ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Beloit Sky Carp 4-2 at ABC Supply Stadium in the season opening game for both teams. The Timber Rattlers scored single runs in the first, second, third, and seventh innings as four pitchers combined for 14 strikeouts and held Beloit to three hits. Wisconsin has won four straight season-opening games and is 16-12 in 28 season-opening games.

A NIGHT OF FIRSTS: Ryan Brady pitched three scoreless, hitless innings and struck out five for his first professional win. Caleb "Bo" Bowman worked a 1-2-3 ninth inning for his first save in affiliated ball.

ANY WAY YOU WANT IT: Wisconsin was 0-for-12 with runners in scoring position and stranded twelve runners last night. Wisconsin scored their runs on bases loaded walks to Ben Metzinger and Je'Von Ward, a passed ball to score Jesús Chirinos and an RBI fielder's choice by Chirinos.

TURNING POINT: Wisconsin had a 3-2 lead in the bottom of the third inning and Beloit had runners at the corners with one out. Starting pitcher Joe Hernandez escaped the jam by getting Jake Thompson to ground into a 4-6-3 double play. Hernandez struck out six over four innings in his debut in the Milwaukee system.

MULTI BALL: Joe Gray Jr and Metzinger each had two hits for the Rattlers. Metzinger also walked twice in the game.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner took the loss in Game Three of the ABL Semifinal series against Perth [on January 28, 2023](#). He allowed six runs on five hits and two walks over 1-2/3 innings.

VS. BELOIT: Wagoner has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEX WILLIAMS: The Marlins selected Williams in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Stanford.

THE CARDINAL: Williams pitched four seasons at Stanford and was 23-8 with a 2.88 ERA in 47 games – 42 starts. He had 211 strikeouts in 237-2/3 innings pitched during his college career.

TROPHY CASE: Williams was the Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a First Team All-American for Collegiate Baseball and College Baseball Foundation after he went 8-4 with a 3.20 ERA in eighteen starts in helping Stanford win the Pac-12 regular season and tournament championships. Williams had 96 strikeouts over 101-1/3 innings pitched as a senior at Stanford.

AT THE COMPLEX: Williams signed with Miami and made two brief starts in for the Florida Complex Marlins without a decision. In five innings, he didn't allow a hit, a walk, or a run while striking out five.

LAST START: Williams had a no decision against the [FCL Astros Blue on August 20, 2022](#). He pitched three scoreless, hitless innings with no walks and three strikeouts in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Williams has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
