SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber

Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 2-0 at

Sunday. That did not hurt his candidacy and Barrios named the Midwest League Player of the Week on Monday after a spectacular five games in the series against the Kernels. He was 13-for-18 (.722) with six doubles and eight RBI over five games. Barrios had two or more hits in all five games of this series and compiled an OPS of 1.818 last week.

DOMINGO: Jimenez pitched five scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out four on Sunday to move his record to 3-0 in three starts this season. He has made all three of his starts this season on Sunday. Jimenez was 5-2 in ten games - eight starts - on Sundays in 2023. He has won his last six appearances on a Sunday dating back to his final three appearances last season.

STRIKE HARD! STRIKE FAST: The Timber Rattlers have outscored opponents 21-8 in the first inning this season. Dylan O'Rae started Sunday's bottom of the first by drawing a walk. Jadher Areinamo followed with an RBI double. Luis Lara drove in Areinamo with a sacrifice fly for the second run.

LEADING THE WAY: O'Rae reached base to start the Wisconsin first inning in each of the last five games of series with the Kernels. He scored in this first inning four times in the series. Overall, O'Rae has scored at least one run in seven straight games and leads the Midwest League with seventeen runs scored.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). MLB Pipeline has nine active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#7), Won-Bin Cho (#9), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#22), Pete Hansen (#26), Joshua Baez (#29), and William Sullivan (#30).

THE CHIEFS SO FAR: Peoria is 6-9 to start the season. The Chiefs avoided a six-game sweep at Quad Cities with a win on Sunday afternoon over the River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. Peoria's only home series prior to this one with Wisconsin was against Beloit from April 9 through April 14. The Chiefs were 4-2 in that series with the Sky Carp.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PATRICIO AQUINO: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Aquino as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on January 15, 2021.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: Aquino made his professional debut with the Brewers #1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He made eleven starts and was 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 44 innings pitched.

LET'S GO TO ARIZONA: Aquino was 2-1 with a 4.72 ERA in eight games – seven starts – for the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League during the 2022 season. He had 49 strikeouts over 34-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO CAROLINA: Aquino was 5-3 with a 2.75 ERA in 21 games – 19 starts – with 86 strikeouts over 88-1/3 innings pitched during the 2023 regular season.

PLAYOFF CALL: Aquino was the starting pitcher for the Mudcats in Game Two of the first round Carolina League playoff series against the Down East Wood Ducks. He had a no decision with six scoreless innings. The Mudcats would lose the game 6-5 in ten innings.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline rates Aquino as the #29 prospect in the Brewers organization.

LAST START: Aquino pitched five innings in game one of a doubleheader against the Cedar Rapids Kernels at home on <u>April 17</u>. He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and a strikeout to earn the win.

VS. PEORIA: Aquino has never faced the Peoria Chiefs prior to this evening. The only time he has pitched against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals was in a Dominican Summer League game on <u>August 27, 2021</u>. Aquino pitched four innings as the starting pitcher, allowed two runs on two hits and three walks, and struck out seven for a no decision.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP INOHAN PANIAGUA: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Paniagua as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on December 22, 2017.

STARTING IN THE SUMMER: Paniagua made fourteen starts and was 3-3 with a 3.77 ERA for the Cardinals Blue affiliate in the Dominican Summer League during 2018. He had 51 strikeouts in 57-1/3 innings pitched.

OFF TO STATE COLLEGE: In 2019, Paniagua started the season in the New York-Penn League with the State College Spikes where he made two starts before a transfer to the Gulf Coast League. Paniagua made thirteen appearances – eleven starts – in 2019. He was 2-5 with a 6.38 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 49-2/3 innings.

TO THE BEACH AND BACK: Paniagua was a member of the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2021 and started with them in 2022. Paniagua had 107 strikeouts over 99 innings pitched in 2022 before a promotion to Peoria on July 26 of that season. He started 2023 on the injured list, made three rehab starts in the FCL, and rejoined Peoria in early July. He would also pitch for Scottsdale in the Arizona Fall League during this past offseason.

PEORIA NUMBERS: Including this season, Paniagua is 3-6 with a 4.58 ERA in 21 starts for the Chiefs. He has 88 strikeouts over 92-1/3 innings pitched

LAST START: Paniagua lost at Quad Cities in game one of a doubleheader on April 17. He allowed seven runs – six earned – on seven hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Paniagua made a start against the Timber Rattlers on September 1, 2022 at Dozer Park for a no decision. He allowed three runs on five hits with four walks and five strikeouts in four innings. Darrien Miller and Jeferson Quero both homered off Paniagua.
