WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Peoria Chiefs defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-6 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#)

Osvaldo Tovalin hit a two-out, two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning to give the Chiefs a 6-5 lead. Peoria added an insurance run on a sacrifice fly in the top of the ninth and they needed it as Wisconsin tallied a run on a Rob Moore homer in the bottom of the ninth, but that was as close as the Rattlers would get.

MORE, MORE, MOORE: Rob Moore added a double and a single and drove in two runs yesterday. He has driven in two runs in three straight games. Moore leads the Midwest League in total bases (15), is tied for the league lead in homers (2), ranks second in RBI (6), and is third in OPS (1.105) so far this season.

RATTTLERS RALLY: Wisconsin had a 2-0 lead before the Chiefs took a 3-2 lead. Eduardo García put the Rattlers up 5-3 in the bottom of the sixth on a three-run home run.

TWO OUT BLUES: The Chiefs scored five of their seven runs after two outs in an inning.

GRAY HAVEN: Gray singled in the sixth inning before the García home run. Gray is on a five-game hitting streak to start the season (7-for-22, .318).

WELCOME BACK, WARD: Je'Von Ward was 2-for-4 with an RBI yesterday. Ward, who missed the entire 2022 season, has played in four games with the Rattlers this season and is 5-for-14 (.357) with two doubles and four RBI.

IN CONTROL: Wisconsin pitchers issued one walk on Wednesday. The Timber Rattlers pitchers have given up thirteen walks on the season. Only West Michigan (12) has issued fewer free passes in the Midwest League so far this season.

DAY TIME: The Rattlers three losses this season have been day games. Wisconsin was 20-16 in 36 day games during the 2022 season.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1983 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1984. They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his first year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#8), Robert Moore (#10), Hendry Mendez (#16), Eduardo García (#22), and Joseph Hernandez (#29). [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Cooper Hjerpe (#7), Jimmy Crooks (#16), Austin Love (#20), Ian Bedell (#25), Dionys Rodriguez (#27), and Victor Scott II (#28). Inohan Paniagua (#18) is on Peoria's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSEPH HERNANDEZ: Acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with the Seattle Mariners on January 7, 2023 in exchange for Justin Topa.

FROM THE REPUBLIC: The Mariners originally signed Hernandez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

TWO YEARS ON THE ISLAND: Hernandez spent his 2018 and 2019 seasons with the Mariners affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in fifteen games – six starts – in 2018 and went 0-1 in four relief appearances in 2019. He had 28 walks and 47 strikeouts over 45 innings pitched in the DSL.

BACK AT IT: Hernandez spent most of his 201 season with the Mariners affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He was 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in ten games – four starts – with 49 strikeouts over 31 innings. He also made one start for Arkansas, Seattle's Double-A affiliate in the Texas League that season.

AWARD WINNING: Hernandez was 9-5 with a 3.39 ERA in 24 games – 22 starts – for the Modesto Nuts, Seattle's affiliate in the California League in 2022. He had 143 strikeouts over 116-2/3 innings pitched and was named the California League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST START: Hernandez had a [no decision at Beloit on April 7](#) to open the 2023 season. He allowed two runs on three hits with three walks and six strikeouts over four innings for his debut in the Brewers system.

VS. PEORIA: Hernandez has never faced the Chiefs prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

INNINGS PITCHED: 6.2 – 8/5/2022 v. Stockton

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TINK HENCE: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Hence in Competitive Balance Round-B with the 63rd pick of the 2020 draft out of Watson Chapel (AR) High School.

TURNING PRO: Hence signed with the Cardinals over a commitment to the University of Arkansas.

STARTING OUT: Hence made eight appearances – one start – for the Cardinals Florida Complex League affiliate in 2021. He was 0-1 with a save and allowed eight earned runs on eleven hits with three walks and fourteen strikeouts over eight innings.

STAYING IN FLORIDA: Hence made sixteen starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2022. He was 0-1 with a 1.38 ERA and recorded 81 strikeouts with just 15 walks in 52-1/3 innings pitched.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline places Hence as the #3 prospect in the Cardinals organization and #71 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball. *Baseball America* puts him at #2 in the St. Louis System and #45 in their Top 100 for all minor league baseball.

LAST START: Hence made his debut with Peoria as the Opening Night starter on [April 6 against the Cedar Rapids Kernels at home](#). He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out six over four scoreless innings for a no decision.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hence has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
