JULY, 2025:

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 6-3 at Modern Woodmen Park in a game shortened to eight innings by rain. Wisconsin grabbed a 5-0 lead with five runs off Drew Beam in the second inning and added an insurance run in the sixth after the River Bandits scored two runs in the fifth. Quad Cities scored a run in the bottom of the sixth but left runners on second and third as Jeferson Figueroa retired the last two batters. Aaron Rund pitched a scoreless bottom of the seventh and picked up the save when the tarp went on the field after the top of the eighth. The game was called thirty minutes later.

FINDING THE HIT: Wisconsin went 5-for-45 with runners in scoring position in the first four games of this series. The Rattlers went 4-for-6 with runners in scoring position in the second inning last night. Hedbert Pérez gave the Rattlers a 2-0 lead when he hit a home run with Eduardo Garcia at second base. Luiyin Alastre was at second with two outs and Andrick Nava doubled him home. Steward Berroa followed with an RBI triple and Jadher Areinamo had an RBI double for the 5-0

A FORTNIGHT: Pérez has fourteen home runs after his blast last night. He has hit five of his home runs against Quad Cities. Pérez leads the Rattlers in homers and is tied for third with four other players in the Midwest League homer run race. Josue Briceño and Alfonsin Rosario are tied for the league lead with fifteen. GREAT EIGHT: Alastre extended his current hitting streak to eight games with two hits last. He is 14-for-32 (.438) during the streak. Alastre is 25-for-79 (.316) with a .722 OPS in 23 games during the second half

ON ASSIGNMENT: Steward Berroa is on a minor league rehab assignment for the Milwaukee Brewers. He had a single and a triple last night in three at bats and was the starting right fielder. Berroa is 2-for-5 with two walks, a stolen base and two runs scored in two games with the Rattlers.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

■ PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP SAM GARCIA: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Garcia in the eighth round of the 2024 draft out of Oklahoma State.

HITTING THE HIGH POINT: Garcia pitched three seasons at High Point University from 2021 through 2023. He was a First Team All-Big South selection after his sophomore season when he was 5-4 with a save and a 1.94 ERA in sixteen games – eight starts.

STILLWATER: Garcia pitched for Brewster of the Cape Cod League in 2023 and transferred to Oklahoma State University for his final season of collegiate baseball. As a Cowboy, Garcia was 7-3 with a 3.64 ERA in sixteen starts. He had 115 strikeouts over 89 innings.

STARTING OUT: Garcia did not pitch professionally last year. He made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats this season and was 5-1 with a save and a 2.08 ERA in ten appearances – two starts. Garcia walked nineteen and struck out 44 in 34-2/3 innings with Carolina before his promotion to Wisconsin on June 3.

LAST START: Garcia had a no decision in game one of this series at Modern Woodmen Park on <u>July 22</u>. He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out six over five scoreless innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Garcia is 0-1 in two starts against the River Bandits. He lost to them at home on <u>June 26</u>. He has allowed a run on five hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts over ten innings against Quad Cities.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP MASON MILLER: The Royals selected Miller in the fourteenth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida Gulf Coast University.

ON THE GULF: Miller pitched three seasons for the Eagles, including an injury-shortened campaign in 2023. He was 6-7 with a 6.31 ERA and a save with 92 strikeouts in 82-2/3 innings at FGCU.

JUMP RIGHT IN: Miller made seventeen relief appearances in the Kansas City system after signing with the Royals in the 2024 season. He was 4-3 with a 7.76 ERA in 29 innings with eighteen walks and 29 strikeouts.

THIS SEASON: Miller began 2025 with Columbia in the Carolina League. He was 5-2 with a save and a 3.63 ERA in 21 games – one start – for the Fireflies. Miller walked fifteen and struck out 57 in 44-2/3 innings for Columbia before his promotion to Quad Cities on July 8.

LAST START: Miller had a no decision in game one of this series at Modern Woodmen Park on <u>July 22</u>. He pitched three scoreless innings, gave up three hits, walked three, and struck out three.

VS. WISCONSIN: Miller's start against Wisconsin was the first time he had faced the Timber Rattlers in his career. He made three relief appearances against the Carolina Mudcats – April 24, June 18, and June 22 – earlier this season. He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out eleven over 7-2/3 scoreless innings.
