ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-6 in game four of the series at LMCU Ballpark. Wisconsin erased an early 5-1 deficit with five runs in the top of the fourth inning, but West Michigan took the lead in the bottom of the fourth with back-to-back solo homers. The Whitecaps hit four home runs in the game. Jace Jung hit two homers and drove in three runs to lead the Whitecaps offense.

A SLIGHT DIFFERENCE: West Michigan outhit the Timber Rattlers 12-10 in last night's game. All ten of Wisconsin's hits were singles. The Whitecaps had seven extra-base hits (three doubles and four homers) out of their twelve hits.

THE RALLIES: Wisconsin scored five runs on five hits in the top of the fourth inning to take a brief 6-5 lead. The first run scored on a double steal with Eduarqui Fernández stealing home. Jose Acosta, Robert Moore, and Matt Wood each had RBI singles in the inning to tie the game. Joe Gray Jr put the Rattlers ahead with a sacrifice fly. West Michigan went back in front in the bottom of the fourth. Danny Serretti and Jung hit back-to-back homers to start the inning and give West Michigan the lead again.

ABSOLUTELY PERFECT: Taylor Floyd relieved with one out in the bottom of the fourth inning and all eleven batters he faced with six strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings to keep Wisconsin within a run.

MULTI-BALL: Fernández went 3-for-4 with a stolen base and two runs scored last night for the Rattlers to record his first three-hit game with Wisconsin. He also had a three-hit game earlier this season for Carolina at Down East on April 18.

KEEP CLIMBING UP THAT HILL: The Timber Rattlers loss snapped their three-game winning streak. Wisconsin has four three-game winning streaks this season, but they have missed on each of their chances to extend that winning streak to four games.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, and Willy Adames.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has six West Michigan players on their list of Top 30 Tigers prospects: Jace Jung (#2), Izaac Pacheco (#12), Robert Brooks (#13), Troy Melton (#17), Josh Crouch (#24), and Danny Serretti (#29). Jackson Jobe (#3) and Tyler Mattison (#25) are on West Michigan's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner beat Peoria at home on June 3. He allowed three hits and walked one over six scoreless innings. Woessner struck out seven.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Woessner has never faced the Whitecaps prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Detroit Tigers.

WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CARLOS PENA: The Detroit Tigers signed Pena as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on March 6, 2019

BEFORE AND AFTER: Pena was 5-0 with a 2.74ERA in fifteen games – four starts – in the Dominican Summer League in 2019. He had 71 strikeouts over 49-1/3 innings pitched for the Tigers #1 affiliate in his first pro season. In 2021, he split time between the Gulf Complex League and Lakeland in the Florida State League. Pena was 2-3 with a 3.34 ERA and 59 strikeouts over 59-1/3 innings over fourteen games – ten starts in that season.

FOUR LEVELS: Pena pitched for all four full-season minor league teams in the Tigers system in 2022. Most of his time was with Lakeland with nineteen games – fifteen starts. He also made a relief appearance with Erie in the Eastern League, two relief appearances with Toledo in the International League, and four appearances – one start – for the Whitecaps. He was 5-5 with a 4.22 ERA and 120 strikeouts over 98 innings pitched combined last season.

APRIL AWARD SEASON: Pena was the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April 2023. He had no record in five starts and allowed one run over 19-1/3 innings pitched. Pena had 26 strikeouts in April.

LAST APPEARANCE: Pena lost at Dayton in a relief appearance at Dayton on June 4. He allowed six runs – five earned – on six hits with no walks and a strikeout over 1-1/3 innings. Pena allowed two homers in the game.

LAST START: Pena had a no decision at Dayton on <u>May 30</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings. Pena gave up a homer in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Pena has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The only times he has pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers were relief appearances on <u>June 24</u> and <u>July 9</u> in the Dominican Summer League in 2019.
