SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-3 at Neuroscience Group Field. Beloit had leads of 1-0, 2-1, and 4-2 and held on for the win.

**MATCHING A STANDARD:** Wisconsin starting pitcher Ryan Birchard tied his professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven on Saturday. He struck out the side in order in the second inning.

**BLACKJACK:** Blake Burke went 2-for-5 with a double and a walk on Saturday to extend his on-base streak to 21 games (27-for-81, eleven walks, .413 OBP, .932 OPS). He is tied with Kyle DeBarge of Cedar Rapids for the longest on-base streak in the league this season.

**PEEK PERFORMANCE:** Reliever Zach Peek pitched a scoreless ninth inning on Saturday. He has allowed one run in 6-2/3 innings over his last five appearances with two walks and eight strikeouts.

WELCOME BACK: Tanner Shears pitched 1-1/3 scoreless innings in relief yesterday in his first game with the Rattlers since September 9, 2023. He missed the 2024 season after undergoing Tommy John

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

# WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TANNER GILLIS:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Gillis had a no decision at Kannapolis on May 11. He allowed one run on three hits and two walks with three strikeouts over four innings.

**LAST START:** Gillis allowed two earned runs on three hits with five strikeouts over seven innings at West Virginia as the starting pitcher for Mahoning Valley on August 22, 2024.

**VS. BELOIT:** Gillis has never pitched against Beloit prior to this afternoon. Today is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

#### BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL SCHOMBERG: Acquired by the Miami Marlins in a trade with the Seattle Mariners for JT Chargois on July 30, 2024.

**ON THE SEA:** The Mariners originally signed Schomberg as a nondrafted free agent on July 22, 2023. He had pitched collegiately at Davidson University. Schomberg was 12-4 with a 4.55 ERA in 52 games – fifteen starts – in four years at Davidson. He pitched for Everett and Modesto in the Seattle system last season before the trade to Miami.

**DRAFT POSITION:** Schomberg pitched two seasons in the MLB Draft League. He made ten relief appearances for West Virginia in 2022 and six appearances – two starts – for Williamsport in 2023.

**ON WISCONSIN:** Schomberg made six starts with Beloit after the trade in 2024. He was 1-3 with a 7.13 ERA, walked 23 and struck out 32 in 24 innings with the Sky Carp.

**LAST START:** Schomberg lost to Cedar Rapids at home on May 11. He allowed five runs on three hits over 5-2/3 innings. Schomberg walked three, hit a batter, and struck out four.

VS. WISCONSIN: Schomberg has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
