THE SURGE — The Surge host the Tulsa Drillers today for the final game of a six game series, and the last game of the season. Tulsa won this series by taking four of the first five games.

TEXAS LEAGUE PLAYOFF BASEBALL - The playoffs for the Texas League are set as Springfield will play Arkansas in a best of three and Frisco will play Midland in their best of three.

THE PROPELLER - Wichita and Tulsa are separated by 129 miles and both cities are instrumental in the airplane manufacturing business and play annually for the Propeller. It's a trophy for the season series winner. The Surge won the Propeller in 2021 and Tulsa has won three straight seasons. The Drillers won the 2024 season series and lead 14-9 with one game remaining. Tulsa leads the all-time series 58-43 and the series at Riverfront is Tulsa 27-26.

DAY BASEBALL- The Surge are 11-12 in day games and 13-11 in series finales. In the day games the team has outscored the opponent 102-98 and has a 3.64 ERA and a 4.23ERA at night

LAST NIGHT – The Tulsa Drillers rallied with a pair of runs in the ninth to defeat Wichita for the fourth time this series 3-2. The Drillers took advantage of a ninth inning error and scored a pair of unearned runs.

*Wichita stranded 12 and finished the game 1x12 with runners in scoring position.

*The Surge lost for the 13th time this season when leading after sixth inning and fourth time when leading after 8th inning.

ON THE BUMP- CJ Culpepper will make his sixth start with the Surge today. He opened the season with Cedar Rapids, named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the week on May 26th and while at Cedar Rapids had a record of 2-2 in ten games, nine starts with a 2.89 ERA, 43K/11BB in 37 1/3 innings pitched. He missed some time this season with a right forearm strain and was on injured list. The 22 year-old is in his third professional season and is ranked the 15th best prospect in the Minnesota Twins top 30 prospects, according to MLB.com.

THE PITCHING– Wichita has allowed just 32 earned runs in 12 September games and have a 2.68 ERA, the team is 3-9 this month. The second best ERA in Texas League.

PIERSON! – Pierson Ohl has finished his season strong, in his last three starts dating back to September 1st he has allowed one earned run in 16.2 innings pitched, a 0.54 ERA.

THE ARMS RACE - The Surge bullpen is 29-44 on the season with a 4.73 ERA, ninth in Texas League and 29th in Class AA.

*The blown save last night is the 23rd of the season, Wichita is 24 of 47 for the year. The 23 blown saves is tied for third most in Texas League.

*The Wind Surge starters, have the third best ERA in the Texas League. Starters are 28-36, with a 3.58 ERA

*Quality – The Surge are 15-12 in games where the starter has pitched a quality start. (6 innings or greater allowing 3 runs or less)

WALK THIS WAY - The Wind Surge have drawn the most walks in the Texas League and second in all of Class AA, with 558 free passes.

THE LEAGUE LEADERS -Jake Rucker is sixth with 117 hits, and third in the league in RBI with 68. Travis Adams is 4th in ERA and 8th in Strikeouts, Marco Raya 4th in starts for a pitcher. Taylor Floyd is 8th with 42 games pitched.

SEPTEMBER SWOON – The Surge have scored two runs or less in seven of the 12 games this month.

*Since August 1st, the Surge are batting .202, 30th of 30th in Class AA, Tulsa is 29th batting .204

*Surge are batting .171 in September, last in Texas League and last in Class AA.

THE TIGHTROPE- Wichita is 16-33 in one run games and 9-18 in second half. The 33 losses leads the league and all of Minor League Baseball, Class AA Reading, 30 defeats, and Ft Wayne 28, the 16 one run wins is second fewest in Texas League. The Surge have played 49 one run games, second most in Class AA. Akron leads with 57 one run contests (32-25).

ATTENDANCE WATCH- The Wind Surge have one home game remaining this season, last night's crowd was the 2nd best attendance in Riverfront Stadium History and Friday ranked 20th. The team is averaging **4,386** fans per game this season. Last season was the teams best year in attendance and the club attracted an average of **4,676** for the season. The total attendance in 2023 was 322,637 a growth of 102,109 from 2022. The biggest jump in all of MiLB.

