TUESDAY NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 10-2 at LMCU Ballpark.](#)

Marco Dinges and Jadhre Areinamo homered for the Rattlers offense. Wisconsin starting pitcher Jaron DeBerry allowed two runs over five innings and earned his second straight win. The Rattlers are 18-7 in their last 25 games to reach four games over .500 for the first time this season.

NUMBER NINE...NUMBER NINE: Areinamo drove in four runs on Tuesday. He drove in five runs on Sunday at Great Lakes to give him nine RBI in his two games.

STREAKING: Eduardo Garcia extended his on-base streak to 27 games on a two-run triple and two walks Tuesday. He is 32-for-101 (.317) with eight homers, ten doubles, 22 RBI, 29 runs, and sixteen stolen bases during the streak. Garcia has an OPS of 1.108 during the streak, which is the longest in the Midwest League this season.

HISTORY LESSON: Garcia has matched Robert Moore for the longest on-base streak by a Rattler since moving to High-A in 2021. Moore reached base in 27 straight games during the 2023 season. Here are the Top Five On-Base Streaks by a Rattler since 2005:

PITCHING IN: DeBerry allowed a run in the first on a two-out single by Josue Briceño and a run in the second on a one-out homer by Austin Murr. DeBerry retired eleven of the final twelve batters he faced with a two-out walk in the third inning the only base runner he allowed in that stretch. DeBerry struck out six over five innings. Bayden Root followed and allowed one hit over three scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Jack Seppings made his Wisconsin debut with a perfect ninth inning needing just five pitches.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Comstock Park, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps have won six Midwest League Pennants – 1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015.

Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Francisco Cordero, Brandon Inge, Cameron Maybin, Alex Avila, and Willy Adames. The Whitecaps clinched the first half East Division Championship on June 13 and are in the Midwest League playoffs for the first time since 2018.

ABOUT THE TIGERS: Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTHONY FLORES: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Flores as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on June 4, 2022.

ON AN ISLAND: Flores pitched the 2022 and 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League. He combined to go 3-8 with a 4.42 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 79-1/3 innings in 22 games – eighteen starts.

COMING TO AMERICA: Flores made twelve appearances in the Arizona Complex League and seven appearances with the Carolina Mudcats in 2024. He combined to go 5-4 with a 5.17 ERA and 85 strikeouts and 27 walks over 69-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Flores won at Great Lakes on [June 13](#). He allowed two runs – one earned – on seven hits and three walks with five strikeouts over six innings for his first quality start of the season.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN: Flores made two appearances – one start – against the Whitecaps in Wisconsin earlier this season. He pitched four innings and allowed two runs – one earned – as a reliever on [April 29](#) and allowed three runs on two hits over 3-2/3 innings as a starter on [May 4](#). Flores has no record with three walks, five strikeouts, and five hits allowed in his 7-2/3 innings against the Whitecaps this season.

WEST MICHIGAN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANDREW SEARS: The Tigers selected Sears in the tenth round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Connecticut.

LITTLE EAST TO BIG EAST: Sears started his collegiate career with two years at Rhode Island College of Little East Conference before pitching one year at the University of Connecticut in the Big East. In his one season at UCONN, Sears went 3-1 with a 6.24 ERA in fourteen starts with 74 strikeouts over 62 innings.

BOUNCING AROUND FOR THE SUMMER: Sears pitched for the Sherrill Silversmiths of the New York Collegiate League in 2021 and for the Valley Blue Sox of the New England Collegiate League in 2022 and 2023.

ONE RUNG AT A TIME: Sears made his pro debut with a one-inning relief appearance in the Florida Complex League in 2023. He spent 2024 with the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Florida State League. Sears was 6-4 with a 2.51 ERA in 22 games – 19 starts – with 101 strikeouts over 89-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Sears was the winning pitcher at Lansing on [June 12](#). He allowed five hits over five scoreless innings with two walks and five strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Sears lost as a reliever to the Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on [April 30](#). He allowed four runs on three hits with two walks and a strikeout over 2/3 of an inning.
