ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-0 at Perfect Game Field.](#)

Wander Javier and Aaron Sabato each drove in two runs and four Cedar Rapids pitchers held Wisconsin to a pair of hits in the game.

FOUR BY FOUR: The Kernels scored four runs in the bottom of the fourth inning to take a 4-0 lead. Four straight Cedar Rapids batters reached with one out in the inning. All four reached by putting a two-strike pitch in play and all four scored.

TWO MORE HITS: Carlos Rodríguez had both of Wisconsin's hits on Thursday night. He had a lead-off bunt single in the third and a two-out triple in the fifth. Rodríguez was 2-for-3 last night for his tenth multi-hit game of the season. He is tied with Xavier Warren for the team lead in multi-hit games. Rodríguez is 7-for-11 in this series with the Kernels.

TWO-OUT BINGO: The Kernels scored a run in the seventh and four more runs in the eighth. All five of the runs scored after there were two outs in the inning.

NOT SINCE: Thursday's game was only the second time the Timber Rattlers have been shutout this season. The only other time Wisconsin was held without a run was a 1-0 loss to Peoria in game one of a doubleheader on April 10.

LATE MOVE: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers added infielder Jader Areinamo to the roster before Thursday's game. Wisconsin's roster is at 28 active players, two under the limit of 30.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). [MLB Pipeline](#) has three current Cedar Rapids players on their Top 30 list of Twins prospects: Alerick Soularie (#24), Cade Povich (#26), and Christian Encarnacion-Strand (#28).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP BRANDON KNARR: The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

GOLDEN DOME: Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

TO FLORIDA: Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

TAMPA, TOO: Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

IN THE MUD: Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

AS A RATTLER LAST YEAR: Knarr made five starts with Wisconsin at the end of the 2021 season. He went 1-1 with fourteen walks, 25 strikeouts, and fifteen earned runs allowed over 22-1/3 innings.

AWARD WINNING: Minor League Baseball named Knarr the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on May 23, 2022 for his performance on May 21 against South Bend.

LAST START: Knarr [beat South Bend at home on May 21](#). He allowed five hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Knarr has won six consecutive starts.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Knarr was 0-1 in two starts against the Kernels in 2021. He allowed ten runs – nine earned – on seven hits with nine walks and ten strikeouts over 7-1/3 innings in those two starts.

CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOHN STANKIEWICZ: The Twins signed Stankiewicz as a non-drafted free agent on July 6, 2020 out of Fordham University.

RAMMING SPEED: Stankiewicz was 11-5 in 36 games – nineteen starts – in his college career at Fordham. He had an ERA of 2.00 with 37 walks and 145 strikeouts in college.

MAN OF THE YEAR: Stankiewicz was named the Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore. He was 8-4 in seventeen games – thirteen starts – with a 1.47 ERA with 102 strikeouts over 92 innings to help the Rams to an A-10 Tournament Championship and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament at the Morgantown Regional.

IN THE ARENA: Stankiewicz made one start in the Florida Complex League and seven appearances – four starts – for Fort Myers in 2021. He was 1-0 with a 2.84 ERA, nine walks, and 30 strikeouts over 25-1/3 innings pitched in his first professional season.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORT: Stankiewicz started the 2022 season with Fort Myers in the Florida State League before earning a promotion to Cedar Rapids on April 30. Stankiewicz was 3-0 with 31 strikeouts and only two earned runs allowed over 21-2/3 innings pitched for the Mighty Mussels before the move to the Midwest League.

LAST START: Stankiewicz [lost to Lake County at home on May 21](#). He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Stankiewicz has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
