ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The South Bend Cubs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 13-4 at Four Winds Field. South Bend scored six runs in the first inning and kept adding to their lead throughout the game. Wisconsin pitchers walked twelve and gave up fourteen hits in the game. The Timber Rattlers avoided the shutout with four runs in the top of the ninth.

LEFT AT THE STARTING LINE: The first five Cubs to bat in the bottom of the first inning reached base and scored against Wisconsin starting pitcher Alexander Cornielle. There was a double, a walk, and a single to load the bases to start the inning. Moises Ballesteros drove in two runs with a single. Then, Felix Stevens hit a three-run home run to extend his hitting streak to thirteen games and make it 5-0. Cornielle got the first out with a strikeout, but walked the next three batters and left the game.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: Karlos Morales took over for Cornielle in the first inning and allowed one of the three runners to score. It happened on a two-out, wild pitch. Morales has inherited twenty runners this season and that run-scoring wild pitch was the first time he has allowed an inherited runner to score

A TRIP TO THE MOUND: Alex Hall started the game in left field but moved to the mound for the bottom of the eighth inning to become the first Wisconsin position player to pitch this season. He had a runner at first with two outs before giving up another single and a two-run double to pinch-hitter Liam Spence. Hall was the only Rattler pitcher who didn't issue a walk last night.

AVOIDING A ZERO: The first three Wisconsin batters in the ninth inning walked and Ernesto Martinez Jr cleared the bases with a triple. Hall followed with a sacrifice fly to account for the final run. The Timber Rattlers have been shut out three times this season.

**DEBUT:** Brock Wilken, the #1 pick of the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2023 Draft, made his Timber Rattlers debut last night. Wilken was 0-for-3 with two strikeouts, a walk, and a run scored against the Cubs

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. They are the defending Midwest League Champions after finishing 73-58 last season, beating Cedar Rapids in the Western Division Finals, and Lake County in the Championship Series. South Bend also won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend went 30-35 in the first half and finished in fourth place in the West Division, 9-1/2 games behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels. The Cubs went 2-8 in the last ten games of the first half. The Cubs were in Peoria before this series started and won the first four games of the series before dropping the final two games to the Chiefs at Dozer Park.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: South Bend won the second half West Division title in 2022 with a 39-26 record 5-1/2 games in front of the Timber Rattlers. The Cubs beat Cedar Rapids 2-1 in the best-of-three West Final and Lake County 2-1 in the best-of-three Championship Series.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Bradley Blalock (#15), Eduardo García (#20), and Matthew Wood (#25). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has five active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Kevin Alcántara (#4), James Triantos (#11), Michael Arias (#13), Moises Ballesteros (#18), and Ed Howard (#22).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3. 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

**NORTH TO ALASKA:** Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

**LAST START:** Woessner had a no decision against Cedar Rapids on <u>July 28</u> at home. He allowed two runs – one earned – on one hit with three walks and seven strikeouts over five innings. Wisconsin won the game 4-3 in ten innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Woessner had a no decision against South Bend at home on May 11. He scattered eight hits and allowed one run with two walks and three strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings against the Cubs. He left the game with the Rattlers trailing 1-0, but Wisconsin rallied for a 3-1 win.

# SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MICHAEL ARIAS: The Cubs signed Arias as a Minor League Free Agent on January 15, 2021.

**AM I BLUE?** Arias was originally signed by the Toronto Blue Jays as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 5, 2018. Arias never pitched a game in the Toronto system and was released on May 29, 2020.

A PLACE TO CALL HOME: Arias started his pro career with the Cubs Blue affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made sixteen relief appearances and was 4-1 with three saves and a 3.09 ERA. Last year, Arias transitioned into a starter between the Arizona Complex League and Myrtle Beach in the Carolina League. In ten starts – eight in the ACL and two with Myrtle Beach – Arias was 0-4 with a 4.76 ERA, 22 walks, and 22 strikeouts over seventeen innings.

**STARTING OVER:** Arias started the 2023 season with Myrtle Beach. He was 1-4 in eleven starts with a 2.55 ERA and 64 strikeouts over 42-1/3 innings. Arias was promoted to South Bend on June 28.

**INTO HISTORY:** On <u>July 6</u>, in his second start with the Cubs, Arias was part of a four-pitcher no-hitter against the Peoria Chiefs at home. He pitched the first three innings, walked four, hit a batter, and struck out five, but didn't allow a hit.

**LAST START:** Arias lost at Peoria on <u>July 29</u>. He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Arias has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. In 2022, Arias faced both of Milwaukee's Arizona Complex League affiliates (June 14 and August 11) and the Carolina Mudcats (September 6). In those three starts against Brewers affiliates last season, Arias was 0-1 and allowed four runs on four hits with eight walks and six strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings. Current Rattler Jheremy Vargas homered off Arias in the game on August 11.

# THIS DATE IN TIMBER RATTLERS HISTORY

August 4, 1997: The Rattlers beat West Michigan 7-1 at home. Julio Ayala pitched seven shutout innings and Wisconsin blew open a 2–0 lead with five runs in the bottom of the seventh.

August 4, 2004: The Rattlers beat Clinton 2-1 at home. The LumberKings scored a run in the top of the sixth inning. Adam Jones had a two-run single in the bottom of the sixth to put Wisconsin in the lead. Jason Mackintosh had ten strikeouts over seven innings for the Rattlers to grab the win.

Bonilla committed a balk to let Conlon get into scoring position with the tying run, but he eventually struck out Matt Stocco on a 3-2 pitch to end the game and pick up the save.
