# INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians scored a run in four of the first five frames, including a four-run third, to take Saturday night's contest against the Nashville Sounds at Victory Field, 8-4, and clinch their fourth consecutive series win at home. The Indians jumped on top in the first, stringing together a walk and a pair of singles to open the scoring. They broke the game wide open in the third, managing four walks, a hit-by-pitch and a pair of RBI on a single from Brett Sullivan and a groundout to cap a four-run third and chase Nashville starter Jacob Misiorowski. Indy added another insurance run in each of the next two innings as Matt Fraizer slugged his second homer of the season in the fourth and Alika Williams cashed in on a Liover Peguero double with an RBI single in the fifth. Indy's scoring came to a close in the seventh when Mike Jarvis singled and stole second to set up Brett Sullivan for his second RBI single of the night. Nashville could not manage a run off of Hunter Barco (1-0), who allowed one hit and struck out a seven across 30 piniping. struck out seven across 3.0 innings

BARNSTORMING BASEPATHS: The Indians recorded six stolen bases in last night's win, marking their most since swiping six bags on Sept. 13, 2023, at Omaha.

**ALL BARC:** Hunter Barco shined last night with 3.0 shutout innings, allowing one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts. He became the first Indians pitcher since at least 2005 to strike out seven in 3.0 shutout innings or fewer. Between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis, it marked his third seven-plus strikeout performance in nine starts on the campaign. He has not allowed more than three hits in any of those nine starts, posted two hits or fewer in eight of those and one hit in four. Seven of those starts were scoreless outings.

VICTORS VALIANT: With last night's win Indy improved to 21-7 at home, owning the best home winning percentage (.750) in Triple-A and tied for fifth best in Minor League Baseball. Since April 16, the Indians are 19-3 at home, good for a .864 winning percentage that paces all Triple-A teams and trails only High-A Brooklyn (.15-2, .882) for the highest winning percentage among all minor league teams in that stretch. In May, they had a .824 winning percentage (.14-3) at Victory Field, the third-best mark in the minors. May's percentage mark matches April 2013 for their highest winning percentage and most wins at home in a month since 2005. Additionally, their .750 winning percentage (.21-7) at home so far this season only trails 2013 (.759, .22-7) for their highest mark through May.

**FLAVOR FRAIZ:** Matt Fraizer engraved the box score in last night's win, going 2-for-3 with one double, one home run, one RBI, two walks, a careerhigh tying three runs (9x, MR: July 24, 2024, at lowa) and two stolen bases. It marked the eighth multi-steal game of his career and first since April 13, 2024 (1), vs. Harrisburg. It was his first time reaching base safely four-plus times since a career-high tying four hits on Aug. 23, 2023, vs. Akron. He has recorded a hit in five of his last six games, including a season-high four game hitting streak, and is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three extrabase hits, three RBI and a 1.050 OPS in that span.

**NEW YORK(E) STATE OF MIND:** Nick Yorke went 1-for-3 with two walks, one run and two stolen bases in last night's win, putting a stamp on his red-hot month of May. It marked his second multi-steal game of the season (MR: May 2 at Omaha). He hit safely in 20 of 24 games in May and posted multiple hits in seven of those. In the month, he led Indians qualified hitters in batting average (.322, 28-for-87), hits (28), OPS (.791), total bases (37) and stolen bases (7). Yorke has recorded a hit in 10 of 11 career games against the Sounds.

PITCHING PROWESS: In May, Indians pitchers led Triple-A in ERA (3.48, 90er/227.1), strikeouts (283), fewest hits allowed (188), opponent average (223, 188-for-843), opponent OPS (670), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.11) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.20). Their 1.23 WHIP trailed only Toledo (1.21) for the best Triple-A mark in the month. In the month, the bullpen's 1.10 WHIP and .616 opponent OPS led Triple-A while its 2.72 ERA (32er/106.0ip) trailed only Nashville's pen (2.64, 31er/105.2ip).

PAIR O' PIRATES: The Indians roster boasts two major league rehabbers in Nick Gonzales and Dauri Moreta. Gonzales has picked up a hit in each of his last four games, including three in last night's contest. Across those games, he's hitting .389 (7-for-18) with three runs scored, a triple, an RBI and a .868 OPS. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displaced left ankle fracture, sustained after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 3.12 ERA (3er/8.2ip) with Indy, allowing five hits while striking out 13 across his 10 appearances.

**TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** Indianapolis concludes its six-game set against Nashville today at 1:35 PM. With yesterday's win, the Indians clinched their fourth straight series win at home and first series triumph over Nashville since the two teams resumed play opposite each other in 2021. Left-hander Nick Dombkowski will open a bullpen game for Indy. He is set to make his fourth start of the season. He made his first career appearance against the Sounds on Friday, tossing 1.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one strikeout. Taking the mound for the Sounds is right-hander Logan Henderson. Henderson has won five consecutive starts since April 3, posting a 1.04 ERA (3er/26.0ip) with 32 strikeouts in this span. He made one career start against Indy in his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9, 2024, at Nashville. He took the loss, allowing just one run in 4.0 innings on a solo homer by Henry Davis.

ON THIS DATE IN 1997: The Indians won 3-0 and 4-0 in a doubleheader sweep over Nashville at Victory Field, which led the American Association Eastern Division at the time. Scott Klingenbeck tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in Game 1 and Scott Service earned his seventh save of the year in the 3-0 win. In the nightcap, right-hander Brett Tomko improved to 6-3 with 6.0 three-hit innings and Felix Rodriguez finished off the 4-0 win. Eric Owens and Tim Belk each had multiple hits in the opener, with Belk driving in a run on the only home run of the day. Pat Watkins and Aaron Boone led the offense with multi-hit games to end the twin bill.
