ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 3-1 to open the series at Neuroscience Group Field. Four Wisconsin pitchers held the Sky Carp to one run on four hits. Joe Gray Jr was 3-for-3, drove in one run and stole home to score another run. Darrien Miller accounted for Wisconsin's other run with a solo homer in the fourth. Yiddi Cappe had three of Beloit's four hits.

TRIPLE DECKER: Gray leads the Timber Rattlers in three-hit games (5) and multi-hit games (17) this season.

PERFECT TEN: Ernesto Martinez Jr went 2-for-3 last night to extend his hitting streak to ten games. Martinez is 13-for-34 (.382) during the streak, his longest of the season, and the second-longest on the team in 2023. CATCH 22: Robert Moore tripled in the first inning and scored on Gray's RBI double. Moore is on a 22-game on-base streak. Moore is 23-for-80 (.289) with an OPS of .869 with fifteen walks, fifteen RBI, and thirteen runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is tied for the fifth-longest in the Midwest League this season. Dalton Rushing of Great Lakes has the longest on-base streak in the league this

IN HARMONY: The quartet of Wisconsin pitchers last night were Alexander Cornielle, Karlos Morales, Tanner Shears, and Shane Smith. Cornielle pitched 3-2/3 innings and allowed two hits. Morales worked two innings, walked three, and allowed two hits. Shears struck out four over 2-1/3 scoreless innings. Smith's scoreless streak ended at nineteen innings when he allowed a pinch-hit homer in the ninth inning but closed out the game for his first Midwest League save.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Joseph Hernandez (#25) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has five Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jacob Berry (#2), Joe Mack (#5), Yiddi Cappe (#6), Kahlil Watson (#12), and Karson Milbrandt (#15).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz picked up the win at Quad Cities on <u>June 29</u>. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over five scoreless innings in Wisconsin's 3-2 win over the River Bandits.

VS. BELOIT (2023): Cruz has no record in two starts – April 9 and April 27 – against the Sky Carp this season. He has allowed three runs on seven hits with four walks and seven strikeouts over nine innings against Beloit this season.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ZACH KING: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the thirteenth round of the 2019 draft out of Vanderbilt.

THE COMMODORE: King was 3-7 and six saves with a 4.02 ERA in 70 games – six starts – over three seasons at Vanderbilt. He walked 60 and struck out 129 in 130 innings pitched during his college career.

AS A PRO (2019): King was 2-0 in six games – three starts – with the Gulf Coast League Marlins after he signed his professional contract. King walked seven and struck out 17 over 16-1/3 innings in the GCL in 2019.

BEAUTIFUL BELOIT: King made sixteen starts for the Beloit Snappers in 2021. He was 2-9 with a 5.88 ERA and 104 strikeouts in 99-1/3 innings pitched.

FROM 2022 UNTIL NOW: King was 4-3 with a 2.77 ERA in twelve starts for the Sky Carp before a promotion to the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, Miami's Southern League affiliate, last season. He was 2-6 with an 8.22 ERA in eleven starts for Pensacola last year and 0-2 with an 11.37 ERA in three starts this year before returning to the Sky Carp in April.

LAST START: King lost at home to South Bend on <u>June 29</u>. He allowed five runs on seven hits over 2-2/3 innings with two walks, two hit batsmen, and a strikeout.

VS. WISCONSIN: King has made six starts against the Rattlers over his 2021, 2022, and 2023 seasons with Beloit. In 2021, King was 1-1 and allowed ten runs on fourteen hits with seventeen strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings in three starts versus Wisconsin. In 2022, King was 0-1 in two starts and gave up seven runs – five earned – with eleven strikeouts in nine innings. King's last start against Wisconsin was on April 28, 2023 and he earned the win with six scoreless innings allowing just two hits and striking out five.
