ABOUT LAST NIGHT: An eighth-inning RBI single by Nick Solak broke up the Omaha Storm Chasers shutout bid, but the late comeback attempt fell short as the Indianapolis Indians dropped Friday night's game at Victory Field, 2-1. With Omaha leading 2-0 following a two-run homer by Isan Diaz off Thomas Harrington in the top of the fifth, the Indians were held to three hits until the eighth inning. Ronny Simon and Jace Bowen, playing in just his second Triple-A game, recorded four of Indy's five knocks. Brandon Johnson was the first arm out of the bullpen for the Storm Chasers, earning the win, and Joey Krehbiel held the Indians scoreless in the ninth for his third save of the campaign.

JULY PLAYER OF THE MONTH: Ji Hwan Bae was named the Indianapolis Indians July Player of the month on Friday, joining Nick Solak, Drake Fellows and Billy Cook, respectively, as recipients of the team's monthly awards this season. Bae logged a .324 batting average (23-for-71) and .903 OPS in the month while ranking among International League hitters in triples (1st, 4), stolen bases (T-1st, 12; also, Ronny Simon and former Indian Jared Oliva) and nionity Willie Yalking alloing international League Interes in triples (1st, 4), stolen bases (1-1st, 12; also, koliny Shinoi and Tornier inicial Jared on Iona) and on-base percentage (9th, .438). He is the first Indians hitter to tally four or more triples in a month since Travis Swaggerty also racked up four in July 2022. Bae and Simon are the first Indians to swipe 12 or more bags in a month since Eury Pérez stole 13 in June 2017. Additionally, they join former big leaguers Nyjer Morgan (13) and Rajai Davis (12) in April 2007 as the only pair of Indians teammates to do so in the same month since at least 2005. Bae's July was highlighted by a 10-game span from July 6-22 in which he recorded multiple hits in five contests, including a four-hit game on July 22 vs. Toledo to cap the stretch. In that span, he recorded two doubles, nine RBI and a 1.116 OPS while ranking among IL hitters in triples (1-1st, 3), batting average (T-5th, .417), hits (T-6th, 15), stolen bases (T-6th, 5) and on-base percentage (8th, .477).

THOMAS HARRINGTON: RHP Thomas Harrington took his ninth loss of the season last night, extending his career-high total. He tossed 4.2 innings with three hits, two runs, one walk and five strikeouts. The lone two runs in the contest were from a two-run home run by Isan Díaz. Harrington's 20 home runs allowed this season is a career high and is tied for the fifth most among Triple-A pitchers. Facing Nick Pratto in the at-bat following the home run, Harrington exited due to injury after throwing a 87.1 mph cutter up and away.

JASE IS JAMMIN': Jase Bowen continued his hot start in Triple-A, going 2-for-4 in last night's contest. He has begun his Triple-A career 4-for-7 with two runs, one double, one home run and one stolen base. He made a splash in his Indians debut on Thursday, going 2-for-3 with two runs and a home run. In his first Triple-A at-bat, he launched the third pitch from Chandler Champlain 394 feet to opposite field for a sole homer. In the fifth inning on Thursday, he smacked another extra-base hit to opposite field, this time a double, off Champlain. He later scored on Brett Sullivan's RBI single to give Indy a 2-0

SHUGART ON REHAB: RHP Chase Shugart joined the Indianapolis Indians on Tuesday when he had his major league rehab assignment transferred from SHUGART UN REHAB: RHP Chase Snugart plined the indianapolis Indians on Tuesday when ne had his major league rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton. Shugart is one of 10 rehabbers assigned to Indy on 11 separate stints, joining infielders Jared Triolo and Nick Gonzales, first baseman Spencer Horwitz, catcher/first baseman Endy Rodríguez, catcher Joey Bart, left-handed pitcher Ryan Borucki and right-handed pitchers Dauri Moreta, Colin Holderman and Johan Oviedo. Shugart was placed on the 15-day injured list on July 8 with left knee inflammation after pitching to a 4-3 record with a 3.69 ERA (16er/39.0ip), 1.15 WHIP and a .214 batting average against (30-for-140) in 32 appearances with Pittsburgh. He did not allow a run in 10 of his first 12 appearances with the Pirates, good for a 1.23 ERA (2er/14.2ip) and a 0.68 WHIP while holding opponents to a .140 batting average (7-for-50). In his sole rehab appearance since returning, on Aug. 3 vs. Single-A Clearwater, he allowed one run in 1.0 inning. He has made three appearances for Indy this season, and two on the rehab stint, last tossing 2.0 shutout frames with one hit and one strikeout on Friday night.

