SUNDAY IN THE PARK: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 4-1 at Modern Woodmen Park. Brandon Knarr pitched seven scoreless innings with nine strikeouts and Joe Gray Jr hit a two-run home run for the Rattlers. Wisconsin went 5-1 in the series at Quad Cities.

BLACKOUT: Tyler Black had three hits, a run score, and an RBI for the Rattlers on Sunday. He has been Wisconsin's lead-off batter in the last eight games. Black has been on base nineteen times and scored nine runs in his eight games as the lead-off hitter.

THE NUMBER 23: Tristan Peters doubled and walked on Sunday and extended his current on-base streak to 23 games. He has an OPS of .947 with thirteen walks, sixteen runs scored, and thirteen RBI during the streak. Peters has the longest active on-base streak in the Midwest League. This is the longest on-base streak by a Rattler since Thomas Dillard went on a 29-game onbase streak from July 14 through August 15 in 2019. SEVENTH HEAVEN: Knarr pitched seven scoreless innings, allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out ten on Sunday. He became the first Wisconsin starter to complete seven innings in a game this season. Knarr has also won his last five starts. Knarr leads the Midwest League in wins (5), is second in strikeouts (48), and is fourth in ERA (1.34).

COMPARE AND CONTRAST: Minor League Baseball announced Matt Mervis of South Bend and Pat Monteverde of Beloit as the Midwest League's Player and Pitcher of the Week for their performances last week. Mervis was 12-for-23 (.521) with two homers, seven RBI, four runs scored, and an OPS of 1.639. Monteverde was 1-0 in one start with seven scoreless innings, four hits allowed and no walks with four strikeouts. Black was 11-for-25 (.440), two homers, eleven RBI, six runs scored, and an OPS of 1.300. Knarr was 2-0 in two starts, allowed two runs on eight hits, and struck out fifteen over twelve innings.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). ## PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP ANTOINE KELLY:** Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

**SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO:** The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres.

**THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE:** Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

**LAST START:** Kelly had a <u>no decision at Quad Cities on May 11</u>. Kelly allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. Wisconsin won the game 3-2.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Kelly has never faced South Bend prior to this evening. This evening will also be the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL ESPINOZA: The Cubs signed Espinoza as an International Free Agent on July 31, 2017 out of Mexico.

**STARTING OUT:** Espinoza made his professional debut with the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Arizona League in 2019. He was 5-2 in eleven games – seven starts – with nine walks, 37 strikeouts, and a 2.49 ERA in 47 innings pitched in the AZL.

**TIME ON THE BEACH:** Espinoza pitched for the Myrtle Beach Pelicans in the Low-A East in 2021. He was 4-9 with a 5.11 ERA in 22 starts. Espinoza walked 26 and struck out 92 over 98-2/3 innings pitched as a Pelican last season.

**SOUTH OF THE BORDER:** Espinoza has pitched for Tomateros de Culicán of the Mexican Pacific Winter League during the offseason between 2020 and 2021 and the offseason between 2021 and 2022. He has made six appearances – four starts – with a 2-1 record and a 3.63 ERA over 22-1/3 innings pitched for his hometown team.

**LAST START:** Espinoza had a no decision against <u>Fort Wayne at home on May 11</u>. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Espinoza has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The only time Espinoza has pitched against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers in his career was on <u>July 21, 2019</u> when he allowed one run on five hits with no walks and a strikeout over five innings against Milwaukee's Gold affiliate in the Arizona League.
