2020 season as he was 2-1 with a 0.82ERA with 34 strikeouts in 22 innings during his final season at OSU.

**SHORTENED SEASON:** Chamberlain made just two relief appearances in May for the Quad Cities River Bandits last season before being shut down for the rest of the year. He was 1-0 and allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings in 2021.

**LAST START:** Chamberlain had a no decision against [Cedar Rapids at home in game two of a doubleheader on April 14](#). He gave up six runs on six hits with five walks and three strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Chamberlain has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