SOLAK'S HISTORIC STREAK: Nick Solak's 39-game on-base streak ended Ion Thursday night as he went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts. It marked just the second time in 75 games Solak struck out three times. His 39-game run was the longest by a Triple-A player since Buddy Kennedy's 45-game run from May 28-Aug. 1, 2024, between Lehigh Valley and Toledo. Solak's streak was also the longest by an Indians player since Chris Richard's 46-game streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. It was the fourth Indianapolis on-base streak of 39-plus games since at least 2005, joining Ty Wigginton (41G, 6/24-8/8, 2005), Ronny Paulino (42G, 6/6-7/27, 2005) and Richard. During his streak, Solak ranked among qualified International League hitters in on-base percentage (2nd, .444), batting average (3rd, .351, 53-for-151) and hits (T-4th, 53), while racking up nine doubles, four homers, 25 RBI, 21 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .934 OPS. On the season, he has reached safely in 71 of his 76 games and has hit safely in 65 of those.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's six-game series vs. the Omaha Storm Chasers tonight at 6:35 PM. RHP Johan Oviedo is set to make his second start of the season, last tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on July 29 at lowa on a major league rehab assignment, with two hits, no walks and five strikeouts. He has made two career starts against the Storm Chasers, posting a 1-1 record and 9.45 ERA (7er/6.2ip), with eight hits, three home runs, four walks and four strikeouts. Both of these starts came in 2022 with Memphis. Opposite Oviedo is Storm Chasers RHP Stephen Kolek, who is set to make his eighth start of the season and second with Omaha after being traded from San Diego to Kansas City on July 31. It marks his first career start against the Indians

WHAT'S ON THE LINE?: With one more loss this series, the Indians would lose their first six-game series at Victory Field since April 1-6 vs. the Iowa Cubs to end a streak of nine straight series wins at home. The season series with Omaha is knotted at eight games apiece. Another loss would mark Indy's first series loss to Omaha at Victory Field since a seven-game set (one game as the away team) from May 27-June 2, 2024, when it lost six of those seven.

ON THIS DATE IN 2012: After being the first of three pitchers in a combined no-hitter on April 29, 2012 at Durham, Justin Wilson went the distance to no-hit Charlotte at Victory Field. It was the fourth no-hitter in the Victory Field era and the 14th in team history. He went 8.0 innings and gave up just one walk with five strikeouts before the game was called early due to rain. The Indians won, 3-0, to improve to 72-48 on the season.

### TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Johan Oviedo:** Oviedo is making his second start of the season with Indy after one previous start on an MLB rehab assignment.

**Bucco Aboard:** Oviedo previously joined the Indians as their ninth rehabber this season. Prior to his rehab outing on July 29 at lowa, he had not pitched since Sept. 27, 2023 with Pittsburgh after undergoing Tommy John surgery during the 2024 offseason

**Indianapolis:** In six appearances (five starts) with Indianapolis, Oviedo has pitched to a 1.10 ERA (2er/16.1ip) with 18 strikeouts and a 0.80 WHIP.

**Against the Storm Chasers:** Oviedo has made two career starts against the Storm Chasers, posting a 1-1 record and 9.45 ERA (7er/6.2ip), with eight hits, three home runs, four walks and four strikeouts. Both of these starts came in 2022 with Memphis.

Last Outing: In his first start above Double-A since 2023 on July 29 at lowa, Oviedo held the I-Cubs to two hits and one run while striking out five in 5.0 innings of work.

Going the Distance: Oviedo tossed his first career complete-game shutout on Aug. 28, 2023 at Kansas City, surrendering two hits and two walks while striking out five. It was the first complete-game shutout in which there were two or fewer hits allowed by a Pirates pitcher since April 8, 2018, when Jameson Taillon allowed one hit across 9.0 scoreless innings vs. Cincinnatti. Oviedo's shutout was his second start of a six-start span from Aug. 22-Sept. 21, 2023 in which he earned a 3-1 record with a 2.23 ERA (8er/32.1ip) and 28 strikeouts.

Miscellaneous: Oviedo was acquired by Pittsburgh from St. Louis with 3B Malcom Nuñez in exchange for RHP Chris Stratton and LHP Jose Qunitana on Aug. 1, 2022.
