WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Cedar Rapids Kernels split a pair of games at Neuroscience Group Field on Wednesday. The Kernels won the conclusion of Tuesday's suspended game 6-2. The Rattlers won the seven-inning game 3-1

GAME ONE RECAP: The Kernels had a 5-0 lead when the game was halted by rain on Tuesday. David Festa pitched 5-2/3 innings as the reliever for the Kernels on Wednesday. He allowed two runs and struck out seven for the win.

GAME TWO RECAP: Justin Jarvis struck out ten over five innings and Zavier Warren broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run home run in the bottom of the fourth. Robbie Baker pitched a perfect sixth and Cam Robinson worked a perfect seventh for his eighteenth save.

PERFECT TEN: Jarvis allowed one hit, a solo homer in the third, and that was the only hit for the Kernels in the game. Jarvis reached double digits in strikeouts for the third time this season and is now fifth in the Midwest League in strikeouts with 88.

SIX-PACK: Warren is on a six-game hitting streak. This is his second six-game hitting streak of the season. The home run was his fourth of the season. It had an exit velocity of 104, traveled 407 feet, and hit on the roof of the 380 Landing bar on the Home Run Porch.

ROBINSON TO THE RESCUE: Robinson leads Minor League Baseball in saves. He also moved up the Wisconsin single season save list with yesterday's 1-2-3 ninth inning.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has five current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Aaron Sabato (#14), Alerick Soularie (#21), Cade Povich (#23), Christian Encarnacion-Strand (#25), and David Festa (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ISRAEL PUELLO: Acquired by Milwaukee as a player to be named later from in a trade that sent David Phelps to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 31, 2020. Puello, Juan Geraldo, and Brandon Ramey were announced at the PTBNL on September 18, 2020.

 $\mbox{\bf ORIGIN STORY:}$ Puello was signed by the Phillies out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

FIGHTIN' PHIL: Puello pitched two seasons (2018 and 2019) for the Phillies White affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He went 4-6 with a 4.52 ERA in fourteen starts in 2018 and 2-1 with a 1.92 ERA in fifteen starts in 2019. Puello had 143 strikeouts over 131-1/3 innings pitched. Puello was named a DSL All-Star in 2019.

WHAT'S BREWING? Puello was 1-4 with a 4.94 ERA in ten starts for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League in 2021. He walked nine and struck out 37 over 27-1/3 innings pitched.

SWEET CAROLINA: Puello was 3-7 in thirteen games – six starts – with a 5.51 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 49 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats before joining the Timber Rattlers on June 28. Puello was 0-2 in four games – two starts in June...BUT, he had a 3.38 ERA, opponents were hitting just .192 against him, and he had sixteen strikeouts over sixteen innings in June.

LAST APPEARANCE: Puello pitched four scoreless, hitless innings of <u>relief at Down East on June 22</u>. He walked one, struck out four and was not involved in the decision.

LAST START: Puello <u>took the loss at Columbia on June 15</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on two hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Puello has never faced the Kernels prior to this evening. This evening is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CADE POVICH: The Minnesota Twins selected Povich in the third round of the 20-21 draft out of Nebraska. MLB Pipeline rates Povich as the #26 prospect in the Minnesota minor league system.

SOUTHWEST: Povich pitched a season at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix, Arizona and was 10-1 with a 1.52 ERA. He had eight complete games and pitched five shutouts.

HUSKY: Povich transferred to Nebraska for the 2020 season and made four appearances before the shutdown. He was a First Team All-Big Ten selection in 2021 after he went 6-1 in fifteen starts. Povich had 88 strikeouts over 81 innings during his final season at Nebraska.

STARTING OUT: Povich pitched in the Florida Complex League and for Fort Myers after signing with the Twins. He had no record and allowed one earned run over ten innings in four games – three starts in those two levels.

LAST START: Povich had a <u>no decision against West Michigan at home on June 24</u>. He allowed seven runs – five earned – on eight hits and two walks with five strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Povich lost to the Timber Rattlers at Cedar Rapids on May 25. He allowed three runs on three hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over five innings. Carlos Rodríguez hit a solo homer against Povich in the game.
