ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Snappers beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-0 at ABC Supply Stadium Antonio Velez allowed one hit and struck out ten over seven innings while Troy Johnston hit a pair of home runs for the Snappers. The Timber Rattlers were held to two hits in the game.

EARLY OPPORTUNITY: Wisconsin had two base runners with two outs in the top of the first inning. Joe Gray Jr. was hit by a pitch with two outs and Thomas Dillard reached on an error. Velez got out of the inning with a strikeout.

HIGHWAY ROBBERY: Kameron Misner took a home run away from Nick Kahle with a catch in the top of the second inning. That home run would have put the Rattlers up 1-0.

FIRST! Johnston homered to center in the bottom of the second inning. The homer was the first one at ABC Supply Stadium and gave the Snappers a 1-0 lead.

GRAY AREA: Gray broke up the no-hit bid by Velez with a lead-off single in the top of the seventh inning. Gray also doubled with two outs in the top of the ninth inning to collect both of Wisconsin's hits in the game. Gray had six multi-hit games since joining the Timber Rattlers. He is also on a six-game hitting streak (9-for-22, .409).

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Snappers are in their first season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3. Mike Jacobs is in his first season as the manager of the Snappers. Jacobs managed the Clinton LumberKings in 2019, Clinton's last year as an affiliate of the Marlins.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins had a history in the old Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and current Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings and went 78-61 to qualify for the playoffs. They were swept by the South Bend Cubs in the 2019 MWL Championship Series.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#19), Thomas Dillard (#21), and Joe Gray Jr. (#30). PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing last season. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis beat Beloit <u>at Pohlman Field on June 29</u>. He allowed a run on two hits with two hits, a walk, and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings pitched.

VS. BELOIT (2021): Jarvis is 1-1 in two starts against Beloit this season. He lost to the Snappers at home on May 6 at home and had the win at Pohlman Field on June 29. He has allowed five runs on seven hits with three walks and nine strikeouts over ten innings against the Snappers this season.

RHP BRYAN HOEING: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the 7^{th} round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Louisville.

TEAMMATES: Hoeing was teammates with Timber Rattlers pitcher Nick Bennett at Louisville. Hoeing was 3-4 with a save and a 3.00 ERA in 22 games – five starts – for the Cardinals. Hoeing pitched in the 2019 Regional Final against Illinois State on June 3, 2019 and allowed one hit over five innings.

IN THE MUCK: Hoeing made his pro debut with the Batavia Muckdogs after signing with the Marlins in 2019. He was 0-2 in nine relief appearances in the New York-Penn League. Hoeing walked five, struck out 17, and compiled a 4.43 ERA in 22-1/3 innings with Batavia.

LAST START: Hoeing had a no decision <u>at Peoria on July 30</u>. He allowed four runs on eight hits over five innings. Hoeing hit a batter, walked none, and struck out nine in the game,

VS. WISCONSIN: Hoeing is 0-1 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He took the loss at Wisconsin on May 5 and had a no decision at Pohlman Field on June 30. In his two starts against the Timber Rattlers, Hoeing has allowed thirteen runs on fourteen hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over 9-2/3 innings pitched.
