ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-2 at Neuroscience Group Field. Quad Cities broke a 1-1 tie with three runs in the fourth inning and added three more runs in the fifth to take control of the game.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Julio Teherán of the Milwaukee Brewers was the starting pitcher for the Timber Rattlers last night. He allowed a two-out, solo homer to River Town in the first inning. Teherán pitched three innings, allowed one run on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts. He threw 43 pitches - 30 strikes.

MULTI-BALL: Luis Lara and Jheremy Vargas both had two hits for Wisconsin last night. Lara's first hit was a two-out, RBI single in the third inning to tie the game 1-1. Vargas also walked in the game when Ben Kudrna let the pitch clock expire before throwing a payoff pitch.

FIRST OF THE YEAR: Tyler Woessner made his first relief appearance of the season for the Timber Rattlers when he entered the game in the fourth inning. It was just the second relief appearance in Woessner's professional career. Woessner went four innings last night and has 111 innings pitched in 2023. He is second in the league in innings behind Trent Baker of Peoria, who has 113-1/3 innings this season.

UNBALANCED: The Timber Rattlers are 7-15 against the River Bandits this season. Quad Cities is hitting .253 with twenty homers and 125 runs scored in the series. Wisconsin is hitting .203 with twelve homers and 85 runs scored in the series with the Bandits.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRADLEY BLALOCK: Milwaukee acquired Blalock in exchange for Luís Urías in a trade with the Boston Red Sox on August 1, 2023.

ORIGIN STORY: The Red Sox selected Blalock out of Grayson High School in Loganville, Georgia with their 32nd round pick in the 2019 draft. Blalock signed with Boston over a commitment to Kennesaw State University.

START STOP START STOP: Blalock went 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA in four games - three starts - in the Gulf Coast League in 2019, missed the 2020 season due to the shutdown, was 3-6 with a 4.27 ERA in 23 starts for the Salem Red Sox in 2021, and missed the 2022 season due to Tommy John Surgery in March of 2022.

QUICK MOVES: Blalock returned to action with Salem on May 24, 2023. He was transferred to the Greeneville Drive, the South Atlantic League affiliate of the Red Sox, on June 20 and made his High-A debut at Bowling Green on June 22. Blalock was 6-1 with a 2.19 ERA and 58 strikeouts over 53-1/3 innings pitched in eleven starts before the trade to the Brewers.

ON A ROLL: Blalock was 4-0 with a 1.75 ERA and 26 strikeouts over 25-2/3 innings in five starts in July. MLB Pipeline added Blalock to the Milwaukee Top 30 Prospect List at #15 after the trade. He is now at #19 after the update on August 11.

LAST START: Blalock had a no decision at Cedar Rapids on August 19. He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings. Wisconsin trailed 3-1 when Blalock left the game and eventually fell behind 5-1 before rallying to tie the game 5-5 in the ninth. However, the Kernels scored a run in the bottom of the ninth to beat the Rattlers 6-5.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Blalock has never pitched against Quad Cities prior to this evening. He made a start against Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals on June 8, 2023. Blalock allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out six over five scoreless innings to earn the

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STEVEN ZOBAC: The Kansas City Royals selected Zobac out of the University of California in the fourth round of the 2022 draft.

BERKELEY BEAR: Zobac was 7-8 with four saves and a 4.48 ERA in 39 games - eleven starts - over three seasons at Cal. He had 100 strikeouts in 86-1/3 innings pitched during his career Zobac was a two-way player for his first two seasons before moving almost exclusively to the mound in 2022. In his final season of college baseball, Zobac was 4-4 with a 4.09 ERA with 72 strikeouts over 61-2/3 innings over twenty games – ten starts.

DELAYED DEBUT: Zobac did not pitch professionally in 2022. He made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies in the Carolina League in 2023. Zobac was 1-2 with a 2.09 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts – with 61 strikeouts over 51-2/3 innings pitched before his promotion to Quad Cities on July 18.

AWARD SEASON: Zobac was named the Carolina League pitcher of the month in April 2023. He allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out eighteen in eight innings over three relief appearances. Zobac was 1-0 for the Fireflies in April.

LAST START: Zobac had a no decision against Beloit at home on August 19. He allowed an unearned run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Zobac has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
