ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders scored nine unanswered runs en route to an 11-5 victory over the Indianapolis Indians on Saturday night at PNC Field. After taking a 4-3 lead in the fourth, the RailRiders broke the game open with a six-run fifth inning, taking advantage of a single, three doubles and three walks issued by Indians reliever Beau Burrows. Ji Hwan Bae opened the scoring with a lead-off single and stolen base in the first, coming home on Nick Solak's RBI knock. Back at it in the second, Alika Williams launched his sixth home run of the season off Brendan Beck. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre answered back in the bottom half of the second with a Braden Shewmake single and an Andrew Velazquez RBI double. The Indians responded in the fourth with Brett Sullivan's stand-up triple that plated Matt Fraizer, but the RailRiders countered with three runs in the home half, highlighted by a pair of RBI singles and a bases-loaded walk. Indianapolis pushed across two in the seventh before Velazquez capped the scoring with another RBI single in the bottom of the inning. In his first career start against the RailRiders, The Indians' pitching staff surrendered twelve walks, their highest of the season since walking ten batters on June 5 at Memphis.

BUBBA CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler, MLB Pipeline's No. 7 overall prospect, took his sixth loss of the season in last night's contest. He tossed 3.1 innings with six hits, four runs, five walks and five strikeouts. The five free passes matched a career high (4x, MR: Sept. 4, 2024, at Toledo). His 121 strikeouts on the campaign are his most with one team in a single season, surpassing 120 strikeouts with High-A Greensboro in 2023. He is 27 punchouts away from a career high of 148, set last season between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis. His 121 strikeouts are the most in the International League and are tied with Las Vegas RHP Mason Barnett for the most in Triple-A.

POSITION PLAYERS PITCHING: Shawn Ross and Mike Jarvis pitched for the Indians last night, combining for 1.2 shutout frames. It marked the first career pitching appearance for Ross. Ross retired the lone batter he faced and Jarvis allowed just one hit across 1.1 innings. It was Jarvis' third career pitching appearance and third of this season, with the previous two for Double-A Altoona. Jarvis has not allowed a run in his 2.2 career innings, giving up two hits and walking one.

I LIKE ALIKA: Alika Williams launched his fourth home run of the season in last night's contest, a solo shot, finishing 1-for-3 with two runs and one walk. He deposited a fastball from Brendan Beck 392 feet into left field for his sixth homer of the campaign. His four home runs this month are his most since also hitting four in July 2023. He trails his single-month career high by one when he hit five homers in June 2022 with Single-A Bowling Green. Williams has reached safely in 10 of 11 games this month and has hit safely in nine of those. He is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with one double, four homers, nine RBI, four walks and a 1.032 OPS in August.

FLAVA FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer extended his hitting streak to seven games last night, going 1-for-3 with one run and one walk. It matches his season high (3x, MR: July 4-25). In these seven games since Aug. 9, he is hitting .448 (13-for-29) with five runs, two doubles, one triple, four homers, two walks, three stolen bases and a 1.070 OPS. He has recorded a hit in 19 of his past 24 games since July 4. In 12 games this month, he is hitting .404 (19-for-47) with seven runs, four doubles, three triples, eight RBI, three walks, four stolen bases and a .963 OPS.

RIDICULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak went 2-for-4 with one RBI in last night's contest, posting his team-leading 29th multi-hit contest of the season. He extended his hitting streak to eight games since Aug. 8. Across 83 games on the season, he has reached safely in 78 of those and hit safely in 72 of them. Leading all minor leaguers in batting average (min. 300 PA), he is on pace to become the Indians first batting champion since Junior Noboa hit .340 (159-for-467) in 1989.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians conclude this week's six-game series against the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders on Sunday afternoon at 1:05 PM. With a win today, the Indians can capture their first series over the RailRiders since taking two of three games at Victory Field from May 14-16, 2019. It would be their first series win at SWB since taking three of four games from May 6-9, 2013, capped by a 2-1 win in 11 innings in the finale. RHP Drake Fellows takes the mound for Indianapolis, set to make his 27th appearance and 13th start of the season. Fellows started the series opener with a no-decision, tossing 4.0 innings with five hits, four runs, one walk and no strikeouts. It marked just his second outing this season in which he failed to record a punchout. (also April 20 vs. Toledo). It marked his first career outing against the RailRiders. Opposite Fellows is RHP Erick Leal, who is set to make his 23rd appearance and 22nd start of the season. In Tuesday's opener, his first career start against the Indians, he tossed 4.0 innings with seven hits, six runs, two homers, two walks and four strikeouts. In his last two outings, Leal has allowed 15 runs (14er) across 8.0 innings with 15 hits, four homers, three walks and seven strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1988: Pinch hitter Razor Shines ripped a two-out single to drive in Johnny Paredes and finish off an 8-7 comeback win for Indianapolis. The Indians were in control when a three-run third inning broke the game's 2-2 tie, but lowa responded with five runs in the sixth to go ahead, 7-5. The Indians countered in the seventh with two runs of their own to tie the game. The win extended Indy's Eastern Division lead to 9.5 games.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Drake Fellows: He will be making his 13th start of the season and his 33rd career start compared to 34 career relief appearances.

Last Outing: Fellows did not factor into the decision in Tuesday's series opener, tossing 4.0 innings with five hits, four runs, two home runs, one hit batter, one walk and no strikeouts.

Against the RailRiders: Fellows' previous start was his first against the RailRiders.

Fellows Posts Zeroes: Fellows owns the longest scoreless streak by an Indians pitcher this season, tossing 15.0 scoreless frames across four starts from July 12-31.

May Flowers: Fellows was named the Indians May Player of the Month earlier this season. In six appearances, he ranked sixth among Triple-A pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched in ERA (1.15, 2er/15.2ip) and 11th in WHIP (0.96). He was the first Indians reliver to earn the award since Hunter Stratton in Aug. 2023

Fab Five: Fellows picked up a win in a career and team-high five straight decisions from April 20-May 31. He pitched to a 2.08 ERA (5er/21.2ip) with 25 strikeouts in nine appearances across that stretch.

Miscellaneous: Selected by San Diego in the sixth round (173rd overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt (Nashville, Tenn.) University...
