CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Indianapolis Indians could not manage a run before the eighth inning but scratched across a pair of runs in the ninth inning to earn their eighth walk-off victory of the season in a 3-2 contest on Wednesday afternoon at Victory Field. With a 2-1 deficit in the ninth inning, Matt Fraizer reached on a single with one out to represent the game-tying run for Indy. He subsequently stole second and advanced to third on Gwinnett's second error of the game. Tsung-Che Cheng followed with a two-out single to drive in Fraizer and Ronny Simon finished off the comeback with a walk-off double. The Stripers struck first in the second inning, when Matthew Batten hit a two out, solo home run to left-center field. The homer proved as the lone blemish on starter Sean Sullivan's line, as he held Gwinnett scoreless and hitless otherwise. Gwinnett added a valuable insurance run to its lead in the fifth inning. Eddys Leonard led off the frame with a single, stole second and advanced to third on an error before scoring on a Sandy León single. The Indians loaded the bases in their half of the fifth but could not crack the scoreboard until the eighth. Simon led off the frame with a walk before stealing a base and scoring on a single from Ji Hwan Bae to pull the Indians within one. Ryder Ryan, Colin Holderman, Michael Darrell-Hicks and Yohan Ramirez allowed only one run while combining for eight strikeouts across the final 6.0 innings of the contest. José Ruiz (L, 0-1) took the loss for Gwinnett after allowing the game-deciding runs in the ninth.

CARDIAC KIDS: The Indians earned their 23rd comeback win and eighth walk-off of the season yesterday to take down the Stripers. Through July 9, it marks their most comeback wins since 23 of them to that date in 2017. The eight game-winners are Indy's best single-season total since eight of them across all of 2022. It is their most through July 9 since eight of them through May 19 in 2001. Additionally, Indy improved to 19-7 in one-run contests this season. Yesterday was the first time this season Indianapolis claimed victory when trailing after the 8th inning (1-24).

SUPER SIMON: Ronny Simon (1-for-3, R, 2B, RBI, 2 BB, K, SB) delivered victory with a walk-off double yesterday. He has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 games, including a 20-game on-base run from June 11-July 5, and has hit safely in 19 of those 23. In this 23-game span, he is hitting .308 (28-for-91) with 17 runs, six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, 17 walks, 13 stolen bases and a .918 OPS.

CHA CHENG: With Indy down to their final strike in yesterday's contest, Tsung-Che Cheng (2-for-4, R, RBI, K, SB) knotted the game, 2-2, with an RBI single in the 9th inning. He has hit safely in five of six games this month, batting .333 (7-for-21) with four runs, one double, one home run, 7 RBI, two walks, one stolen base and a .915 OPS. He cashed in with his first career Triple-A home run in Tuesday's series opener, his first longball since Aug. 20, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Richmond.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak (1-for-3, 2B, BB, K) extended his team-best on-base streak to 23 games yesterday, which is tied for the third-longest active run in the International League. It is the longest on-base stretch by an Indian since Jake Lamb's season-best 27-game streak from April 18-May 27, 2024. Solak is hitting .337 (30-for-89) with 19 runs, four doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks, two stolen bases and an .872 OPS in this stretch. He has hit safely in 21 of those 23 games, with a team-high tying 14 game hitting streak from June 12 (1-27). He owns honors as the IL's top hitter with a .363 batting average (78-for-215) for the season. As the Indians lone representative on the league offensive leaderboard, he also ranks among qualifiers in on-base percentage (3rd, .430), OPS (4th, .979) and slugging percentage (10th, .549).

DON'T RUN ON ROSS: Shawn Ross (1-for-3, BB, K) extended his on-base streak to eight games yesterday, hitting .259 (7-for-27) with four runs, one double, two home runs, four RBI, seven walks and a .931 OPS in this span. He has hit safely in 10 of 14 games on the campaign and has reached safely in 12 of those. He has cut down 10 of 24 runners attempting to steal with Indy this season, good for a .417 caught stealing percentage, which is the third best among Triple-A catchers with at least 100.0 innings caught.

TODAY'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series with the Gwinnett Stripers tonight at 7:05 PM. RHP Bubba Chandler is set to make his International League-leading 18th start of the season, last tossing 6.0 shutout frames on July Fourth vs. Louisville. It was his first scoreless start of 6.0-plus innings since Sept. 10, 2024, vs. Rochester. Chandler has struck out six-plus batters in 14 of his 24 career starts with Indianapolis, and did so in back-to-back contests for the first time since May 13-18. To date, he has thrown 39 pitches of 100.0 mph or faster this season, third among all starters in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Triple-A Nashville's Jacob Misiorowski (66) and Single-A St. Lucie's Raimon Gomez (41). It will be his first career game against the team from his hometown. Opposite Chandler is Stripers RHP Hurston Waldrep, who is set to make his 17th start of the season. Despite allowing three runs in his last outing on July 5 (5.0ip, 3R, 0er, 4h, 4bb, 4k), it marked his first game this season with zero earned runs. It is his first career game against the Indians.

OLD BAY SEASONING: The Indians seek a third straight win over the Stripers since a three-game run from June 4-July 8, 2017, between Indianapolis and Gwinnett, and third straight win over them at Victory Field since a three-gamer across June 13, 2015-June 27, 2016.

PRIMETIME AT VICTORY FIELD: In nine starts at Victory Field this season, Bubba Chandler is 1-1 with a 2.10 ERA (8er/34.1ip) and 49 strikeouts. In 11 night games this year, he is 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA (9er/50.1ip) and 63 strikeouts. In five night games at Victory Field on the campaign, he is 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2er/24.0ip) with 33 strikeouts.

F-F-FIRE SALE: Bubba Chandler is set to make his 10th start at Victory Field this season, with tonight being his seventh home feature as Minor League Baseball's Free Game of the Day on MiLB.TV. Catch the action at no cost on milb.com or in the MiLB app.

ON THIS DATE IN 2003: Center fielder Jason Conti recorded the first cycle in the Victory Field era in an 8-5 win vs. Norfolk. Batting second, Conti went 4-for-5 with three RBI and three runs scored. The Indians scored one run in each of the first three innings and put the game out of reach with a three-run sixth inning. There have been seven cycles in the Victory Field era (MR: Nick Gonzalez, Sept. 19, 2023, vs. Rochester) and Conti's was the only cycle for Indy in the era until the 2010 campaign.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 5 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 1. In 24 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 7-2 with a 2.62 ERA (31er/106.2ip) and 140 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in eight of those starts and six-plus in 14.

Last Outing: Chandler earned his third win of the season on July Fourth vs. Louisville, tossing 6.0 shutout frames with five hits, two walks and six strikeouts.

Against the Stripers: Tonight is Chandler's first career appearance against the Stripers.

IL Pitcher of the Month: Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (7) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. He was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.
