SATURDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 6-3 in game two of the series at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#)

Both teams have won a game heading into today's series finale. Wisconsin, which was held to one hit on Friday, bounced back with eleven hits yesterday.

TWO-BY-TWO: Wisconsin took a 2-0 lead with two runs in the bottom of the second inning. Jesús Chirinos had an RBI double. Dylan O'Rae followed with an RBI single. The Chiefs tied the game in the top of the fourth on a two-run double by Michael Curialle.

SETTLED IN: Wisconsin starting pitcher Alexander Cornielle got the final two outs in the fourth and pitched around a single in the fifth to keep the game tied.

TAKING THE FIFTH: Wisconsin's first five batters in the fifth inning reached base. Gregory Barrios drove in two runs with a bases-loaded double to give the Rattlers the lead. Jadherr Areinamo followed with a two-run single, and the Rattlers were up 6-2.

KING OF TRIOS: Mike Boeve went 3-for-5 with a double and a run scored for the Rattlers on Saturday. It was the first three-hit game by a Rattler this season.

SAVING THE DAY: Yerlin Rodríguez pitched into and out of trouble in the top of the ninth inning to earn his first Midwest League save. A lead-off walk and a one-out hit batsman brought the tying run to the plate. Rodríguez struck out Won-Bin Cho, who had three hits before the ninth inning, for the second out of the ninth. Then, Rodríguez struck out Brody Moore looking to end the game.

TIGHTENED UP THE DEFENSE: Wisconsin played error-free ball yesterday. The Rattlers committed three errors on Friday. Wisconsin also turned their first double play of the season, a nifty 5-3 double play in the sixth inning that stopped a possible Peoria rally.

Reliever Jake Polancic walked the first two batters of the sixth before getting Curialle to send a grounder to third. Boeve made a nice pick, stepped on third, and threw to first to complete the double play.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

THE FULL-SEASON JOURNEY: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2. Once he was a Timber Rattler in 2023, Jimenez was 7-5 with a 4.50 ERA in 21 games – 15 starts – with 93 strikeouts over 102 innings pitched.

NEAR MISS: Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31, 2023 after a taking a no-hitter into the eighth inning against Cedar Rapids on [July 30](#). He earned the award by striking out ten Kernels over 7-1/3 scoreless innings. Jimenez walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

LAST APPEARANCE: Jimenez beat Cedar Rapids as a reliever on [September 10, 2023](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings. Jimenez allowed two homers in the game.

LAST START: Jimenez allowed two runs – one earned on five hits over seven innings to earn the win at Beloit on [September 3, 2023](#). He walked one and struck out seven in the game

VS. PEORIA: Jimenez went 1-1 in four games – two starts – against the Chiefs in 2023. He allowed ten runs on seventeen hits with three walks and twelve strikeouts over fifteen innings versus Peoria last season.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP PETE HANSEN: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hansen in the third round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Texas.

THE EYES OF TEXAS: Hansen went 22-4 with a 2.67 ERA and 218 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings in his career with the Longhorns. He was 11-3 with 120 strikeouts over 107-2/3 innings in his final season at Texas.

SHUTDOWN MODE: Hansen signed with St. Louis on July 23, 2022 and did not pitch professionally until the 2023 season.

GET IT STARTED: Hansen began his career with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League in 2023. He went 11-3 with a 3.09 ERA and 126 strikeouts over 112-2/3 innings pitched over 23 starts last season.

MEMPHIS IN THE MEANTIME: Hansen made a relief appearance for the Memphis Redbirds, the Triple-A Affiliate of the Cardinals on [September 24, 2023](#). He pitched a scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and no strikeouts for a no decision.

STACKING AWARDS: Hansen was the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on August 13, 2023, a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star, and an MiLB.com St. Louis Cardinals Organizational All Star last year.

HOW DOES HE RATE? Hansen is rated as the #26 prospect in the St. Louis system by MLB Pipeline and the #28 Cardinals prospect by Baseball America.

LAST START: Hansen won against Clearwater on [September 6, 2023](#) at home as a starter for the Palm Beach Cardinals. He allowed four hits, walked two, and struck out seven over 5-2/3 scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hansen has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time Hansen will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