RUCKER– Jake Rucker picked up his 226th career hit in a Wind Surge uniform moving him past DaShawn Keirse, Jr. as the most by any Wind Surge player. Rucker's 131 career RBI ranks number one and his 44 doubles moved him ahead of Keirse for tops and his 106 runs scored is 14 behind Keirse for tops in club history. The 123 hits this season, puts him second amongst Wind Surge hitters for a season. Yoynier Fajardo 143 last year ranks the most. Rucker led the team in RBI last year with 63 and leads the team this season with 68 RBI. No player has ever led in back to back seasons.

SEASON NOTES

THE SEASON - The Wind Surge will finish the season with fewest wins for a season in franchise history.

*The team is a franchise low 23 games under .500.

*The 17 games back of first place in the second half is the furthest back the club has ever been.

HIGH FIVE – The Wind Surge have scored five or more runs in 40 of the 56 wins this season. The Wind Surge are 2-38 when scoring two runs or less and 17-58 when scoring four runs or less.

FAN APPRECIATION - The Wichita Wind Surge attracted 9,264 fans on Saturday and the best two attendances in franchise history are the 2023 and 2024 fan appreciation nights. Both the games fell on the final Saturday home game of the season. The top crowd ever was on September 16th, 2023 when the team drew 10,442 fans. The third best crowd was on Opening Day 2024.

○ **EXTRA INNINGS** – Wichita played a league high 16 extra inning games and are 7-9 in games decided in extras.

DOUBLE DOWN - The 238 doubles are second in the league and third in all of Class AA. Carson McCusker led the team this season with 26 doubles, seventh best in the Texas League this season.

THE DEFENSE – The 112 errors this season rank third most in the Texas League with a fielding percentage of .977.

SURGE NOTES- The longest hit streak of the season was a ten game streak by Kila'i Rosario.

THE LONG BALL- Wichita has a pair of players climbing the home runs charts in Surge history. Alex Isola has 31 career Surge home runs. Aaron Sabato has hit 27 with Wind Surge in his career. Andrew Bechtold and Yuniur Severno have most ever in Wichita history with 32.

THE LONGBALL- Wichita finished second in the league with 32 home runs in August. The 122 home runs for the season fourth-highest in TL and 7th in Class AA.

*The Surge have ten players with 8 or more home runs this season and five players with ten or more.

*The Surge are projected for fewest home runs for the season, hit 159 last season, 164 in 2022, and 150 in 2021.

HOME AND ROAD - Wichita will finish the 2024 season with its fewest ever home wins. The team has 29 home wins this season, last season team won 31, after winning 34 and 43 in first two seasons. The 41 road losses is the second most in the league, Corpus Christi 43. 41 road losses is the most in a single season by Wichita, Surge previous high was last year with 35 losses.

MCRBI – At the time Carson McCusker was promoted to Class AAA, he lead the team in all three triple crown categories. He lead the team with a .281 batting average, with 15 homers and 64 RBI. He is currently ranked 6th in the league in batting average, 10th in RBI, 2nd in OPS and Slugging, 7th in doubles, 10th in OBP

WAITING ALL DAY FOR SUNDAY NIGHT - Wichita is 3-0 in Sunday night games scoring ten runs in two of the three Sunday Night games.

THE LONESTAR WOES- The Surge made four straight road-trips to the Lonestar State to finish the road schedule, the team logged 4,220 miles over the final four trips. Measuring across USA is only 2,800 miles. In the final four trips the team finished 10-14.

TO THE SHOW - 34 Wind Surge alums have reached MLB in team history and nine in 2024, Austin Martin (Minnesota Twins, March 30, 2024), Jair Camargo (Minnesota Twins, April 16, 2024), David Bañuelos (Baltimore Orioles, April 22, 2024), David Festa (Minnesota Twins, June 27, 2024), Brooks Lee (Minnesota Twins, July 3, 2024), Bryan Sammons (Detroit Tigers, July 29, 2024), Zebby Matthews (Minnesota Twins, August 13, 2024), and Michael Helman (Minnesota Twins, September 3, 2024), DaShawn Keirse (Twins, September 5, 2024). The Wind Surge elevated 16 guys to Triple A this season.

