FALLING DOWN: Cedar Rapids scored first last night on the Wingrove home run in the third inning. Wisconsin opponents have scored first in the last eight games. Wisconsin is 1-7 in their last eight games. Wisconsin trailed 5-0 before Areinamo got Wisconsin on the scoreboard with his home run in the sixth.

TENS ALL AROUND: Areinamo and Rodríguez both hit their tenth home runs of the season last night. Eduarqui Fernandez earned his tenth outfield assist of the season when he threw out Urbina at third base in the second inning

**DEFENSIVE NOTES:** The Rattlers committed an error last night and have fallen behind the Quad Cities River Bandits for best fielding percentage in the Midwest League. ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved around the league. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#2), Luke Adams (#8), Luis Lara (#16), and Jadher Areinamo (#21). Blake Burke (#15) is currently on the IL. MLB Pipeline has six active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Walker Jenkins (#1), Kaelen Culpepper (#6), Gabriel Gonzalez (#9), Rayne Doncon (#19), Connor Prelipp (#22), and Rubel Cespedes (#24). Danny DeAndrade (#23) is currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

**TROPHY ROOM:** Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

**OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA:** Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55<sup>th</sup> overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

**THE CAPE:** Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

**THE MUDCAT:** Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Rudy lost to Quad Cities at home on <u>August 31</u>. He allowed five runs on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. CEDAR RAPIDS:** Rudy is 0-1 in two starts against the Kernels this season. He has allowed eight runs on thirteen hits with five walks and nine strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings. Rudy has allowed three homers in his starts against the Kernels.

#### CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DARREN BOWEN: The Minnesota Twins acquired Bowen on January 29, 2024 as part of a trade that sent Jorge Polanco to the Seattle Mariners for Anthony DeSclafani, Justin Topa, Gabriel Gonzalez, Bown, and cash.

**ORIGIN STORY:** The Mariners originally selected Bowen in the thirteenth round of the 2022 Draft out of University of North Carolina-Pembroke. Bowen was 7-5 with nine saves in 42 games – eighteen starts – over three seasons at UNC-Pembroke. He compiled a 5.36 ERA with 175 strikeouts over 122-2/3 innings pitched during his career.

**THAT'S NUTS:** Bowen did not pitch professionally in 2022. He started his pro career with the Modesto Nuts, the California League affiliate of the Mariners in 2023. Bowens was 4-2 with a 3.88 ERA in nineteen games – fifteen starts. He walked 25 and struck out 59 with Modesto.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Bowen had a no decision as a reliever at Lake County on August 31. He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Bowen lost at Dayton on <u>August 25</u>. He allowed four runs – three earned – on four hits with two walks and six strikeouts ovr four innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Bowen is 0-2 in two starts against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed five runs on seven hits with five walks and seven strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings.
