ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Cedar Rapids Kernels were tied 3-3 through the top of the ninth when a thunderstorm with lightning and heavy rain forced a suspension of play. Wisconsin trailed 3-2 with two outs in the bottom of the seventh when Joe Gray Jr was hit by a pitch. Gray stole second, took third when the throw from the catcher went into center, and scored when the throw from center wound up in the Cedar Rapids dugout. THE WOODRUFF REPORT: Milwaukee Brewers pitcher Brandon Woodruff made his second rehabilitation start of the season with the Timber Rattlers when he took the mound Thursday night. Woodruff allowed one run on four hits with no walks and three strikeouts. He tossed 52 pitches with 36 strikes. MAGNIFICENT SEVEN: Alexander Cornielle relieved Woodruff for the top of the fifth inning and he would toss five innings and allow one unearned run. Cornielle recorded seven strikeouts, gave up three hits, and walked one for a no decision on Thursday.

LEAVE THEM WANTING MOORE: Wisconsin took a 2-1 lead on Moore's solo home run in the bottom of the third inning on Thursday. The homer was his seventh of the season. In the bottom of the tenth, Moore jumped on the first pitch from Miguel Rodriguez for a line drive single to right with runners at second and third. Both runners scored for Wisconsin's 4-3 win

A PRESENCE I HAVE NOT FELT SINCE: Thursday was the first walkoff win for the Rattlers since May against Peoria. Wisconsin also had a walkoff win against Beloit on April 29. All three of Wisconsin's walkoff wins this season have happened in the bottom of the tenth inning. The game on April 29 and Friday night saw Wisconsin rally for two runs in the bottom of the tenth after their opponents had taken the lead in the top of the tenth.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League, in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including this year. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places three active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6), Eduardo García (#19), and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Emmanuel Rodriguez (#2), Noah Miller (#11), Misael Urbina (#19), Alejandro Hidalgo (#20), CJ Culpepper (#26), Kala'i Rosario (#27), Ben Ross (#28), and Cory Lewis (#30). Connor Prelipp (#3) is currently on the IL.

## WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

**DELAYED START:** Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

**MUDDY WATERS:** Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

**LAST START:** Cruz had a no decision at Dayton on <u>July 23</u>. He allowed four runs on four hits with two batsmen, no walks, and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Cruz took the loss at Cedar Rapids on May 27. He allowed two runs on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts.

#### CEDAR RAPIDS SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER GAME TWO:

RHP CHRISTIAN MACLEOD: The Twins selected MacLeod in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of Mississippi State. .

**TWO YEARS IN STARKVILLE:** MacLeod was 4-0 in four starts with a 0.86 ERA during the abbreviated 2020 season with the Bulldogs. He went 6-6 in nineteen starts in 2021. In his time at Mississippi State, MacLeod had 148 strikeouts over 103-2/3 innings pitched.

**THOSE TWO TIMES IN OMAHA:** MacLeod was the starting pitcher twice in the 2021 College World Series. He allowed four runs on five hits in 1-1/3 innings against Virginia on June 22, 2021 and six runs on two hits in 2/3 of an inning against Vanderbilt on June 28, 2021.

**THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE:** MacLeod made one appearance in the Florida Complex League after signing with the Twins. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out five over 1-2/3 innings. He would undergo Tommy John Surgery in March of 2022 and missed the entire 2022 season.

**BACK AT IT:** MacLeod has made two starts for Fort Myers in the Florida State League before joining the Kernels today. He had no record and allowed two runs on one hit with six walks and eight strikeouts in 5-1/3 innings pitched with the Mighty Mussels.

**LAST START:** MacLeod had a no decision at home against Peoria on July 23. He gave up one run on four hits with two walks, two hit batsmen, and five strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: MacLeod had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Cedar Rapids on May 28. He allowed three runs on two hits with a walk and no strikeouts over one inning for his Midwest League debut. Joe Gray Jr hit a three-run homer off MacLeod in the first inning.