TWINS FARM SYSTEM – The new top 100 MLB Pipeline list has debut and six Minnesota Twins prospects have made the list. All six players have Wind Surge ties. Walker Jenkins is the highest-rated Twins Prospect at #4. Brooks Lee 16, Emmanuel Rodriguez 22, Luke Keaschall 67, Zebby Matthews 97, David Festa 89. *Baseball America* and ESPN revealed a mid-season update to the farm system and the Minnesota Twins moved up to third in *Baseball America* and 4th according to ESPN. The highest ranking in over five seasons.

WHAT A WEEKEND - The Surge had three of the top 15 crowds in ballpark history from May 7-12 this season. The team attracted 35,581 in the six game series vs Arkansas the most ever in a six game homestand. The previous high was 32,946 in the final homestand of 2023 vs Midland. The current series vs Tulsa has attracted 27,413 with one game to go.

CHILI BUNS - The **Wichita Wind Surge** are nominated for one of the most exciting honors! The **Wind Surge** are one of seven teams nominated for Best Alternate Identity, which is awarded to the most unique and quirkiest alternate identity from this season. The award will be announced as part of this year's MiLB Awards Show, which will air on MLB Network on Sept. 30 at 8 p.m. central. Voting is open until Sept. 23 at 5 p.m. ET / 2 p.m. PT. The show will highlight all things Minor League Baseball, from this year's top prospect performances to the wackiest alternate identities and everything in between.

ONE MILLIONTH FAN – The Wind Surge welcomed their one millionth fan to the ballpark earlier this season. The team awarded the lucky fan with array of prizes and celebrated them on August 2nd.

LEAGUE HONOURS - The Texas League honored Surge players seven times this season with the weekly honors. Four hitting awards and three pitching awards. The seven awards for a season is the most ever added up by a previous Wind Surge team. Previous high was five in both 2022 and 2023.

TWINS ACCOLADES- The Minnesota Twins named their Minor League Hitter of the Week and Pitcher of the Week throughout the season and in 2024 the Surge players stepped up and won the award 16 times.

RECORD BREAKING NIGHT- Carson McCusker had the first three home run night in Wind Surge history on May 7th, he also is the first to score five runs in a game. The five hits ties him with Jose Miranda, Spencer Steer and Dashawn Keirse in a game. Six RBI is a season high, one shy of Edouard Julien for the club record.

THE FOUR-INNING SAVE- The four inning save is pretty rare, in the first three seasons the Surge did it once. In fact dating back to 2002 the franchise that was the New Orleans Zephyrs had two four inning saves, including the Kody Funderburk save in 2021. In 2024 the team did it four different times. Pierson Ohl, Christian MacLeod, Cory Lewis and Andrew Morris accomplished the feat in 2024.

THE LEAD OFF HITTER – The Surge used just eight lead off hitters this season. Luke Keaschall, Kila'i Rosario, Jake Rucker, Emmanuel Rodriguez, Tanner Schobel, Alerick Soulaire, Jefferson Morales, Dalton Shuffield and Walker Jenkins.

RUNNING - The 126 stolen bases are second to last in Texas League this season and 26th in all of Class AA.

VERSATILITY - Of the Wind Surge Position players only 2 have played one spot, not including the DH position. Noah Cardenas has only played catcher and Aaron Sabato has only played first base.

FRIDAY THE 13TH - The Wind Surge improved to 1-2 all time on Friday the 13th and 1-1 vs Tulsa, playing them on August 13, 2021. The game on September 13th was first at home

THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN- Travis Adams moved to the top of several Wind Surge pitching records. He leads the franchise with 206 career strikeouts, 44 games started, 217.2 innings pitched.

SHUT IT DOWN- Miguel Rodriguez and Jordan Gore lead the franchise with eight career saves.

APPEARANCES – Taylor Floyd will finish the 2024 season with 71 career Surge appearances most ever by a Surge pitcher. His 43 appearances in 2024 ranks sixth in the Texas League this season.

THE FUTURE- Luke Keaschall represented the Twins and Wind Surge at the MLB Futures Game in Arlington, Texas.

THE YARD- The Wind Surge have won best field of the year in 2022 and in 2023 won Best Class AA and Texas League Field of the year. The field is attempting a three-peat.
