### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers defeated the Peoria Chiefs 8-3 at Neuroscience Group Field in Wisconsin's home opener.](#)

Tyler Woessner allowed three runs – one earned – over five innings for the win. Ernesto Martínez, Jr, Robert Moore, and Je'Von Ward each had two RBI in the game for the Rattlers.

**FIRST!** Woessner's win was his first as a professional. He walked two and struck out five for the victory.

**HOME OPENER HISTORY:** Wisconsin in 20-8 in their home openers since 1995. The Rattlers have won their last four home openers and six of their last seven. Last night was also the warmest home opener in Timber Rattlers history. The game time temperature last night was 75°. The previous high temperature for the Wisconsin home opener was 68° for an afternoon game against Peoria on April 12, 2015.

**GOING DEEP AGAIN:** Martínez hit a two-run home run to the new seats on top of the wall in left in the bottom of the third inning. Martínez has homered in two straight games.

**GRAY HAVEN:** Gray had two more hits last night. He is on a four-game hitting streak to start the season (6-for-17, .353).

**OH WHAT A RELIEF:** Russell Smith took over for Woessner to start the top of the sixth inning. In the seventh, the Chiefs had runners on first and second with one out and the Rattlers holding a 5-3 lead. Smith struck out the next two batters to close out the inning.

**SAVINGS PLAN:** Karlos Morales took over for Smith with two outs in the top of the eighth with the Rattlers up 6-3 and got the final out. Morales pitched a scoreless ninth after the Rattlers scored two insurance runs in the bottom of the eighth to pick up his first save of the season.

**NICE DEBUT:** Eric Brown Jr., the first-round pick of the Milwaukee Brewers, made his Timber Rattlers debut last night and was 1-for-4 with a run scored.

**ABOUT PEORIA:** The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1983 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1984. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

**ABOUT THE CARDINALS:** St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#16), Eduardo García (#22), and Joseph Hernandez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Cooper Hjerpe (#7), Jimmy Crooks (#16), Austin Love (#20), Ian Bedell (#25), Dionys Rodriguez (#27), and Victor Scott II (#28). Inohan Paniagua (#18) is on Peoria's IL.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

**FEELING 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision against [Beloit at home on September 8, 2022](#). He allowed a run on four hits over six innings with two walks and seven strikeouts.

**VS. PEORIA:** Cornielle [won at Peoria on September 2, 2022](#). He allowed a run on five hits with a walk and six strikeouts over six innings for his first Midwest League victory.

## PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ZANE MILLS:** The St. Louis Cardinals drafted Mills out of Washington State University with their fourth-round selection in the 2021 draft.

**LET'S GO COUGARS:** Mills went 5-5 with a 4.15 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 80-1/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts in his final season at Washington State. He was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week twice in 2021.

**IT'S COMPLEX:** Mills made seven relief appearances for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals after signing his professional contract. Mills allowed a run on four hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and nine strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings pitched.

**PALM READER:** Mills started 2022 with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League. He was 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA in seven starts with seven walks and 35 strikeouts over 41-1/3 innings before his promotion to Peoria on May 23. Mills was 4-6 with a 4.03 ERA in nineteen starts for the Chiefs after his promotion.

**LAST START:** Mills had a no decision at [Quad Cities on September 9, 2022](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN (2022):** Mills is 0-2 in three starts – [May 31](#), [June 5](#), and [September 3](#) – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He allowed seven runs – six earned – on twelve hits with three walks and fifteen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings pitched against Wisconsin last season.
