Gray also threw out another runner at the plate in the bottom of the fifth. The Chiefs would have taken the lead had either of those runners scored. Gray leads the Rattlers with eight outfield assists this season.

SAVING THE DAY: Karlos Morales entered Friday's game in the bottom of the eighth inning with the bases loaded and two outs. Morales got the final out of the eighth and pitched a perfect ninth for his first Midwest League save. The save was also the 41st of the season for Wisconsin. The franchise record of 47 saves was set by the 2012 team.

DOWN THE STRETCH: Wisconsin was eliminated from playoff contention last night. South Bend will clinch a playoff spot and the second half Western Division title with one win or one Beloit loss over the final eight games of the season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodriguez (#19), and Eduardo Garcia (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodriguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has five Chiefs on their list of Cardinals prospects: Inohan Paniagua (#13), Austin Love (#17), Dionys Rodriguez (#19), Nathanael Heredia (#27), and Andre Granillo (#29).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ: Selected by Milwaukee in the 6th round of the 2021 draft out of Florida SouthWestern State Junior College.

ALL-DADE: Rodríguez was a four-year letter winner at Miami Christian High School. He had a 0.67 ERA in his senior season of high school and was an All-Dade County selection.

BUC SHOTS: Rodríguez went 7-2 with a 2.11 ERA and 62 strikeouts over 47 innings pitched in his only season at Florida SouthWestern State. He was a First Team All-Suncoast Conference selection for his performance for the Buccaneers.

PICKED HIGH: Rodríguez is the highest Florida SouthWestern State draft selection since the baseball program restarted in 2016. He was the highest MLB draft selection from the school since Kerry Ward was a fourth-round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in 1993.

SWEET CAROLINA: Rodríguez did not pitch professionally last season. His first action as a pro was this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. Rodríguez was 3-4 with a 3.53ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts – prior to joining the Timber Rattlers. He had walked 27 and struck out 84 in 71-1/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: Rodríguez [beat Lansing at home on August 28](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over six innings.

VS. PEORIA: Rodríguez has never faced Peoria prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZANE MILLS: The St. Louis Cardinals drafted Mills out of Washington State University with their fourth-round selection in the 2021 draft.

LET'S GO COUGARS: Mills went 5-5 with a 4.15 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 80-1/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts in his final season at Washington State. He was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week twice in 2021.

IT'S COMPLEX: Mills made seven relief appearances for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals after signing his professional contract. Mills allowed a run on four hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and nine strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings pitched.

PALM READER: Mills started 2022 with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League. He was 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA in seven starts with seven walks and 35 strikeouts over 41-1/3 innings before his promotion to Peoria on May 23.

LAST START: [Mills won at Beloit on August 28](#). He allowed an unearned run on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mills is 0-2 in two starts – [May 31](#) and [June 5](#) – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed seven runs – six earned – on ten hits with three walks and eleven strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings pitched against Wisconsin in 2022. Both of his starts were at Neuroscience Group Field. Both of Wisconsin's hits off Mills on June 5 were solo home runs – one by Xavier Warren and one by Ashton McGee.
