ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Bubba Chandler tossed his second straight start of 6.0 scoreless innings and was backed by three clean frames from the bullpen as the Indianapolis Indians tossed their seventh shutout of the season and clinched at least a series split with Thursday night's 3-0 win against the Gwinnett Stripers at Victory Field. With a scoreless tie in the third inning, Aika Williams kicked off the frame with a double off Hurston Waldrep and was knocked in by Ji Hwan Bae's triple two batters later. The triple by Bae was his second in three games against Gwinnett after he tripled in the eighth inning of Tuesday's contest. Bae then came around to score the final run of the inning on a fielding error by shortstop Luke Waddell to put the Indians up, 2-0. The Stripers threatened in the seventh when Matthew Batten reached on a lead-off walk. He attempted to move to third on a single from former Indian Jason Delay but was cut down by a seed from Billy Cook to quell the rally. Indianapolis stayed off the scoreboard after the second until the eighth inning, when Ronny Simon clubbed his sixth home run with Indy and seventh of the season, a 408-foot shot to right field, to pad Indy's lead. Eddy Yean, Cam Sanders and Kyle Nicolas (S, 3) each tossed an inning to finish out the shutout.

CIRCLE CITY SHUTOUTS: Indy's seven shutouts this season already surpass the five they had in 2024 and are the most they have had through July 10 since 2018, when they posted ten shutouts. The Indians shutout record improved to 7-6 this season.

PRIMETIME BUBBA: Last night, Bubba Chandler recorded his second straight start of 6.0 scoreless innings and has tossed 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the first inning of his start on June 28 vs. Omaha. His scoreless innings streak is the longest by an Indians pitcher this season, surpassing Eddy Yean's run of 11.1 scoreless innings from April 11-May 11. In 10 starts at Victory Field this season, Chandler is 2-1 with a 1.79 ERA (8er/40.1ip) and 56 strikeouts. In 12 night games this year, he is 4-0 with a 1.44 ERA (9er/56.1ip) and 70 strikeouts. In six night games at Victory Field on the campaign, he is 2-0 with a 0.60 ERA (2er/30.0ip) with 40 strikeouts.

SUPER SAIYAN SIMON: Ronny Simon (1-for-4, HR) launched his seventh home run of the season in the 7th inning last night. The 408-foot blast was his third-farthest-hit longball of the campaign. He has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 games since June 11, including a 20-game on-base run from June 11-July 5, and has hit safely in 20 of those 24. In this 24-game span, he is hitting .305 (29-for-95) with 18 runs, six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, 17 walks, 13 stolen bases and a .933 OPS.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak (0-for-3, BB) extended his team-best on-base streak to 24 games yesterday, which is the third-longest active run in the International League. It is the longest on-base stretch by an Indian since Jake Lamb's season-best 27-game streak from April 18-May 27, 2024. Solak is hitting .326 (30-for-92) with 19 runs, four doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 13 walks, two stolen bases and an .852 OPS in this stretch. He has hit safely in 21 of those 24 games, with a team-high tying 14 game hitting streak from June 12 (1)-27. He owns honors as the IL's top hitter with a .358 batting average (78-for-218) for the season. As the Indians lone representative on the league offensive leaderboard, he also ranks among qualifiers in on-base percentage (3rd, .427), OPS (4th, .968) and slugging percentage (10th, .541).

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae (2-for-4, R, 3B, RBI, 2K, SB) tripled home the Indians first run of the contest last night, extending his hitting streak to six games. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with 10 runs, one double, two triples, five RBI, five walks, six stolen bases and a .906 OPS in 11 games.

CHA CHENG: With Indy down to their final strike in Wednesday's contest, Tsung-Che Cheng (2-for-4, R, RBI, K, SB) knotted the game, 2-2, with an RBI single in the 9th inning. He has hit safely in five of six games this month, batting .333 (7-for-21) with four runs, one double, one home run, 7 RBI, two walks, one stolen base and a .915 OPS. He cashed in with his first career Triple-A home run in Tuesday's series opener, his first longball since Aug. 20, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Richmond.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series against the Gwinnett Stripers tonight at 7:05 PM. LHP Hunter Barco is set to make his 10th start of the season, last tossing a career-high tying 6.0 shutout innings on July 5 vs. Louisville with one hit, three walks and a Triple-A best tying seven strikeouts. It marks his first career outing against the Stripers. On the mound for Gwinnett is RHP Blake Burkhalter, Atlanta's No. 14 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, who is set to make his Triple-A debut. In 14 starts with Double-A Columbus this season, he is 2-5 with a 3.13 ERA (25er/72.0ip).

FRIDAY FISH FRY: The Indians earned a third-straight over the Stripers for the first time since a three-game run from June 4-July 8, 2017, between Indianapolis and Gwinnett, and third straight win over them at Victory Field since a three-gamer across June 13, 2015-June 27, 2016. With a win tonight, Indy can secure its first series win over the Stripers since taking two of three games at Gwinnett from July 7-9, 2017, and first home series victory over them since two of three games from June 2-4, 2017.

HUNTING DOG: In his last outing on July 5 vs. Louisville, Hunter Barco became the first Indians pitcher to have three straight starts of 6.0+ innings with 1er or less allowed since J.T. Brubaker ran off four straight from July 25-Aug. 11, 2018. He joined Thomas Harrington (3 QS, 6/3-14) as the second Indian to throw three consecutive quality starts this season. Since June 24, he leads all International League qualifiers with a 0.61 WHIP and .115 batting average, and ranks second in ERA (0.50). His back-to-back starts of 6.0-plus innings and one hit or less allowed were the first by an Indy pitcher since James Marvel on July 18 and 24, 2019, which was additionally the last time an Indians pitcher did so twice in a single season. He holds the fifth-lowest ERA (1.47, 5er/30.2ip) in home games of Triple-A pitchers (min 25.0ip). He has limited rightsies to a .427 OPS and a .126 average (11-for-87) which rank first and second respectively among Triple-A southpaws (min. 80 AB).

HAPPY 29TH BIRTHDAY, VICTORY FIELD: On this date in 1996, a new era of baseball in Indianapolis began as Victory Field opened its gates. The Indians hosted the Oklahoma City 89ers and fell, 5-3, with a first-time attendance of 14,667.

ON THIS DATE IN 2003: For the first and only time in Victory Field history, the Indians hosted the Triple-A All-Star Game between the Pacific Coast League and International League. Indy first baseman Mike Coolbaugh hit a two-run homer and Louisville left fielder Adam Dunn belted a pair of long balls for the IL All-Stars, who were handed a 9-5 loss.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 80 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco tossed a career-high tying 6.0 shutout innings on July 5 vs. Louisville with one hit, three walks and a Triple-A best tying seven strikeouts.

Against the Stripers: Tonight marks his first career start against the Stripers.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finshed his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
