ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Nick Solak's go-ahead two-run homer in the fifth inning was the decisive hit in the Indianapolis Indians 6-5 win over the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders on Tuesday night at PNC Field. After Ji Hwan Bae singled to lead off the fifth frame, Solak deposited a curveball from Erick Leal over the left field wall for a 6-4 advantage. The Indians got on the board two batters in, with Ronny Simon tripling to lead off the ballgame. Solak brought him home on a sacrifice fly for a 1-0 lead. With the bases loaded in the second inning, Tsung-Che Cheng brought home a second run on an RBI groundout. A Jeimer Candelario homer in the bottom of the second cut the deficit for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to 2-1. Cam Devanney launched his second home run as an Indian, and his 20th home run of the season, to extend the lead, 3-1, in the third frame. The Indians added another run via a triple and sac fly in the fourth inning, with Matt Fraizer reaching third base and Rafael Flores bringing him home. A three-run fourth inning tied the ballgame for the RailRiders, capped by a two-run homer from Duke Ellis, before Solak swatted the decisive blast. Drake Fellows tossed 4.0 innings, allowing four runs with five hits and one walk. Following Fellows, Ryan Harbin allowed one run across 2.0 innings in his Triple-A debut. Colin Holderman tossed 2.0 perfect innings to bridge to Evan Sisk for a scoreless ninth inning. Leal allowed all six Indianapolis runs.

OFFENSIVE ODDITIES: The Indians' offense scored six runs last night despite going 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position. It's the first time the Indians have scored six or more runs while going hitless in seven or more at bats with RISP since June 17, 2006, at Buffalo, when they won, 7-4, while going 0-for-9 with RISP. Indy has managed to win four games in which they've gone hitless with runners in scoring position, their most in a season since they also won four such games in 2017. Additionally, the Indians racked up two triples and two home runs in a road game last night for the first time since Aug. 3, 2018, at Toledo (also 2 3B and 2 HR). They did not record a double, marking the third time since at least 2005 that Indy has recorded multiple triples and home runs in a game without tallying a double (also: 4/8/14 @ TOL and 7/31/09 @ NOR).

RIGHTY TIGHTY: Indianapolis took the win last night against right-handed starter Erick Leal and are projected to face a righty in each of the next five games against the RailRiders. The Indians are 55-32 when opposed by a right-handed starter this season, which is the second-highest winning percentage (.632) and the second-most wins among Triple-A teams this season, only trailing Jacksonville (59-34, .634). The Indians hold the highest batting average (.280) of any International League team against righty starters, have struck out the second-fewest times (308) and have the fourth-highest OPS (.801).

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak hit a two-run, go-ahead home run in the fifth inning last night, capping a 2-for-4 effort with three RBI in the win. The big fly was his 12th of the season, which matches Jack Suwinski for the most on the Indians and marks Solak's most in a single season at one level since he hit 17 with Durham in 2019. Solak has hit safely in 17 of his last 20 games and has logged multiple hits in nine of those contests. He has recorded a .364 batting average (.28-for-77) with five doubles, three homers, 18 RBI and a 1.002 OPS across that span. Additionally, he has reached safely in 43 of his last 44 games, including a Triple-A high 39 game on-base streak from June 10-Aug. 6. On the season, Solak leads qualified full-season minor league hitters in batting average (.359, 106-for-295) and on-base percentage (.435) and ranks fifth in OPS (.977). Solak's batting average is the highest by an Indians hitter to this point in the season (min. 250 PA) since at least 2005, surpassing Miguel Andujar's .355 clip (125-for-352) through Aug. 12, 2023.

FLAVA FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer went 4-for-4 with a triple, a stolen base and a run scored in last night's win, matching a career high in hits he last set on Aug. 23, 2023, vs. Double-A Akron while with Altoona. Fraizer has recorded a hit in 15 of his last 20 games since July 4, good for a .368 batting average (.25-for-68) in that span that ranks third among International League hitters with at least 75 plate appearances. Fraizer played his 22nd game in right field last night, the most he's played in any position this season. He is hitting .372 (.29-for-78) with a .978 OPS as a right fielder, which ranks first and seventh respectively among International League right fielders (min. 75 PA as a RF). Three of Fraizer's hits came with the bases empty last night, a situation in which he ranks second among International League hitters in batting average (.366, 37-for-101) and fifth in OPS (1.008).

DEVANNEY DINGER: Cam Devanney smoked a 103.5 mile per hour solo home run to left field in the third inning last night's win. It was Devanney's second home run in an Indians uniform and his 20th on the season overall. Since debuting with the Indians on July 8, Devanney has reached safely in 18 of 20 games while hitting .268 (19-for-71) with six doubles, nine RBI and a .818 OPS. In nine road games with Indy, Devanney is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, two homers, four RBI and a 1.015 OPS.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians play Game 2 of their six-game series with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders tonight at 6:35 PM. The Indians have come out on top in four of its last five matchups with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre since May 9, 2019. It's the first time Indy has won four times in a five-game span against the RailRiders since May 8-Aug. 2, 2013, when they also took four of five matchups. Southpaw Hunter Barco, MiLB's No. 87 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, will take the mound for Indy across from RHP Allan Winans. In eight second half starts, Barco has pitched to a 3.12 ERA (12er/34.2ip) with 35 strikeouts and a .185 batting average against (23-for-124). This will be his first career appearance against the RailRiders. Winans enters play with the lowest ERA (1.16, 9er/70.0ip) and the second-lowest opponent's OPS (.534) of Triple-A pitchers this season (min. 70.0ip). This will be Winans' second career start against Indy after tossing 7.0 innings of one-run ball while matching a career high with 10 punchouts on Aug. 5, 2023, while with Gwinnett.

ON THIS DATE IN 1964: Starting pitcher Dave DeBusschere, who was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1983, hit a second-inning grand slam off Jesse Jenkins to lift the Indians to a 7-2 win over Arkansas at old Victory Field. Jenkins was inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991. DeBusschere earned his 12th win of the season after throwing 6.0 innings and yielding only two runs with five strikeouts. Marv Staehle, Ramon Conde and Jim Koranda registered multi-hit performances in the victory.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Hunter Barco: The southpaw ranks as Pittsburgh's No. 4 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 87 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Historic Zeroes: Barco did not allow a run in his six starts with Double-A Altoona, totaling 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, marking the longest scoreless streak in Curve history.

Last Outing: Barco allowed one hit while punching out four in 4.0 scoreless innings on Aug. 7 vs. Omaha. He tossed 51 pitches, 31 of which went for strikes, and faced the minimum 12 batters in his outing.

Against the RailRiders: Tonight will mark Barco's first career start against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

EAS Pitcher of the Month: Barco was awarded the 2025 Eastern League April Pitcher of the Month Award after leading the league (min. 20ip) in ERA (0.00, 20.2ip) and batting average against (.132, 9-for-68), while ranking second in WHIP (0.63) and tied for fourth in strikeouts (30).

Mowing Them Down: Barco finished his award-winning April with back-to-back eight-strikeout starts, the last of which came in just 3.0 innings of work on April 27 at Double-A Chesapeake. He became the first Pirates full-season farmhand to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less since Osvaldo Bido also struck out eight in 3.0 innings vs. Triple-A Louisville on Aug. 4th, 2022.

Miscellaneous: Barco was selected by the Pirates in the second round (44th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida (Gainesville).
