### **CIRCLE CITY ROUNDUP**

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Jared Oliva's two-run, go-ahead double in the seventh inning led the Nashville Sounds to a 7-4 win over the Indianapolis Indians at First Horizon Park on Saturday night. With the game tied, 4-4, Oliva roped an 0-2 pitch down the left field line off Colin Holderman to give the Sounds a late 6-4 lead that they held onto. Nashville added an insurance run in the eighth inning on an RBI single from Daz Cameron to conclude the scoring. Indianapolis opened the scoring in the second inning. After a two-out single by Darick Hall and a bit-by-pitch to Alika Williams, Brett Sullivan drove both home for a 2-0 lead with his third triple of the season. Nashville battled back in the third inning, with Oliver Dunn's two-run, go-ahead single capping a four-run frame for a 4-2 advantage. Indy rallied to tie the game with a run in the fifth and sixth

**THE SULLIVAN SHOW:** Brett Sullivan (2-for-4, R, 3B, 3 RBI) contributed to all four runs the Indians scored yesterday, crossing the plate once and driving in a season-high three runs. It marked his most RBI in a game since a trio on May 25, 2024 with EI Paso vs. Sacramento. It was his third multi-hit performance in his last six games, after posting just seven of them in his first 40 games between Indy and EI Paso this season.

CHA CHENG: Tsung-Che Cheng (1-for-4, 2B, RBI) has reached base safely in 10 of 11 games this month and extended his on-base streak to seven games last night. He has driven in one-plus run in seven of those 11 and in six of his last seven. In this 11-game span in July, Cheng is hitting .286 (10-for-35) with six runs, three doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBI, five walks, one stolen base and an .889 OPS.

BAEWATCH: Ji Hwan Bae (0-for-2, 2 BB) has reached base safely in 34 of 39 games on the campaign, 12 of his last 14 and nine of his last 10. He has hit safely in 10 of his past 14 games and has multi-hit performances in four of his last eight contests. Since returning from the 7-day injured list on June 27, he is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with 11 runs, one double, two triples, eight RBI, eight walks, seven stolen bases and an .818 OPS in 15 games. Bae has not made an error this season, converting on all 71 chances between the three outfield positions.

SUPER SAIYAN SIMON: Ronny Simon (1-for-5, 3 K) has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 games since June 11, including a 20-game on-base run from June 11-July 5, and has hit safely in 22 of those 29. In this 29-game span, he is hitting .272 (31-for-114) with 20 runs, seven doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, 18 walks, 14 stolen bases and an .835 OPS.

BUCCO BORUCKI: LHP Ryan Borucki had his rehab assignment transferred from Low-A Bradenton to Indianapolis on Friday last week. He made one rehab appearance with Bradenton on July 8, tossing a scoreless inning with one strikeout before being transferred to Indianapolis. He is one of eight rehabbers assigned to Indy on nine separate stints this season. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on June 21 with low back inflammation after going 1-3 with a 5.26 ERA (15er/25.2ip) in 29 appearances with Pittsburgh. The reliever has made 23 appearances with Indianapolis since joining the Pirates organization, logging a 2.31 ERA (6er/23.1ip) and 31 strikeouts. 20 of his outings with Indy have been scoreless and he has not allowed a hit in 14 of those.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak (1-for-2, RBI, HBP) extended his team-best on-base streak to 27 games on Friday, which is the third-longest active run in the International League. It is the longest on-base stretch by an Indian since Jake Lamb's season-best 27-game streak from April 18-May 27, 2024. Solak is hitting .337 (34-for-101) with 21 runs, five doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, 15 walks, two stolen bases, three HBPs and a 27, 224. **TONIGHT'S MATCHUP:** The Indianapolis Indians conclude this weekend's three-game series against the Nashville Sounds tonight at 7:05 PM. Dropping the series with a second loss last night, Indy is yet to win a series at Nashville since the teams resumed play in 2021, posting a 0-3-1 road series record against them in this span. RHP Drake Fellows takes the mound for Indianapolis, set to make his 22nd appearance and eighth start of the season. Fellows is fresh off one of his best outings of the season, with a season-best 5.0 shutout innings with zero hits, one hit batter, two walks and three strikeouts. It marked his first scoreless outing of 5.0-plus frames since 5.0 zeroes on June 13, 2024, with Double-A Altoona vs. Erie. Tonight is set to be Fellows third appearance and first start opposite the Sounds on the campaign. In those two previous outings, he has allowed just one run across 4.1 innings with five hits, one walk and seven strikeouts. Taking the mound for Nashville is RHP Logan Henderson. It marks his third career start against Indy and second this season, last tossing 3.0 shutout innings on June 1 at Victory Field. Across those two starts, he has allowed just one run in 7.0 innings with seven strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 2005: The Indians erased a 9-0 deficit to win a wild game against Syracuse at Victory Field, 14-11, the largest comeback in the Victory Field era. Indians right fielder Graham Koonce and designated hitter Brad Eldred each hit two home runs and combined for nine RBI. Indianapolis tied the game at 10-10 in the sixth inning and jumped in front for good with a four-run seventh frame.

### TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Drake Fellows:** Indy's newest member of the rotation will be making his eighth start of the season and his 28th career start compared to 35 career relief appearances.

**Last Outing:** Fellows is fresh off one of his best outings of the season, with a season-best 5.0 shutout innings with zero hits, one hit batter, two walks and three strikeouts. It marked his first scoreless outing of 5.0-plus frames since 5.0 zeroes on June 13, 2024, with Double-A Altoona vs. Erie.

**Against the Sounds:** Tonight is set to be Fellows third appearance and first start opposite the Sounds on the campaign. In those two previous outings, he has allowed just one run across 4.1 innings with five hits, one walk and seven strikeouts.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliver to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023.

**Fab Five:** Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.
