### SUNDAY AFTERNOON: [The Cedar Rapids Kernels](http://TheCedarRapids.com)

[beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-3 at Perfect Game Field.](http://TheCedarRapids.com) The Kernels broke a 2-2 tie with five runs in the bottom of the sixth inning.

**ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL:** Wisconsin was no-hit and trailing 2-0 through the first five innings against starting pitcher Jaylen Nowlin, who was making his Kernels debut. Antonio Piñero broke up the no-no with a lead-off double in the sixth. Ben Metzinger drove in Piñero with a single. Reidy Mercado scored the tying run on a wild pitch.

**INTO THE CORN:** Cedar Rapids hit three two-run home runs on Sunday. Seth Gray hit a two-run homer in the first inning for Cedar Rapids. Wander Javier hit a two-run homer in the sixth to give the Kernels a 4-2 lead. Brooks Lee, the #1 pick of the Twins in the 2022 draft, hit a two-run home run to cap the inning.

**SO LONG AND THANKS FOR THE Ks:** Justin Jarvis was the starting pitcher for the Rattlers on Sunday. He allowed three runs and struck out six over 5-1/3 innings. Jarvis was promoted to Biloxi on Monday. He finished his season as a Rattler with 134 strikeouts over 121 innings. Jarvis is the Midwest League leader in strikeouts, innings pitched, and starts (24) as he moves up to the Southern League.

**WELCOME:** Milwaukee Brewers infielder Jace Peterson starts a rehab assignment tonight for the Timber Rattlers. He is scheduled to be here through Thursday.

**ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS:** The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Oakland Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

**ABOUT THE ATHLETICS:** The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since moving from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974. Oakland returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Oakland's affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. Oakland left the league after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, Oakland went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](http://MLBPipeline.com) puts four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#7), Carlos F. Rodríguez (#19), and Eduardo García (#21). Tyler Black (#6), Russell Smith (#20), and Carlos D. Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](http://MLBPipeline.com) has five current Lansing players on their Top 30 list of Athletics prospects: Max Muncy (#7), Denzel Clarke (#11), Brayan Buelvas (#23), Joey Estes (#25), and Cooper Bowman (#29). Euribiel Angeles (#19) is on the Kernels IL.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ:** Selected by Milwaukee in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of Florida SouthWestern State Junior College.

**ALL-DADE:** Rodríguez was a four-year letter winner at Miami Christian High School. He had a 0.67 ERA in his senior season of high school and was an All-Dade County selection.

**BUC SHOTS:** Rodríguez went 7-2 with a 2.11 ERA and 62 strikeouts over 47 innings pitched in his only season at Florida SouthWestern State. He was a First Team All-Suncoast Conference selection for his performance for the Buccaneers.

**PICKED HIGH:** Rodríguez is the highest Florida SouthWestern State draft selection since the baseball program restarted in 2016. He was the highest MLB draft selection from the school since Kerry Ward was a fourth-round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in 1993.

**SWEET CAROLINA:** Rodríguez did not pitch professionally last season. His first action as a pro was this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. Rodríguez was 3-4 with a 3.53 ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts – prior to joining the Timber Rattlers. He had walked 27 and struck out 84 in 71-1/3 innings with the Mudcats.

**LAST START:** Rodríguez [lost at Cedar Rapids on August 17](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and nine strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**VS. LANSING:** Rodríguez has never faced the Lugnuts prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics.

## CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP GRANT HOLMAN:** Oakland picked Holman in the 6<sup>th</sup> round of the 2021 draft out of California-Berkley.

**TWO-WAY PLAYER:** Holman was 5-9 with a 4.05 ERA in 25 games – 23 starts – in three seasons at Cal. He also hit .264 with five homers and 34 RBI in his first two seasons at Cal. Holman did not have an at bat in his final season with the Bears.

**CALL:** Holman made his professional debut with the Stockton Ports in the California League after signing with the Athletics. He was 0-1 and allowed seven earned runs with fifteen strikeouts in 15 innings pitched over six games – four starts.

**HARDWARE:** Holman started this season with Lansing and was 1-2 in four games – three starts – with a 3.43 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 21 innings pitched for the Lugnuts in April. He missed April and May before making two starts in the Arizona Complex League on July 21 and July 26.

**AUGUST IN THE MIDWEST:** Holman returned to Lansing and is 0-1 in three games – two starts – this month. He has allowed seven runs on eight hits with six strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings.

**LAST GAME:** Holman pitched [four innings as a reliever against Great Lakes on August 16](#). He allowed a run on a hit with no walks and no strikeouts for a no decision over four innings.

**LAST START:** Holman had a [no decision at Dayton on August 9](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Holman has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. He made a brief start against the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League [on July 21, 2022](#). He gave up three runs on three hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Jace Avina hit a home run off Holman in the bottom of the first inning in that game.
