### SUNDAY AFTERNOON BASEBALL: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 5-3 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Jesús Chirinos gave Wisconsin a 2-0 lead with a two-out, two-run double in the bottom of the second inning. Wisconsin added three runs in the fifth. Gregory Barrios had a sacrifice fly with the bases loaded. Moments later Dylan O'Rae scored from third on a wild pitch and an error on the play allowed Jader Areinamo to score from second. Edwin Jimenez allowed a three-run homer to Josh Zamora in the top of the sixth but kept the score at 5-3 through seven. Chase Costello pitched a 1-2-3 eighth and Craig Yoho worked a scoreless ninth for his sixth save.

**UP THE HALL:** Milwaukee Brewers pitcher DL Hall pitched one inning as the starter on Sunday for Wisconsin. He retired all three batters he faced with one strikeout. Hall threw eleven pitches – eight strikes – in his start.

**DOMINGO:** Jimenez won for the sixth time in seven appearances this season with six innings of relief work on Sunday. Wisconsin is 6-1 on Sunday this season and – dating back to last season – the Timber Rattlers are 10-2 in their last twelve Sunday games. Jimenez has been the winning pitcher in all ten of those Sunday games.

**SPELLING RELIEF:** Costello needed twelve pitches for his perfect inning on Sunday. He needed 22 pitches for two perfect innings with two strikeouts in the series with Beloit. Yoho had a walk and a strikeout in the ninth to close out the game. Yoho has walked three and struck out 32 while allowing one earned run over seventeen innings this season.

**TUESDAY STANDINGS CHECK:** The Timber Rattlers have the best record in the Midwest League. They lead Cedar Rapids by 1-1/2 games in the West Division. There are 27 games remaining in the first half, which ends on June 20 while the Rattlers are in Fort Wayne.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP MARK MANFREDI:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Manfredi in the 9<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Dayton.

**THE COLLEGE BEFORE COLLEGE:** Manfredi pitched two abbreviated seasons at Sinclair Community College in Dayton before moving to the University of Dayton. Manfredi was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA in seven games – three starts – in his two seasons at Sinclair.

**RADIO FLYER:** Manfredi pitched two seasons at Dayton. He was 4-6 with a 4.42 ERA in 29 games – 24 starts – with 158 strikeouts over 138-1/3 innings pitched. Manfredi finished third in the Atlantic 10 in strikeouts for his senior season.

**SUMMER CATCH:** Manfredi made three starts for Wareham in the Cape Cod League prior to the 2023 draft. He had 16 strikeouts over 13 innings with a 2.08 ERA with three no decisions before signing with Milwaukee.

**PLAYOFF CALL:** Manfredi did not pitch as a professional in the regular season last year. However, he was the starting pitcher for the ACL Brewers in their semifinal playoff game against the ACL Rockies on August 24, 2023. He pitched a scoreless inning with a walk and three strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Manfredi had a no decision against South Bend at home on [May 8](#). He allowed a run on three hits with two walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

**VS. CUBS:** Manfredi faced the Cubs as a reliever at Four Winds Field on [April 10](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on five hits and four walks with five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings. Manfredi was not involved in the decision, but Wisconsin won the game 14-8.

### SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP DREW SMYLY:** The Chicago Cubs signed Smyly as an MLB Free Agent on March 19, 2022.

**MAJOR KEY:** Smyly is 66-60 with three saves and a 4.23 ERA in eleven MLB seasons. He has pitched for Detroit, Tampa, San Francisco, Philadelphia, Texas, Atlanta, and the Cubs since making his MLB debut with the Detroit Tigers on April 12, 2012.

**POSTSEASON:** Smyly appeared in two games of the 2021 World Series for the Atlanta Braves. He also made the playoffs twice with the Tigers and pitched in two World Series games in 2012.

**MINOR KEY:** The Tigers drafted Smyly in the second round of the 2010 draft out of the University of Arkansas. Smyly did not pitch as a pro in 2010 and skipped the West Michigan Whitecaps in the Midwest League in 2011. He pitched for both Lakeland in the Florida State League and Erie in the Eastern League in his first pro season. Smyly also made seven starts for Toledo in the International League in 2012.

**BACK IN SOUTH BEND:** This is Smyly's third appearance with South Bend at Four Winds Field. He pitched one scoreless inning with three strikeouts against Bowling Green on [August 30, 2018](#). He also made a rehab start against the Timber Rattlers on [July 4, 2022](#).

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Smyly allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and a strikeout over 2-1/3 innings against Miami on [April 21](#) for a no decision. He is 2-2 with a 4.97 ERA in nine relief appearances for the Cubs this season. Smyly has eleven strikeouts and five walks in 12-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Smyly took the loss in the game against the Rattlers on July 4, 2022. He allowed three runs on four hits with six strikeouts over four innings. Joe Gray Jr and Ashton McGee both homered against Smyly.
