WELCOME BACK! The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers are ready to begin the 2022 season with today's game against the Peoria Chiefs. Wisconsin finished the 2021 season at 59-60.

MOVING THROUGH SOME CHANGES: Joe Ayrault is the new manager of the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers. Ayrault replaces Matt Erickson, who had been the Wisconsin manager from 2011 through 2021. Erickson was promoted to the Milwaukee Brewers coaching staff during the offseason. Nick Stanley, the hitting coach for the Rattlers, is the only member of the coaching staff to return from last season. Will Schierholz is the new pitching coach. Patrick McGuff has joined the staff as the development coach. Liu Rodriguez, a Timber Rattlers coach during the 2015 season, is back in Wisconsin as a coach.

OPENING DAY HISTORY – CHAPTER ONE: This will be the 14th time since 1995 the Timber Rattlers will open a season with a home game. This is also the third consecutive season for Wisconsin to open their schedule at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Wisconsin is 14-12 in their first 26 season-opening games.

OPENING DAY HISTORY – CHAPTER TWO: This is the seventh time Wisconsin has opened a season with a game against the Peoria Chiefs. The only team the Rattlers have faced more in their first game of the season is Beloit (eight times). The Timber Rattlers are 3-3 in Opening Day games against the Chiefs, including a 2-1 record at home. Additionally, the first game in Timber Rattlers history was on April 7, 1995, a 6-0 loss to the Chiefs at Pete Vonachen Stadium in Peoria.

HOME OPENER HISTORY: The Timber Rattlers are 16-10 in 26 Home Openers during their history. Wisconsin has played Peoria five times in a Home Opener with a record of 2-3. The Chiefs have beaten Wisconsin three straight times when they have been the opponent to open the home schedule.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodriguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Chiefs2 on their list of Cardinals prospects – four active and two on the injured list: Maysin Winn (#5), Michael McGreevy (#8), Austin Love (#21), and Gordon Graceffo (#23) are on the active list. Ian Bedell (#22) and Jhon Torres (#24) are on the Peoria Injured List.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing last season. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis had [a no decision at Great Lakes on September 17, 2021](#). He allowed an unearned run on two hits with four walks and four strikeouts over 3-2/3.

VS. PEORIA (2021): Jarvis made three starts and had no decisions against the Chiefs in 2021. He allowed six runs on eleven hits with eleven walks and nine strikeouts over ten innings in those three starts against Peoria last season.

INNINGS PITCHED: 7.0 – 6/20/2019 v. Clinton

STRIKEOUTS: 10 – 9/3/2021 v. Beloit

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MICHAEL MCGREEVY: The Cardinals drafted McGreevy with the 18th pick of the first round in the 2021 draft out of UC-Santa Barbara.

GAUCHO: McGreevy was 9-2 with a 2.92 ERA in sixteen starts at UCSB in 2021. He had 115 strikeouts and eleven walks in 101-2/3 innings pitched.

INTO THE PROS: McGreevy made seven starts after signing with the Cardinals. He was 0-2 in two starts that lasted a total of 1-2/3 innings Florida Complex League Cardinals and made five starts with no record for Palm Beach in the Low-A Southeast. He pitched just 7-2/3 innings with seven strikeouts and two walks as a professional last year.

EIGHT BALL: MLB Pipeline rates McGreevy as the #8 prospect in the St. Louis organization. Baseball America puts him a little higher at #4.

LAST START: McGreevy had a no decision on September 19, 2021 for the Palm Beach Cardinals against the Daytona Tortugas. He allowed two runs on three hits with no walks and no strikeouts in one innings pitched.

VS. WISCONSIN: McGreevy has never faced Wisconsin prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
