Wisconsin didn't get a runner to third until the ninth inning. Adrian Bohorquez pitched five scoreless innings for the Kernels to get the win. Michael Ross pitched four scoreless innings for the save. Wisconsin starting pitcher Josh Knoth allowed two runs over 5-2/3 innings.

**TWO-OUT BLUES:** Cedar Rapids scored all four runs in last night's game with two outs. Byron Chourio and Jacob McCombs had RBI hits with two outs in the fifth. Quinn McDaniel had a two-out, two-run single in the eighth.

**STARTING STONG:** Sawyer Strosnider singled in the third inning last night. Milwaukee's second-round pick in the 2026 draft out of Texas Christian University is 4-for-14 on a three-game hitting streak since joining the Timber Rattlers on Tuesday.

**SO LONG AND THANKS FOR THE HOMERS:** Braylon Payne was promoted to Biloxi earlier today. Payne hit 23 home runs to set the Timber Rattlers single-season franchise record in homers. He played 77 games with the Rattlers this season stole 22 bases, drove in 55 runs, and compiled an OPS of .930.

**ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS:** The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the end of the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended in 2024 when the Kernels missed the playoffs but started again in 2025 when they advanced to the Midwest League Championship Series. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

**ABOUT THE TWINS:** Minnesota has a long history in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

# STARTING PITCHERS

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ETHAN DORCHIES:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Dorchies in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

**GOING PRO:** Dorchies signed with the Brewers over a commitment to the University of Illinois-Chicago.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Dorchies is rated as the #24 prospect in the Brewers system by *Baseball America*.

**LAST SEASON:** Dorchies split time between the Arizona Complex League (Six games – three starts) and the Carolina Mudcats (Thirteen games – eight starts). Dorchies went 0-3 with four saves, a 2.74ERA, and 89 strikeouts in 82 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Dorchies lost at Beloit on [August 8](#). He allowed six runs on nine hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Dorchies beat Cedar Rapids at home on [June 25](#). He allowed one run on five hits over seven innings with a walk and three strikeouts.

## CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JUSTIN MITROVICH:** The Minnesota Twins selected Mitrovich in the ninth round of the 2025 draft out of Elon University.

**A RISING PHOENIX:** Mitrovich pitched three seasons at Elon. He was 14-14 with a 4.36 ERA in 43 games – 42 starts. Mitrovich walked 86 and struck out 243 over 233 innings pitched in college. He was 6-4 with a 4.23 ERA in fifteen starts and 81 strikeouts over 89-1/3 innings in his final season at Elon.

**ON THE BEACH:** Mitrovich did not pitch professionally last season. He started the season with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels and was 1-3 with a 2.74 ERA in eleven starts. Mitrovich walked eighteen and struck out 53 over 42-2/3 innings. He was promoted to the Cedar Rapids Kernels on July 16, 2026

**LAST START:** Mitrovich won at South Bend on [August 8](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out four over six scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Mitrovich has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
